Next Game

Creighton visits Illinois State in a battle between the two preseason favorites in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Bluejays will kick off the new year on Jan. 2 in a 7:05 p.m. contest at Redbird Arena in Normal, Ill.

Scouting the Bluejays

Creighton returned to the win column with a 90-65 win over Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 29 that saw six different players score in double figures.

The Creighton lineup got a huge boost when all-MVC pick and leading scorer **Kyle Korver** (15.1 ppg.) returned to the lineup just nine days after arthroscopic knee surgery and added 12 points and eight rebounds in 11 minutes vs. MVSU. Creighton had gone 1-2 in Korver's absence.

Terrell Taylor (12.0) and **Brody Deren** (10.1) also average in double-figures for a CU team that is 6-1 at home and 0-3 on the road.

Scouting the Redbirds

The league's preseason favorite is 4-7 on the year after preseason MVC Player of the Year Tarise Bryson was lost for the season in the team's 74-70 win over Weber State to open the year. Much like Creighton, ISU has been a different team on the road, going 3-1 at home and 1-6 away from Redbird Arena.

Junior college transfer **Baboucarr Bojang** leads the team with 14.8 points and 7.8 rebounds per game, while seniors **Shedrick Ford** (11.0) and **Shawn Jeppson** (10.4) also reach double-digits off the bench.

The Coaches

Creighton's **Dana Altman** (Eastern New Mexico, '80) is in his eighth year as head coach of the Bluejays, owning a 129-90 (.589) mark at CU and a career ledger of 212-157 (.575) in his 13th year as an NCAA Division I head coach. Altman led the Bluejays to a 24-8 mark last season and their third consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. Altman had led four teams to 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths as a head coach. Teams coached by Altman have played in the postseason in seven of the past 10 years. Creighton has improved its win total in every season under Altman.

Illinois State's **Tom Richardson** (St. Xavier, '77) is in his third year as head coach at Illinois State, owning a 35-36 record in that time. Prior to becoming the head coach, he had been an assistant at ISU to **Kevin Stallings** for six years during a run of four postseason bids. After going 10-20 his rookie campaign, Richardson's Redbirds went 21-9 and lost in the first round of the NIT last season. He is assisted by **Chad Altadonna**, **Doug Novsek** and **Anthony Beane**.

The Illinois State State Series

Illinois State leads the all-time series with Creighton 31-12, including a 19-2 advantage in Normal. The Redbirds have won 16 of the last 17 games in Normal in this series, with the lone exception being CU's 86-83 win on Feb. 5, 2000. Creighton has won four of the last five games in the series, though the teams split two games last year.

Last Year vs. Illinois State

Illinois State defeated Creighton 75-63 on Jan. 8 in Normal before the Jays returned the favor with a 78-69 decision in Omaha 19 days later.

In the first meeting, **Shedrick Ford** scored 15 of his game-high 21 points in the second half and led all players with 10 rebounds as ISU posted a 75-63 win over the Jays. Illinois State ran off two separate 10-0 runs in the second half to break open a game CU led 31-30 at the half. **Kyle Korver** led CU with 15 points and **Ben Walker** added 14 points.

In the second meeting, Korver scored 22 points as Creighton beat ISU 78-69 before 8,371 at the Civic Auditorium. Walker added 16 points and **Terrell Taylor** had 11 for the Jays as CU shot 55 percent from the floor. Creighton opened the game on a 18-5 run and held a 41-25 lead at the half. ISU closed to within 10 with six minutes left before a Korver three-pointer and consecutive dunks by Taylor gave Creighton a comfortable 65-48 lead en route to the win.

Creighton's Last Game

Creighton never trailed in a 90-65 win over Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 29 in Omaha. The Jays scored seven points in the final minute of the first half to gain a comfortable 49-36 lead at the break. Creighton then opened the second half with a 14-5 run to open up a 22-point lead and they were never challenged the rest of the way.

Creighton had six players in double-figures, led by 15 points from **Larry House** in his first game off the bench. As a team, CU outrebounded the Delta Devils 55-29 and outshot MVSU 48 percent to 36 percent from the floor.

