They slumped to just 8 of 16 from the stripe in losing just their second game in the last 10. Shawn Jeppson led the Redbirds with 16 points.

#### About the Wichita State Shockers

- Wichita State is located in Wichita, Kansas, and enrolls 15.000 students. The Shockers are members of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Wichita State is under the direction of head coach Mark Turgeon, who graduated from Kansas in 1987. He has a 32-39 record in his third year with the program. Turgeon has a career record of 57-68 amassed over a period of five vears.
- The Shockers are averaging 71.7 points per game, while allowing 66.8 to their opponents.
- Wichita State returns six lettermen, including three starters, while losing five letterwinners.
- Sophomore Jamar Howard leads the team in scoring and in rebounding.
- · Sophomore Randy Burns is second in scoring and is first in assists.
- The Shockers have been members of the Missouri Valley Conference since 1946.
- WSU owns a 402-425 in Valley games.
- · Wichita State's last trip to post-season play occurred in the National Invitation Tournament in 1989. The Shockers last NCAA appearance was the previous season in 1988.
- The Shockers are 17-31 against Illinois State all-time, including a 4-18 record in Normal, III.

## A Rare Combination

Illinois State and Wichita State have met 48 times on the hardwood in a series where Illinois State holds a 14-game advantage in the win column. In today's match-up, Illinois State enters with a losing record and the Shockers are on the plus side. It has been 12 years since that same scenario was duplicated. On Jan. 28, 1991, the Redbirds entered the contest against the 10-9 Shockers with a 3-14 record. Wichita State went on to win that game at Redbird Arena, 73-60.

### For Starters ...

Illinois State has used a number of starting lineup combinations this season. Through 13 games, the Redbirds have sent 10 different quintet combos on the floor for the opening tip.

## Sending Out an S.O.S.

After being picked to finish fourth in the conference and sitting with a 1-12 overall record, the Redbirds are left feeling like they're stranded on a deserted island. However, for these castaways the cause, rather than the solution, can be found in an S.O.S. - Strength of Schedule. Illinois State's schedule ranks as the No. 26 toughest slate in the nation by Saragin Rankings and No. 51 by College RPI.

### **Caging a Tiger**

On Jan. 15, the Redbirds added Missouri transfer Najeeb Echols to their roster. Echols, who will have to sit out a year to meet NCAA transfer rules, has started practicing with the team and will eligible for competition on Dec. 13, 2003. Echols played in 10 games for the Tigers this season, averaging 3.1 points and 2.8 rebounds per game. As a freshman, he registered 2.5 points and 2.6 boards per contest. As a prep, Echols was ranked by most recruiting services among the nation's top 30 seniors. He was also a regular feature on the Fox Sports television show Preps, which focused on the lives of several Chicago basketball standouts.

### Thus Far, Not An Average Valley Year

Since the Redbirds joined the Valley for the 1981-82 season, Illinois State has averaged 10.3 conference wins per year. Five of those 21 campaigns were just 16-game Valley schedules, while four others included only 14 games. On average, Illinois State has finished four games over .500 in league play.

### A Stumbling Start

With the 60-46 loss at SMS, the Redbirds lost their fifth Missouri Valley Conference game in as many tries this season. The 0-5 league start is the second-slowest since Illinois State joined conference play in 1981-82. The 1999-2000 Redbirds started the Valley season 0-6, before winning five of their last 12.

#### Hey Arnold!

Freshman **Marcus Arnold** can't be seen on cable's Nicklelodeon, but he has been putting on a show against Missouri Valley Conference opponents. In four of his first five league games of his career, Arnold scored double figures including a career-high with 19 at Northern Iowa. In addition to averaging a team-best 13.0 points in conference games, Arnold is shooting 26-for-48 (.542) against league foes.

### A Post Pattern

Head coach **Tom Richardson** isn't looking to become an offensive coordinator for the Redbird football team, but he has called for a post pattern heading into conference play. In the first eight games, posts **Baboucarr Bojang** and **Marcus Arnold** averaged 6.5 and 6.4 points per game, respectively. However, in the last five, Arnold is averaging 13.0 points per game and Bojang is hovering around the double digit mark with 8.4 points per contest.

