Series History

- Wednesday's game will be the 94th in the all-time series between Bradley and Illinois State.
- The series dates back to a 39-13 ISU win three games into the 1904-05 season in Bradley's first-ever game against another collegiate program.
- Illinois State has won three straight in the series and the Redbirds will be gunning for a fourth consecutive victory versus Bradley for the first time since a seven-game ride from March 4, 1982 through Jan. 26, 1985.
- The Redbirds, who won 58-55 last season at Carver Arena, will be shooting for consecutive wins on Bradley's current home court for the first time since Jan. 31, 1983 (56-55) and Feb. 18, 1984 (56-50).
- Bradley owns a 30-16 all-time home record versus Illinois State, including a 14-7 advantage at Carver Arena.

The Coaches

BRADLEY HEAD COACH JIM LES

- A star point guard for Bradley in the mid-80s, **Jim Les** is 8-14 (.364) in his first year as the head coach at his alma mater.
- As a senior in 1985-86, Les directed the Braves to a 32-3 record, the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title and a first-round win in the NCAA Tournament while claiming the MVC Player-of-the-Year award and the Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award as the nation's top senior less than 6-feet tall.
- Following his all-star college career, Les enjoyed a seven-year NBA career.

ISU HEAD COACH TOM RICHARDSON

- **Tom Richardson (St. Xavier '77)** is in his fourth year as the head coach at Illinois State, following six years as an assistant to Kevin Stallings on the Redbird staff.
- Richardson owns a 52-59 (.468) career record in his first college head coaching position.
- During the 2000-01 season, Richardson's second as the head coach, he directed the Redbirds to a 21-9 overall record and a trip to the NIT.
- Despite a season-ending injury to league Player-of-the-Year favorite Tarise Bryson in the first game, Richardson guided the 2001-02 'Birds to a 17-14 mark and a third-place Valley finish.

Head-to-Head

- In his first year as Bradley's head coach, Jim Les owns an 0-1 record versus Tom Richardson and ISU.
- Les did face the Redbirds seven times as a player and won the last four meetings to finish with a 4-3 record versus Bradley's 1-74 rival, including a 2-1 record at Carver Arena.
- Richardson owns a 5-3 record versus Bradley, but is 1-2 versus the Braves at Carver Arena.

About The Redbirds

- Since losing 15 of its first 17 games, Illinois State has rebounded to win three of its last four contests and has pulled to within one and one-half games of Bradley in the race for sixth place in The Valley standings.
- All four of Illinois State's wins have come at home, however, and the Redbirds are 0-9 away from home.
- While defense has been the primary problem area for the Redbirds of late, they have managed two of their better defensive efforts in the last three games, limiting the Braves to 43.9 percent shooting in the first meeting Feb. 1 and Indiana State to a 36.0 percent effort Saturday.
- For the season, though, Illinois State's opponents are shooting 49.0 percent from the floor and 41.6 percent from 3-point range.
- Offensively, Illinois State's five starters all average between 8.3 and 11.8 points per game, while the top scorer off the bench, Andy Strandmark, contributes just 4.3 points per game.

Missouri Valley Conference Teleconference

- The Missouri Valley Conference sponsors a weekly teleconference for the media and the league's 10 head coaches throughout the college basketball season.
- The 2002-03 Valley teleconferences are held on Tuesday mornings at 10 o'clock, beginning Dec. 3 and Bradley head coach Jim Les will be available at 10:05.
- The exact dates are: Dec. 3, Dec. 10, Dec. 17, Jan. 7, Jan. 14, Jan. 21, Jan. 28, Feb. 4, Feb. 11, Feb. 18, Feb. 25 and March 4.
- To participate in the teleconference, members of the media may call 913/981-5509.

Bradley Basketball Interview Policy

- To set up interviews with a Bradley player or member of the coaching staff, members of the media are instructed to first contact **Bobby Parker**, Assistant Athletic Director for Communications.
- Bradley Basketball players are NOT available for interviews on game days until the postgame press conference.
- The Bradley Basketball lockerroom is closed after games, but the Bradley SID staff will make requested coaches and players available to the media following the 10-minute cooling off period.
- At home, all postgame interviews will be conducted in the Press Hospitality Room at Carver Arena.
- On the road, postgame interviews will be conducted in the area designated by the host school.

