About The Game: Tonight's game is the third for the Redbirds in seven days and a rematch against Creighton, with the first meeting only occurring nine days ago in Normal, III. The 'Birds are riding a seven-game losing skid, while the Jays have won five straight.

Series History: This is the 48th meeting between the two schools and Illinois State holds a 31-16 advantage. **Last Meeting:** Despite trailing by only a seven-point deficit at halftime, Illinois State could not get it done in the second half as No. 16 Creighton pulled away and defeated the Redbirds, 74-55, at Redbird Arena. Creighton had only two players score in double figures with Michael Lindeman turning in 19 and Kyle Korver contributing 17. Tyler McKinney dished out seven assists for the 'Jays to go along with his five points. Creighton shot 60 percent from the field in the game on 30-for-50 shooting, including 7-for-18 from beyond the arc. Illinois State was led by Vince Greeene with 17 points and seven assists, including 12 second-half tallies. Gregg Alexander and Marcus Arnold also turned in 13 points apiece for the Redbirds.


THE COACHES

Tom Richardson (St. Xavier '77) is 49-56 in his fourth season at Illinois State. He is assisted by Chad Altadonna, Lance Irvin and Kirk Sarff. Richardson is 31-34 against Valley opponents, 18-22 vs. non-conference foes, 32-17 at home, 12-33 on the road and 5-6 on neutral floors.

Dana Altman (Eastern New Mexico '80) is in his ninth season at Creighton. He owns a 161-96 record with the Bluejays and is 243-163 during his 14-year coaching career.

About the Creighton Bluejays

- Creighton is located in Omaha, Neb., and enrolls 6,297 students. The Bluejays are members of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The Bluejays return 10-of-12 letterwinners and all five starters from last season's 23-9 team that reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Valley Player of the Year Kyle Korver leads the team in scoring, rebounding and steals.
- The No. 13 ranking equals the highest in school history last done in March, 1975.
- With five treys against Southern Illinois, Korver become the most prolific three-point shooter in league history.
 He now has 317 for his career.
- In addition to being the top three-point marksman in the history of the conference, Korver is also the leader in the nation among active players.
- Creighton has outscored its opponents 158-92 in the first five minutes of the game.
- The Jays have put together a 10-point run or more 18 times this season.
- The Jays have been to the NCAA Tournament four straight seasons.
- CU has made 2 or more treys in 279 straight games.
- This is the final season the Jays will play in the Omaha Civic Auditorium. Creighton owns a 425-155 mark at the Civic. Next season, the Jays will play at the \$291 million Omaha Convention Center & Arena. The new facility will hold 15,800 fans and is less than a mile from the old auditorium.

For Starters ...

Illinois State has used a number of starting lineup combinations this season. Through 14 games, the Redbirds have sent 11 different quintet combos on the floor for the opening tip.

Sending Out an S.O.S.

After being picked to finish fourth in the conference and sitting with a 1-13 overall record, the Redbirds are left feeling like they're stranded on a deserted island. However, for these castaways the cause, rather than the solution, can be found in an S.O.S. – Strength of Schedule. Illinois State's schedule ranks as the No. 26 toughest slate in the nation by Saragin Rankings and No. 51 by College RPI.

Boarding Call

Entering the game against Wichita State, the Redbirds ranked last in the Valley for rebounding (28.8), while the Shockers were first (39.3). Forty minutes later, for only the fourth time this year, the Redbirds outrebounded their opponent 34-30. Of the 34 caroms, 14 of ISU's rebounds were off the offensive glass.

Haven't Seen This Since the 2¢ Stamp

This season has been an aberration for the Redbird faithful. With the loss to Wichita State, the Redbirds are off to their worst start through 14 games since joining the Division I level. Only the 1924-25 team posted a lower winning percentage by finishing the season with an 0-14 record. The last time this sort of thing happened in Normal, Calvin Coolidge was President of the United States and Joseph Stalin was the Soviet dictator. Walt Disney also finished his first cartoon film "Alice's Wonderland" and the Washington Senators defeated the New York Giants 4-3, in the World Series.

Caging a Tiger

On Jan. 15, the Redbirds added Missouri transfer **Najeeb Echols** to their roster. Echols, who will have to sit out a year to meet NCAA transfer rules, has started practicing with the team and will eligible for competition on Dec. 13, 2003. Echols played in 10 games for the Tigers this season, averaging 3.1 points and 2.8 rebounds per game. As a freshman, he registered 2.5 points and 2.6 boards per contest. As a prep, Echols was ranked by most recruiting services among the nation's top 30 seniors. He was also a regular feature on the Fox Sports television show *Preps*, which focused on the lives of several Chicago basketball standouts.



Thus Far. Not An Average Valley Year

Since the Redbirds joined the Valley for the 1981-82 season, Illinois State has averaged 10.3 conference wins per year. Five of those 21 campaigns were just 16-game Valley schedules, while four others included only 14 games. On average, Illinois State has finished four games over .500 in league play.

Hey Arnold!

Freshman Marcus Arnold can't be seen on cable's Nicklelodeon, but he has been putting on a show against Valley opponents. In five of his first six league games of his career, Arnold scored double figures including a career-high with 19 at Northern Iowa. He is averaging a team-best 12.5 points in conference games.