### Looking for the Winning 50-50 Ticket

With a win against Wichita State, head coach **Tom Richardson** would register the 50th win of his coaching career. Richardson currently ranks 10th in victories at Illinois State with 49.

### It's Easy Being Greene

Kermit the Frog might not agree, but for point guard **Vince Greene** it is easy when he gets his teammates involved. Greene ranks fourth in The Valley in assists with 4.3 dishes per game. In addition to distributing the ball, Greene has posted double-digit scoring efforts in five of his last seven games and ranks third on the team in scoring with 10.2 points per game.

### **Built Ford Tough**

When freshman **Dana Ford** pulled down a team-high and a career-best eight rebounds at Southern Illinois, he became the first Redbird guard to grab eight caroms since Tarise Bryson equalled the feat against Evansville on March 3, 2001 in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. Ford leads all guards and ranks fourth on the team in rebounding with 2.7 boards per game. The Tamms, Ill., native is also second on the team in league games with 3.6 rebounds per game.

### Greene Means Go

Sophomore **Vince Greene** has had his motor running in conference play thus far this season. Through five games, Greene has only missed three three-point attempt in 11 tries. His eight made treys in Valley games is tops on the team. In his career, Greene is shooting 21-for-42 (.500) on threes in conference play.

### **Consistently Inconsistent**

The Redbirds have seven players that have started six or more games, but head coach **Tom Richardson** is still looking for a consistent scoring trend. Of the seven players, each one has scored at least nine points in a game, while also tossing in as few as three tallies in a game. The seven have also combined for 23 games where they have scored three points or less.

### It's a Small World

With 6-foot-9 **Baboucarr Bojang** being tabbed a preseason first team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection, head coach **Tom Richardson** is probably surprised that his top three scorers are 6-4 or smaller. **Trey Guidry** (10.7 ppg.), **Gregg Alexander** (10.5 ppg.) and **Vince Greene** (10.2 ppg) are the top three tallymarkers on the team.

#### Greenbirds

Prior to this season, the 13 players currently on the Illinois State roster had combined for a total of 240 game played, or just 18.5 games per player, or roughly half of one season. Moreover, of the 13 now playing, seven had never played in an ISU game prior to this season and six had never played in a college game.

### Time and the Minutes Are On Their Side

Just slightly less than 75 percent of the minutes (73.7%) logged so far this season (1,915 of a possible 2,600) are by players that have at least two years of eligibility AFTER this season. The top three minute-getters are **Gregg Alexander** (403), **Vince Greene** (376) and **Trey Guidry** (350) – all sophomores.

#### No Thanks, I'm Just Watching

**Neil Plank** transferred to ISU from Wisconsin, but cannot play for the 'Birds until the 2003-04 season. NCAA rules require that he sit out one season. In 27 games, Plank scored 25 points in 173 minutes for UW.

#### **Redbirds Fall at Wichita State**

WICHITA, Kan. – Gregg Alexander broke the Illinois State freshman record for three-point field goals in a season, but missed ISU foul shots and Wichita State's inside muscle helped the Shockers avenge an 81-71 loss Jan. 7 in Normal by beating the Redbirds 77-66 Wednesday in a Missouri Valley Conference basketball game at Henry Levitt Arena.

The Redbirds, 14-13 overall, 10-6 in the Valley, were No. 3 in the nation in free throw percentage at the game's start. They slumped to just 8 of 16 from the stripe in losing just their second game in the last 10. Shawn Jeppson led the Redbirds with 16 points.

WSU, 14-13, 8-8 in the Valley, was led by Troy Mack's toughness in the second half. Scoring 15 of his game-high points in the final 20 minutes, Mack included 9-11 free throws as the Shockers hit 17 of 23 from the line while winning for the seventh time in eight league home games.