Century of Celebration

- Bradley Basketball is in the second year of a three-year "Century of Celebration."
- The 2002-03 season is the 100th anniversary season since the Braves first tipped off hardwood competition Jan. 1, 1903 with a 12-8 victory versus Invincibles at Peoria's YMCA.
- Because Bradley Athletics was shut down for two years during World War II, next season will be the 100th season of competition for the Braves.
- Last season, fans selected "Teams of the Decade" and those 60 players are now eligible for the 15-player Bradley Basketball "Team of the Century."
- Voting for both the "Team of the Century" and a "Greatest Games" tournament will be done online at www.bubraves.com all season.



Team of the 90s

- As part of the on-going celebration of the first century of Bradley Basketball, the "Team of the 90s" will be honored a halftime of Wednesday's game.
- As of Monday, **Rob Dye** and **Aaron Zobrist** had plans to attend Wednesday's game and **Billy Wright** is to be represented by Willis Pennington during the halftime ceremony.
- The rest of the eight-man "Team of the 90s" includes: Adebayo Akinkunle, Deon Jackson, Anthony Parker, Jerome Robinson and Curtis Stuckey.

Short-Handed Braves

- Bradley began the season with only 11 scholarship players.

- Due to a variety of circumstances, the number of available scholarship players has dropped to seven as the Braves prepare for Wednesday's game.
- Sophomore center **Brandyn Heemskerck** began a medical leave of absence from the school Dec. 5, but has returned to campus and will redshirt the season.
- Freshman forward **Stevan Marcetic** and sophomore forward **Danny Granger** transferred during the winter break.
- Junior forward **Jason Faulknor**, who missed the season's first 15 games with a stress fracture in his right foot, made a brief two-game return before re-injuring the foot in practice Jan. 24 and is sidelined indefinitely.

Carver Arena History

- Bradley is playing its 21st season in downtown Peoria at Carver Arena.
- Including a 5-5 record this year, Bradley owns an all-time record of 219-72 (.753) at Carver Arena, which includes a 128-45 (.740) mark in MVC regular-season games.
- After winning 19 consecutive Valley home games from Feb. 22, 1999 through Feb. 27, 2001, however, the Braves are 7-7 in their last 14 Valley home games.

Attendance Leaders

- Bradley has led the Missouri Valley Conference in home attendance average each of the last six years and the Braves have ranked among the nation's top 50 in home attendance in eight of the last nine years.
- Despite finishing with a 9-20 record last year, Bradley led the Valley and ranked 48th nationally by averaging 9,072 fans.
- Bradley currently leads the Missouri Valley Conference in home attendance at 9,107 per game.

The Last Time Out

- Bradley's junior guard combination -- **Phillip Gilbert** (16), **James Gillingham** (14) and **Marcello Robinson** (10) -- combined for 40 points, but the trio also combined for 15 turnovers as #13 Creighton pulled away for an 88-65 win Saturday in Omaha.
- While the Braves held Creighton All-American candidate Kyle Korver in check for the second time

this year -- 14 points on 4-of-13 shooting -- Michael Lindeman again sparked the Bluejays by nailing all five of his 3-point attempts while scoring a career-best 21 points.

- Sophomore forward **Mike Suggs** left the game early in the second half with a sprained ankle after registering nine points and six rebounds in his first 22 minutes.

Scoring Difference

- Jim Les promised the Braves would play an up-tempo game, and through the first 22 games of the year, the points are coming at a record quicker pace.
- Last year, the Braves finished last in The Valley in scoring a 60.7 points per game.
- Through games of Feb. 9, Bradley is third in The Valley in scoring at 74.0 points per game.
- The jump of 13.3 points per game currently would go down as the largest scoring increase from one season to the next in Bradley's 99-season men's basketball history:

But The Pace Is Slowing

- Since Bradley began The Valley portion of its schedule, however, its scoring pace has slowed dramatically.
- The Braves ranked among the nation's top 20 teams in scoring through the non-conference season by averaging 82.3 points per game.
- Through the first 11 Valley games, though, the Braves are averaging only 65.6 points per game.

It's Not Rocket Science

- The keys to victory for Bradley this season remain pretty simple.
- Bradley is 8-3 (.727) when shooting at a higher percentage than its opponents from the floor, but is 0-11 when its opponents own a higher shooting percentage.
- The Braves also are 0-7 when they commit more turnovers than their opponents and 3-11 when they do not outrebound their opponents.