MVSU shot 10-for-37 from three-point range and was led by 17 points from **Michael Archie**.

Double-Digit Half Dozen

Creighton had six players with 11 points or more in its 90-65 romp over Mississippi Valley State. The last time CU had six players in double-figures was a 102-69 win over Evansville on Feb. 28, 2000.

This season, Creighton has had 10 different players score 10 or more points in a game. The only players who haven't reached double-digits this year are **Tyler McKinney**, **Ismael Caro** and **Dan Bresnahan**.

A Tough Road Ahead

Creighton has started 0-3 on the road for the first time since 1996-97 when they finished the year 3-9 on the road, and it doesn't get much easier this week. The Jays next visit Illinois State and Northern Iowa, two places where they are a combined 5-26 overall. They are 2-19 all-time in Normal and have lost 16 of their last 17 visits there. It hasn't been much better in Cedar Falls, where they are 3-7.

Korver Returns With A Flurry

After missing three games following arthroscopic surgery on his meniscus, junior **Kyle Korver** returned to the floor an amazing nine days after his Dec. 20 procedure. Korver's game didn't appear to have suffered too much, as he totaled 12 points, eight rebounds and a pair of assists in just 11 minutes off the bench in his return vs. Mississippi Valley State.

Career Nights For Quintet

Five different players notched career-highs in points vs. Mississippi Valley State, **DeAnthony Bowden**, **Larry House**, **Jimmy Motz**, **Mike Grimes** and **Dan Bresnahan**.

Bowden had career-highs with 12 points, five rebounds and five assists while House had a career-high 15 points in his first game off the bench. Grimes had 11 points in 17 minutes and Motz had 13 points in 25 minutes as they both reached double-figures for the first time. Not to be forgotten, Bresnahan scored the first point of his young career in the final minute on a free throw.

Taylor Packs Scoring Punch

Before being held to just two points in five minutes vs. Mississippi Valley State, junior **Terrell Taylor** had led or tied for the team lead for CU in scoring in five straight games. What made it even more impressive is the fact that he did it off the bench. Taylor's streak started with 11 points at BYU. He followed that up with 18 points vs. Nebraska, 10 points vs. Indiana State, 15 vs. Western Kentucky and a dozen points vs. Xavier. He leads the team with 120 points for the season and is shooting a stellar 39.7 percent from three-point range for the campaign.

Dabbert Sparks the Bench

Sophomore forward **Joe Dabbert** has proven to be a nice fit off the Creighton bench of late. Since coming off the pine, Dabbert has scored 32 points in 51 minutes over the course of three games. He made 3-of-5 field goals vs. Indiana State, 3-of-4 shots at Western Kentucky and 3-of-5 vs. Xavier. He's also made 12 straight free throws over the last four games.

McKinney Earns Start

Freshman guard **Tyler McKinney** earned the first start of his young career vs. Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 29. McKinney was saddled by foul trouble early in the first half but finished the game with three points, a rebound and an assist in 18 minutes vs. the Delta Devils.

Guards Turnover

Think Creighton doesn't miss **Ryan Sears** at all? Last year the four-year starter had a solid 137 assists compared to just 63 turnovers. This year, CU's three point guards--**DeAnthony Bowden, Ismael Caro** and **Tyler McKinney**--have combined for 56 assists and 45 turnovers.

As a team, last year's team had 64 more assists than turnovers, while this year's team has 14 more turnovers than assists.

Trifectas Troubling Trend

After 10 games this season, Creighton has hit 63-of-212 of its three-pointers, good for 29.7 percent, as nine different players have at least one trey. If the season ended today, that 29.7 percent would rank as the lowest mark from long-range in Creighton history. By comparison, last year after 10 games, the Jays were 83-for-222, making 37.4 percent of their trifectas.

Bench Gets It Done

With 11 players averaging 10 minutes per game or more, **Dana Altman's** club continues to get tremendous production off the bench. In fact, four of Altman's top five scorers (Taylor, Korver, Dabbert and House) entering the Mississippi Valley State game came off the bench in that contest, with **Brody Deren** as the only exception.

