In-State Streaking

Illinois is playing the first of two in-state non-conference games by hosting Western Illinois. Eastern Illinois visits the Assembly Hall on Dec. 10. Illinois is 97-12 all-time against in-state schools in non-conference play. Illinois' last loss to a non-Big Ten in-state school came Nov. 29, 1990 to Illinois-Chicago, a current streak of 25 consecutive wins. Since 1974, Illinois is 42-3 against non-Big Ten in-state schools.

Un-Self-ish Play

The Fighting Illini have begun the 2002-03 season with unselfish play. Illinois has combined for 39 assists (19.5 avg.) over two games, including 24 in the win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff. In each of the first two games, all nine players who were on the court in each game scored with six being the most shots taken by any one player.

Freshmen Bask In Season Opener

For the first time in school history Illinois opened the season with three freshmen in the starting lineup when James Augustine, Dee Brown and Deron Williams were on the floor for the opening tip. Two sophomores, Roger Powell and Nick Smith, rounded out the starting lineup as the youngest in school history. The five starters had combined for a total of four starts (all by Nick Smith) to begin the season.

The last time Illinois started three freshmen in any game was Feb. 20, 1991 when Rennie Clemons, Scott Pierce, and Tom Michael started vs. Ohio State.

The five Illinois freshmen have scored 104 of Illinois' 186 points (56 percent) this season, while grabbing 42 of the Illini's 90 rebounds (47 percent).

Last Time Out --

Illinois 96, Arkansas-Pine Bluff 43

Illinois posted a 96-43 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff with four players scoring in double figures, led by Roger Powell's 17. Illinois dominated the smaller Golden Lions on the boards by an incredible 50-20 margin, pulling down 24 offensive rebounds. The Illini continued unselfish play, as for the second consecutive game all nine players who saw action in the first half scored.

Fresh Faces:

Five Freshmen Give Illini New Look

Five freshmen will give an entirely new look to the Fighting Illini beginning with the

2002-03 season. The Illini recruiting class was a consensus Top 10 group and includes McDonald's All-American **Dee Brown**, a 6-foot guard from Proviso East High School in Maywood, Ill., **Deron Williams**, a 6-3 guard from The Colony, Texas, **Kyle Wilson**, a 6-8 forward from Plano, Texas, **James Augustine**, a 6-10 forward from Lincoln-Way Central High School in New Lenox, Ill., and **Aaron Spears**, a 6-9 post player from Chicago Dunbar High School.

Jankovich Added to UI Staff

Bill Self added veteran coach Tim Jankovich to the Illinois coaching staff Nov. 20, replacing Billy Gillispie who moved to UTEP as head coach on Nov. 2. Jankovich, a former head coach at North Texas, has worked as associate head coach the last three seasons at Vanderbilt. He served on the same Oklahoma State staff with Self in the early 1990s.

Cook, Howard Return to the Floor

Senior forward Brian Cook and junior guard Jerrance Howard return to action after sitting out the first two regular-season games of the season because of participation in an unsanctioned summer tournament. Cook is Illinois' top returning scorer and rebounder from a year ago.

Cook needs one point to move into 25th place on the UI career scoring list and 23 points to move into 23rd place.

Tip-Ins...

Illinois' 26 wins in 2002 tied as the third-winningest season in school history ... The 2001-02 season was the second time in school history that the Illini posted back-to-back 26 win seasons. The last time was in 1984 and 1985 ... After starting the 2002 season with five straight road losses, Illinois finished with five straight road wins, including four straight Big Ten road victories ... The last time Illinois won four straight Big Ten road games in the same season was in 1956 ... Illinois' nine-game winning streak to end the 2002 regular season was its longest since opening the 1995-96 season with a 9-0 record ... Illinois won at least 10 games in conference play for the third straight season, and fifth of the last six years ... Brian Cook made 50 of his last 52 free throws over the span of the last 18 games of the 2002 season ... In Big Ten play, Cook ranked first in free throw percentage at 92.0 percent (46-of-50) ... Illinois led the Big

Illini Head Coach Bill Self

Bill Self is in his third season at the helm of the Illini program following three years at Tulsa where he earned National Coach of the Year honors from the John & Nellie Wooden Foundation and *The Sporting News* in 2000.

At Illinois, he became the second coach in Big Ten history, and the first since 1912-14, to win Big Ten titles in his first two years in the league. He is the first coach in Illinois history to reach 50 wins in his first two seasons. Self has led teams to at least the NCAA Sweet Sixteen each of the last three seasons, including two trips to the Final Eight.

After leading Tulsa to a 32-5 record and into a Regional Final appearance in 2000, Self became the second coach to lead two different schools to a Final Eight appearance with the Illini in 2001. Prior to his stop at Tulsa, Self spent four years at Oral Roberts where he built a program from 6-21 his first season to 21-7 in his fourth year.

A 1985 graduate of Oklahoma State, Self has worked under Larry Brown at Kansas and Leonard Hamilton and Eddie Sutton at Oklahoma State.

In his first season at Illinois, Self led the Illini to 27 victories, the second-most in school history and became just the fourth Big Ten coach since 1950 to defeat every conference school in his first season. He also became just the ninth coach in Big Ten history to win a Big Ten title in his first season.

Self was a finalist for the Associated Press National Coach of the Year, finishing fourth in voting, and was a nominee for the Naismith College Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2002.