Margins Matter

- Through the first 22 games of the season, Bradley is 8-6 (.571) in games decided by double digits, but winless (0-8) in games decided by less than 10 points.
- Four of those six single-digit losses were decided by only one basket (three points or less).
- Bradley did win its season-opener in overtime,

pulling away for a 95-81 victory in the extra session.

- Among those eight single-digit defeats are five losses to Butler (18-3), Central Michigan (14-5), #13 Creighton (21-2), UNLV (13-7) and Wichita State (12-8), five teams with a combined 78-25 (.757) record through Feb. 9.

Triple 30s

- With junior guard **Phillip Gilbert** joining the trio with a career-best 32 points Jan. 25 versus Wichita State, three different Braves have topped 30 points in a game this season.
- Former Brave Danny Granger started the trend with 37 points in his Bradley finale Jan. 11 at Evansville.
- Junior guard **James Gillingham** scored a career-best 34 points Jan. 15 versus Drake.
- The three 30-point games are the most in a season for the Braves since Curtis Stuckey scored at least 30 nine times during the 1990-91 season.
- Bradley has not had three different Braves score at least 30 points in a game during one season since the 1988-89 campaign when Anthony Manuel, Dion Thurman and Paul Wilson pulled off the feat.

And Quadruple 30s

- Since sophomore forward **Mike Suggs** approached a 30-point night with 26 points Jan. 29 at Southern Illinois, it is worth noting the Braves have never featured four different 30-point scorers during the course of a season.
- Suggs' effort, however, has given Bradley four different 25-point scorers this year.
- Bradley had not featured four different 25-point scorers since the 1988-89 campaign when Luke Jackson, Anthony Manuel, Dion Thurman and Paul Wilson each went for at least 25 points during the first six games of the season.
- Bradley is one of four teams nationally with four different 25-point scorers this season, joining Drake, Florida and Louisiana Tech.
- Three of Drake's 25-point men, however, hit the mark for the only time this season versus NCAA Division III Grinnell College.

Bradley's "G-Men"

- Bradley's offensive attack begins with the duo of junior guards **Phillip Gilbert** and **James Gillingham**.
- Through games of Feb. 9, the two players are the first- and fourth-leading scorers in The Valley -- and have combined for 34.1 points per game.
- At least one of the two players has scored at least 20 points in 18 of Bradley's first 22 games and both went for 24 points in the Jan. 18 win versus Northern Iowa.
- Gilbert has assumed the title of team rebounding

leader (4.8 boards per game) now that Danny Granger has left.

- Gillingham is second in The Valley in steals (2.09 per game) and remains one of the league's top defensive players.

Gilbert Making Quick Climb

- The 38th Brave to join Bradley's 1,000-Point Club, junior guard **Phillip Gilbert** is making a quick climb up Bradley's all-time scoring list.
- Now 23rd on Bradley's career scoring list with 1,184 career points, Gilbert needs just 16 more to reach 1,200 career points (see chart after Player Notes).
- At his current season average of 18.2 points per game, Gilbert is on pace to finish the season with at least 1,330 points, which would make him the sixth highest-scoring junior in program history.

Gillingham In Elite Company

- Junior guard **James Gillingham** needs only four steals and 11 rebounds to become the sixth Bradley player to record at least 100 rebounds and 50 steals in a season.
- Since Bradley began tracking steals during the 1978-79 season, only Hersey Hawkins (1985-86-87-88), Charles White (1992), Billy Wright (1994), Eric Roberson (1998-99-00) and Rob Dye (1999-00) have recorded 100 rebounds and 50 steals in a season.
- With 349 points and 81 assists to date this season, Gillingham is on the verge of joining Hawkins (1986-87-88) as the only Braves to record **400 points, 100 rebounds, 100 assists and 50 steals** in a season.

Louisiana Lightning

- Logic held that the departure of sophomore forward Danny Granger, and his 19.2 points and 7.9 rebounds per game, would be a tremendous setback for the Braves.
- In the seven games since his departure, however, Granger's first cousin, sophomore forward **Mike Suggs (Metairie, La./Grace King H.S.)**, has done a remarkable job filling the void.
- In 33 career games before Granger's departure, Suggs averaged 10.5 minutes per game (he did not play in 10 games), while contributing 3.6 points and 1.9 rebounds per contest.