The 'Birds saw a 27-23 lead dissolve into a 32-27 Shocker edge as WSU went on a 9-0 run from 6:35 to 3:39 remaining in the first half. Bojang ended the ISU dry spell with a bank shot with 3:02 left. Randy Rice followed with a jumper to cut that lead to 32-31 2:40 before halftime. Rice, with all 9 of his points in the first half, dropped in two driving shots to put ISU up 35-34 with 14 seconds left, but C.C. McFall beat the buzzer and WSU led 36-35 at intermission. The 'Birds never led again.

#### *On Guard*

The Redbirds, offensively, have definitely been driven by guard play so far this season. Sophomores Trey Guidry, Gregg Alexander and Vince Greene have accounted for 52.3 percent of Illinois State's scoring this season. The threesome has also combined for 71 treys and is shooting 42 percent from behind the arc.

#### We Have a Winner

After finishing 17-14 last season, the Redbirds finished above .500 for the 29th time in 32 seasons at the Division I level. It was also the 'Birds' tenth winning season in the last 11 years.

#### 97 Straight Games With a Trey on the Board ...

Illinois State heads into tonight's game with at least one made 3-pointer in 97 straight games. In fact, in the Tom Richardson era the Redbirds have only gone one game without a made trey on an 82-43 loss at Creighton on December 12, 1999. Since Richardson took the helm, the 'Birds have made four or more treys in 76 of 104 games.

### Feeling Charitable

The Redbirds have been in a giving mood at times this season. Both sophomores Trey Guidry and Vince Greene have dished out career-high 11 assists this season. Guidry passed out the gifts at Kent State, while Greene delivered his presents against Jacksonville. Both Greene and Guidry's 11 assists were the most by a Redbird since Randy Rice's 13 dishes against Evansville on Feb. 12, 2001.

#### Second Half Resistance Has Been Futile

For the second time this season, Illinois State held its opponent below 50 percent shooting in the second half. In the Redbirds' 11 losses, ISU foes have shot 151-for-256 in the second half - for an insuperable 59%.

#### Who Ya Gonna Call?

Bracket Busters! In an effort to help "mid-major" programs bust into the NCAA Tournament field, conferences from around the country have joined forces with ESPN to form - Bracket Buster Saturday on Feb. 22, 2003. The event consists of 18 teams with one predetermined match-up with Gonzaga hosting Tulsa. The rest of the games will be announced on Feb. 1, 2003, with the intention of pitting the best-possible match-ups. By the end of the season, the 'Birds will have faced six opponents that are a part of Bracket Buster Saturday.

### **Bojang One of Valley's Elite**

Senior Baboucarr Bojang was named to the preseason all-league team at the Missouri Valley Conference's media day. Bojang claimed second-team honors in 2001-02 and joined Creighton's Kyle Korver, Drake's Luke McDonald and Southern Illinois' Kent Williams and Jermaine Dearman on the All-Valley team.

### FT Five-Peat ?

With the 77.5% effort from the line last season, the Redbirds eclipsed the 70% shooting mark for a fourthstraight season. This year the Redbirds are in line to accomplish the feat with a 71.8 percentage through the first 13 games. ISU shot 72.8% from the free throw line in 2000-01, 74% in 1999-2000 and 73.5% in 1998-99. The Redbirds have not had a stretch of five-straight seasons since it bettered 70% from 1975-1979.

### The Addition of Size, Size and More Size

On November 13, 2002, the Illinois State basketball team added 241 inches and 670 pounds to the program next season with the inking of Ronnie Carlwell (6-10, 250, Maywood, III • Proviso East), Greg Dilligard (6-8, 215, LaBelle, Mo. • Highland) and Michael Sams (6-7, 205, Mt. Zion, Ill. • Mt. Zion) on the first day of the early signing period. The Redbirds have one scholarship left to fill.

#### Redbird Flashback

Since becoming an NCAA Division I program in 1970, the Redbirds have posted a 7-2 record when playing on January 18, one of Illinois State's seven wins happened in 1971 and it is today's Redbird Flashback: Jan. 18, 1971 • Normal, III. - The Illinois State men's basketball team scored early and often as the Redbirds disposed of Central Missouri 102-63, in Horton Field House. It was the first time since becoming a Division I program that the Redbirds broke the 100-point plateau. Doug Collins led the charger with 31 points to lead five Redbirds in double figures. Myron Litwiller added 18, Dennis Murray 15, Greg Guy 12 and Jim Smith 10 as the Redbirds shot 52.5 percent from the floor going 42-for-80 on field goals.