Illinois won back-to-back Big Ten titles for the first time in 50 years (since 1951-52) and for just the third time in school history. The Whiz Kids posted back-to-back titles in 1942 and 1943. Illinois has never won three straight Big Ten titles.

Self Wins Second Big Ten Title in Two Years

Bill Self became just the second Big Ten coach in conference history, and first since Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell did so his first three seasons from 1912-14, to win Big Ten basketball titles in his first two seasons in the league.

Last season, Bill Self became the first coach in 22 years, just the ninth all-time in the Big Ten, and second Illini coach to win a Big Ten championship in his first season as coach at a conference school.

League rookies earning hardware are Wisconsin's Meanwell in 1912, Guy Lowman in 1918 and Harold Foster in

1935, Iowa's Sam Barry in 1923, Michigan's George Veeckner in 1929, Illinois' Doug Mills in 1937, Minnesota's Bill Musselman in 1972, Purdue's Lee Rose in 1979, Self in 2001 and Wisconsin's Bo Ryan in 2002.

Williams, Archibald move to the League

Frank Williams became Illinois' first, first-round NBA draft pick since 1990 when the New York Knicks chose him as the 26th pick of the 2002 NBA Draft. Teammate Robert Archibald soon followed as the 32nd pick by the Memphis Grizzlies. Archibald is the first native of Scotland to be drafted by an NBA team.

High-Scoring Illini

Illinois led the Big Ten in scoring in 2002 with an average of 77.4 points per game and shot 47.0 percent from the field, which ranked second in the conference. Illinois opened the 2002-03 season by scoring 90 points in a win over Lehigh and 96 against

Did you Know ...

- ... Dee Brown and Brian Cook. They share a common bond, being named Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois. Brown won the award in 2002 and Cook in 1999.
- ... Since 1980 Illinois has signed 12 McDonald's All-Americans and two are currently on the Illini roster. Dee Brown made the All-America team in 2002 and Cook in 1999. Illinois ranks 11th all-time in number of McDonald's All-Americans to attend the school.
- ... Illinois has the 16th best all-time winning percentage (.645) among Division I schools, one spot ahead of Arizona.
- ... Illinois has an all-time record of 1434-789. The 1434 wins rank 18th on the Division I list.
- ... Illini Head Coach Bill Self helped Oklahoma State to a Big 8 Conference Tournament Championship in 1983.
- ... Illini Head Coach Bill Self and his coaching staff is one of just two staffs in the nation to have a current streak of four-consecutive conference championships.
- ... Nine Illini players have been first-round draft selections, including Nick Anderson and Kendall Gill from the 1989 Final Four team and recently departed Frank Williams to the New York Knicks in 2002.
- ... Illinois ranks second in the Big Ten behind Indiana in total NCAA appearances.
- ... Illinois is second among Big Ten schools in all-time victories and third in all-time winning percentage. In all-time Big Ten play, the Illini are third in conference wins and winning percentage behind Purdue and Indiana.
- ... The Orange Krush student group is more than just a Fighting Illini cheering section. The students raised over \$150,000 last year which went to the University of Illinois general scholarship fund, the Fighting Illini Scholarship Fund (to the Matthew Heldman Scholarship Fund) and a variety of charities. Over the last four years, Orange Krush has distributed more than \$375,000 to charities.

Illinois is just outside the Top 25 in the Associated Press poll at No. 29.

National Exposure

For the 2002-03 season, Illinois is scheduled to appear at least 13 times on national television with six games on ESPN, three games on ESPN2 and four games on CBS.

Quick Shots ...

- Dee-Fence ... Dee-Fence:** In 2002, the Illini held opponents to 41.6 percent field goal shooting, including 34.0 percent from three-point range. The Illini forced 15.4 turnovers per game and averaged 7.4 steals.

- Defending Home Court:** In 14 home games in 2001-02, Illinois opponents shot just .390 (305-783) from the field, .320 (85-265) from three-point range and .625 (168-269) from the free throw line. Lehigh shot just 37 percent from the field in the season opener Nov. 24.

- Ingram Transfers From Tulsa:** Jack Ingram, a 6-10 forward/center from San Antonio, Texas, transferred to Illinois from Tulsa this past summer and will sit out the 2002-03 season per NCAA transfer rules.

Sophomore Roger Powell had 15 points and nine rebounds to lead five underclassmen in double figures for Illinois in a 90-56 win over Lehigh.

Illinois (1-0) started three freshman and two sophomores in its first regular season game because of injuries and suspensions to two of its players, and the inexperience showed early on.

But after a few rocky minutes, the Illini's youngsters eventually settled down and easily pulled away from Lehigh (1-1).

Illinois trailed 15-12 before going on an 18-3 run that was capped by a crowd-pleasing dunk by freshman Aaron Spears. The 6-9 center caught a pass four feet from the basket, spun around a defender and slammed the ball with one hand for his first career points at Illinois.

After a basket by Lehigh, Illinois outscored the Mountain Hawks 17-4 behind three 3-pointers from 6-8 Kyle Wilson and took a 47-24 halftime lead.

Illinois shot 56 percent for the game, including 46 percent from 3-point range, and held Lehigh to 37 percent shooting.

Cook and reserve guard Jerrance Howard sat out while serving two-game suspensions for playing in a non-sanctioned summer tournament. Wilson scored 14 points and made 3-of-5 3-pointers. Illinois guards Dee Brown and Deron Williams, both freshmen, combined for 26 points and had four assists apiece.