This year, Creighton's bench has accounted for 46 percent of the team's points, 50 percent of the team's rebounds and 48 percent of the team's assists while playing 44 percent of the minutes, as seen below:

Home Sweet Civic

Creighton is 21-1 at home since the last home game of the 1999-00 season, losing only to Xavier in that time. Xavier snapped a CU-record 20-game home winning streak on Dec. 20 that had ranked as the seventh longest active streak in Division I.

Before the Xavier setback, the last time the Bluejays had suffered a home defeat was a 92-83 loss on Feb. 19, 2000, when Southern Illinois escaped Omaha with a victory. It was Creighton's second non-conference loss at home in the last five seasons, the other being a 75-67 loss to #19 Tulsa on Jan. 12, 2000.

Block Party

Creighton finished the Xavier game with a season-high seven blocked shots. That's the most they've had since they had seven vs. Bradley on Feb. 14, 2001. The last time they had more than seven swats in a game was when they had nine vs. Southern Illinois on Jan. 31, 2001.

Motz Goes Route of West

Jimmy Motz had his redshirt lifted in Creighton's sixth game vs. Nebraska on Dec. 12. However, he isn't the first Bluejay player in recent memory to come out of redshirt midway through the year as **Matt West** (1996-00) did the same thing.

West missed Creighton's first 11 games of the '96-97 season before his redshirt was lifted for a Jan. 4 game vs. Houston, in which he played five minutes.

West finished the year averaging 11.7 minutes per game, scoring 2.6 points per game. He finished his career playing in 106 career games, scoring 502 points, grabbing 218 rebounds and 92 three-pointers.

Creighton owns an impressive 10-game winning streak in regular-season MVC games dating back to a Jan. 24, 2001 loss at Evansville. Creighton's best previous run through the league was a stretch of nine straight conference wins between Jan. 21-Feb. 16, 1998.

All You Need To Know

Want a good indication of who's going to win? Take a look at the free throw shooting of **Kyle Korver**. Since Jan. 12, 2001, Korver is a near-perfect 49-for-50 from the stripe in Creighton's wins but just 16-for-22 (72.7 percent) in the Jays losses in that time. Of those losses, only once has Korver been perfect at the line.

Dialing Long Distance

Count on more than a couple three-pointers being launched when the Bluejays visit Illinois State.

The Jays have gone 222 consecutive games with a three-pointer, including all 219 games under the direction of **Dana Altman**. Creighton's last game without a three-pointer was a 59-53 loss at Illinois State on Feb. 20, 1993 when **Rick Johnson** was the coach.

Going a step further, Creighton has hit three or more trifectas in 168 consecutive games dating to a 58-57 overtime loss to Northern Iowa on Feb. 16, 1996. In that game, CU was 2-for-16 from long-range.

All Who Play, Score

Twice this season Creighton coach **Dana Altman** has had everyone in the line-up score. The first time it happened was when Altman used 11 different players in the Dec. 4 loss at TCU, with all 11 making a dent in the scoring column.

It most recently happened on Dec. 22 when 10 different guys played and scored vs. Xavier. Entering this season, the last time Creighton had every player in action score was its 96-50 romp over Western Illinois to open last season. In that contest, 14 different Jays scored.

For the season, Creighton's bench has outscored its counterparts 345-187, an average advantage of +15.8 points per game, including a +36 advantage in the romp over Grambling State.

Moving Up The Charts

Just a junior, **Kyle Korver** has moved into fourth in Creighton history with 179 career three-pointers, surpassing **Duan Cole's** 177 (1987-92) for fourth in CU history and six behind **Matt Roggenburk** (1986-90) for third place. Korver's teammate the previous two seasons, **Ryan Sears**, owns the school record with 245 career trifectas.

Junior **Terrell Taylor** owns 101 career three-pointers and in the Xavier game passed **Ben Walker** (1997-01) for 10th on the career chart at CU. Taylor leads the team and is second in the MVC with 2.50 three-pointers per game. However, his streak of 12 straight games with a three-pointer came to an end vs. Mississippi Valley State on Dec. 29.
