Home Winning Streak At 18 Games

The Salukis have an 18-game home winning streak that began with last season's opening win over Belmont and includes five home victories this season. It is the longest home winning streak since the Salukis won 20-straight at SIU Arena between Feb. 11, 1992 and Dec. 16, 1993.

Williams Excels In New Role as Point Guard

Senior G Kent Williams, who stands fifth in career scoring at SIU, has accepted a new challenge this season. As the team's point guard, he is distributing the ball more and shooting more selectively.

Williams has excelled in his new role, averaging 3.3 apg with

an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.6-to-1. Last year, he led the MVC in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.1-to-1. Williams is converting 46.0 percent from 3-point range this season. He entered the year with a career mark of 36.9 from 3-point.

Series Vs. Illinois State

Saturday will mark the 120th meeting between the two schools, the most times SIU has played any opponent in its 89-year history. The Salukis hold the slimmest of margins, 60-59, in the all-time series. Bruce Weber is 5-3 vs. ISU, but has lost three of the last four. Southern is 17-10 vs. the Redbirds at SIU Arena.

Dawg Bites

The Salukis held Drake scoreless in the

first eight minutes and 17 seconds of Thursday's game in building a 14-0 lead...Southern Illinois is 6-0 in games where it scores at least 70 points and 0-3 when it scores less than 70 points...G Darren Brooks is averaging 17.3 ppg in his last four games...C Josh Warren is averaging 9.0 ppg and 4.3 rpg in his last four games.

Defensive Comparison

In last year's Sweet 16 season, the Salukis allowed only five opponents to shoot better than 45 percent from the field in 36 games. This season, SIU's defense has already allowed seven of its nine opponents to shoot better than 45 percent.

Senior guard Kent Williams and senior forward Jermaine Dearman are both members of the 1,000-point club at SIU and are taking aim at the top scorers in school history this season. Williams is currently fifth in career scoring 1,666 points, while Dearman is 23rd with 1,112 points.

Warren Shines

Sophomore C Josh Warren, who redshirted a year ago, had a career night against Charlotte. While the rest of the team shot just 33 percent, Warren was perfect from the field (6-for-6) and scored 13 points, including his first career 3-pointer. He also added six rebounds.

Free Throw Inconsistency

One area where this year's club appeared to have a leg up over last year's Sweet 16 squad was in free throw shooting. Last year's biggest

free throw offender was Rolan Roberts, who shot 41.6 percent from the line. However, he graduated.

This year, the Salukis are shooting 65.7 percent from the free throw line, up slightly from last year's 61.9 percent.

However, SIU has swung from two extremes, making 91.7 percent from the line against Murray State, but hitting just 56.6 percent in losses to UIC, Charlotte and Saint Louis.

Road Losing Streak

The Salukis have lost three straight road games to UIC, Charlotte and Saint Louis. The Salukis had not lost three straight road games since the 2000-01 season when they dropped four in a row.

Last year, SIU was one of the nation's most successful teams away from home. The Salukis were 9-5 in road games and 6-3 in neutral site games for an overall record of 15-8 away from home.

Hairston Emerges

Sophomore guard Stetson Hairston entered the season with a

reputation as a defensive stalwart. However, he has more than doubled his scoring average over last year and leads SIU in scoring (14.6).

On Dec. 9, he was named the MVC "Player of the Week" for his performances in wins over Murray State and Southeast Missouri State.

Adopted By St. Pete

The city of St. Petersburg, Fla., is hosting the first and second rounds of the 2003 NCAA Tournament, and since they don't have a college team in town, *The St. Petersburg Times* went looking for one to "adopt." They picked the Salukis and have chosen to follow the Dawgs throughout the 2002-03 season.

Beat writer John Cotey spent several days in Carbondale, Ill. for a full-page feature that ran in the *Times* on Nov. 17. In addition to running game capsules throughout the season, the paper will do occasional feature stories and travel to cover some of the team's biggest games of the season.

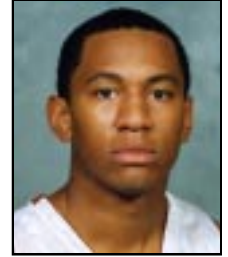