#### **EXHIBITION 1**

#### **Greene Leads 'Birds in Exhibition Win**

NORMAL, III. – Sophomore point guard Vince Greene scored a game-high 26 points, including six three-pointers, as Illinois State won its first exhibition of the season, 89-70, over SIU-Edwardsville at Redbird Arena.

Baboucarr Bojang finished with 14 points and six rebounds for the 'Birds, while true freshman Chris Burras came off the bench to score 12.

SIU-Edwardsville was led by Ron Jones with 19 points, 17 of which came in the second half. Rob Baumgardner and Ben Garwitz each contributed 13 points, and Baumgardner also led the Cougars in rebounding with six boards. The Cougars never led in the entire game and after the initial 12-point deficit never got closer than seven points.

Illinois State opened up the game with a 12-0 run, highlighted by two three-pointers and a cross-over lay-up by Greene. The 'Birds defense forced eight Cougar turnovers in the first 12 minutes of the game, including the team's first two possessions.

Greene led all scorers in the first half with 10 points, while Gregg Alexander chipped in eight first half points on 3-for-4 shooting. ISU shot 61 percent from the field in the first half, including 5-for-8 from beyond the arc.

Down 45-24 at halftime, the Cougars came out firing in the second half and outscored the 'Birds 26-15 over the first 8:30 minutes led by nine points apiece by junior Ron Jones and freshman Logan Glosser narrowing the Redbird lead to 10. Following a timeout with 11:05 remaining in the game, the 'Birds went on a 13-0 run to extend their lead back to 23, which tied their largest lead of the night.

#### Redbirds Fall 68-53 to Utah State

**NORMAL, III.** – Trey Guidry led Illinois State with 20 points, including six three-pointers, but it wasn't enough as the Utah State Aggies spoiled the Redbirds' season opener, 68-53, Saturday night at Redbird Arena.

Vince Greene was the only other Illinois State player to score in double figures with 10, while freshman Marcus Arnold turned in nine points. The 'Birds shot only 39 percent from the field and made only one of their eight (.125) free-throw attempts.

Desmond Penigar led Utah State with 22 points, going 4-for-4 from three-point range. Point guard Mark Brown scored 19 points for the Aggies. Utah State shot 50 percent from the field in the game, including 50 percent from beyond the arc on 6-for-12 shooting.

Illinois State (0-1) got off to a slow start offensively, scoring only four points in the game's first nine minutes and dug itself into a 11-4 deficit. However, Guidry hit a three-pointer with 10:35 left in the first half that sparked a 13-5 Redbird run that gave Illinois State its only lead of the first half at 17-16. Guidry scored 11 of the 'Birds 13 points during the run, including three shots from beyond the arc.

Utah State (1-0) went on a 16-5 run over the final six minutes of the half, including holding the Redbirds scoreless for nearly three minutes, to take a 10-point lead into the locker room, 32-22. Brown ignited the Utah State run with nine points, including three lay-ups. The Redbirds came out firing in the second half, scoring 15 of their

The Redbirds came out firing in the second half, scoring 15 of their first 17 second-half points from beyond the arc. Guidry helped lead the charge with three three-pointers, while Gregg Alexander contributed two. Illinois State used the offensive surge to shred the Aggies' halftime lead and close to within two points, 43-41, with just over 12 minutes remaining in the game.

Illinois State went into a scoring draught, however, over the game's next six minutes, which allowed the Aggies to build a 10-point lead at 51-41. Penigar led Utah State during the 8-0 run with seven points. Greene scored the Redbirds' next seven points, but Utah State was able to keep Illinois State from getting any closer than eight in the game's closing minutes.

NORMAL, III. - Trey Guidry had a career-high 26 points and Baboucarr Bojang posted his first double-double of the season, but Illinois State could not get its first win falling to Chattanooga 75-68 in non-conference college hoops action tonight at Redbird Arena.

Bojang finished with a season-high 15 points and 10 rebounds, while Andy Strandmark tied his season-best mark with 11 points. Guidry shot 11for-15 (.733), including 4-for-5 from beyond the arc. The Redbirds had only 10 turnovers and 28 rebounds in the game, their best marks of the young season

Chattanooga (4-1) was led by Jason Rogan with 22 points, while Tim Parker contributed 17 points, including four three-pointers. Ray Trowell and Ashley Champion were the other two Mocs to score in double figures with 13 and 11 points respectively. Chattanooga was able to overcome 18 turnovers to get the win.

Illinois State (0-4) appeared destined for a slow start, managing only one field goal in the game's first six and a half minutes and staring at an 11-4 deficit. However, a huge block by true freshman Dana Ford out the 'Birds rolling in transition and Bojang capitalized with a thunderous, one-handed dunk with 13:12 remaining in the first half.

The dunk sparked an 11-0 Redbird run that erased the Chattanooga lead and gave Illinois State its first of the game. The Mocs recovered with an 8-0 run of their own, capped by back-to-back three-pointers from Parker. The Redbirds were able to keep the game close with lay-ups by Arnold and Guidry, but the Mocs used a 9-0 run late in the period to take an 11-point lead at 34-23, its largest of the half.

A Kevin Troc three-pointer and a fast-break lay-up off his own steal by Ford in the final two minutes helped chip into the Chattanooga lead and made the score 36-28 at halftime.

The Mocs got five quick points in the opening minute of the second half to take a 13-point lead at 41-28, but the Redbirds went on a 23-10 surge over the next ten and a half minutes led by 10 points by Guidry. With the Chattanooga offense struggling, Illinois State was able to finally take back the lead at 53-52 off a lay-up by Bojang with 8:43 remaining in the game.

NORMAL, III. - Vince Greene and Marcus Arnold each scored 14 points, but Illinois State suffered its worst defeat ever in Redbird Arena falling 76-48 to Southwest Missouri State in the Missouri Valley Conference opener for both teams.

#### Northern Iowa Edges the Redbirds, 66-64

CEDAR FALLS, Iowa – Marcus Arnold scored a career-high 19 points and Gregg Alexander chipped in 12 to pace Illinois State but it was not enough as the men's basketball team fell to 1-10 overall, 0-3 in the Missouri Valley Conference on Tuesday after a two-point loss to Northern Iowa, 66-64, in Cedar Falls, Iowa.

Leading by one point with 1:10 to play, the Redbirds let the game slip from their grasp as Ryan Paulsen of UNI hit a three pointer with :42 seconds remaining. A missed trey by Alexander and a foul by Dana Ford put Ben Jacobson at the line in the final seconds. He connected on both free throws as the Panthers (4-7, 1-2) handed ISU their fourth consecutive loss. Vince Greene hit a shot to pull within two with :16 seconds left, but that was as close as the 'Birds got.

Illinois State led 31-29 at the half off of hot shooting from Alexander, who scored eight points in the first twenty minutes, and Kevin Troc who added seven. It was the second game in a row that the 'Birds led at halftime and faultered in the second period, resulting in a loss.

Northern Iowa shot 58 percent from the field in the second half, sparked by 17 points from Jacobsen. Paulsen added 14 for the Panthers while Chris Foster tossed in 11.

NORMAL, III. – Despite trailing by only a seven-point deficit at halftime, Illinois State could not get it done in the second half as No. 16 Creighton pulled away and defeated the Redbirds, 74-55, at Saturday at Redbird Arena.

Creighton, 13-1, 4-0 MVC, had only two players score in double figures with Michael Lindeman turning in 19 and Kyle Korver contributing 17. Tyler McKinney dished out seven assists for the 'Jays to go along with his five points. Creighton shot 60 percent from the field in the game on 30-for-50 shooting, including 7-for-18 from beyond the arc.

Illinois State, 1-11, 0-4 MVC, was led by Vince Greeene with 17 points and seven assists, including 12 second-half tallies. Gregg Alexander and Marcus Arnold also turned in 13 points apiece for the Redbirds, and Arnold led the team on the boards with a game-high tying six rebounds.