A Post Pattern

Head coach **Tom Richardson** isn't looking to become an offensive coordinator for the Redbird football team. but he has called for a post pattern heading into league play. In the first eight games, posts Baboucarr Bojang and Marcus Arnold averaged 6.5 and 6.4 points per game, respectively. In the last six, Arnold is averaging 12.5 points per game and Bojang is right around the double digit mark with 9 points per contest.

Looking for the Winning 50-50 Ticket

With a win against Creighton, head coach Tom Richardson would register the 50th win of his coaching career. Richardson currently ranks 10th in victories at Illinois State with 49.

It's Easy Being Greene

Kermit the Frog might not agree, but for point guard Vince Greene it is easy when he gets his teammates involved. Greene ranks fourth in The Valley in assists with 4.2 dishes per game. In addition to distributing the ball, Greene has posted double-digit scoring efforts in six of his last eight games and ranks third on the team in scoring with 10.4 points per game.

Built Ford Tough

When freshman Dana Ford pulled down a team-high and a career-best eight rebounds at Southern Illinois, he became the first Redbird guard to grab eight caroms since Tarise Bryson equalled the feat against Evansville on March 3, 2001 in the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. Ford leads all guards and ranks fourth on the team in rebounding with 2.8 boards per game. The Tamms, Ill., native is also third on the team in league games with 3.7 rebounds per game.

Greene Means Go

Sophomore Vince Greene has had his motor running in conference play thus far this season. Through six games, Greene has only missed four three-point attempt in 15 tries. His 11 made treys in Valley games is tops on the team. In his career, Greene is shooting 24-for-46 (.522) on threes in conference play.

Consistently Inconsistent

The Redbirds have seven players that have started six or more games, but head coach Tom Richardson is still looking for a consistent scoring trend. Of the seven players, each one has scored at least nine points in a game, while also tossing in as few as three tallies in a game. The seven have also combined for 24 games where they have scored three points or less.

It's a Small World

With 6-foot-9 Baboucarr Bojang being tabbed a preseason first team All-Missouri Valley Conference selection, head coach Tom Richardson is probably surprised that his top three scorers are 6-4 or smaller. Trey Guidry (11.0 ppg.), Gregg Alexander (10.5 ppg.) and Vince Greene (10.4 ppg) are the top three tallymarkers on the team.

Greenbirds

Prior to this season, the 13 players currently on the Illinois State roster had combined for a total of 240 game played, or just 18.5 games per player, or roughly half of one season. Moreover, of the 13 now playing, seven had never played in an ISU game prior to this season and six had never played in a college game.

Time and the Minutes Are On Their Side

Just slightly less than 75 percent of the minutes (73.9%) logged so far this season (2,069 of a possible 2,800) are by players that have at least two years of eligibility AFTER this season. Three of the top four minute-getters are Gregg Alexander (439), Vince Greene (416) and Trey Guidry (365) – all sophomores.

ISU Falls to No. 16 Creighton. 74-55

Creighton, 13-1, 4-0 MVC, had only two players score in double figures with Michael Lindeman turning in 19 and Kyle Korver contributing 17. Tyler McKinney dished out seven assists for the 'Jays to go along with his five points. Creighton shot 60 percent from the field in the game on 30-for-50 shooting, including 7-for-18 from beyond the arc.

Illinois State, 1-11, 0-4 MVC, was led by Vince Greeene with 17 points and seven assists, including 12 second-half tallies. Gregg Alexander and Marcus Arnold also turned in 13 points apiece for the Redbirds, and Arnold led the team on the boards with a game-high tying six rebounds.

Creighton jumped out to an early 6-0 lead hitting three jumpers on their first three possessions, but the Redbirds answered with a lav-up by Bojang that sparked an 10-2 run by Illinois State, giving the 'Birds their first lead of the game 10-8 with 12:46 remaining before the half.

Shortly after Korver hit his first field goal of the game, a three-pointer near the top of the key, to give Creighton back the lead, 11-10, Arnold scored seven of the next 10 Redbird points to keep the game close with just over six minutes remaining. However, Korver was able to hit two treys down the stretch that helped give Creighton a nine-point advantage, 31-22, three minutes before the break. The 'Birds got a big boost heading into the locker room when Alexander hit a half-court bank shot at the buzzer to keep the Bluejay lead in single digits, 37-30.

On Guard

The Redbirds, offensively, have definitely been driven by guard play so far this season. Sophomores **Trey Guidry**, **Gregg Alexander** and **Vince Greene** have accounted for 53 percent of Illinois State's scoring this season. The threesome has also combined for 78 treys and is shooting 42.9 percent from behind the arc.

We Have a Winner

After finishing 17-14 last season, the Redbirds finished above .500 for the 29th time in 32 seasons at the Division I level. It was also the 'Birds' tenth winning season in the last 11 years.

98 Straight Games With a Trey on the Board ...

ISU enters tonight's game with at least one made 3-pointer in 98 straight games. In fact, in the **Tom Richardson** era the 'Birds have only gone one game without a made trey on an 82-43 loss at Creighton on Dec. 12, 1999. With Richardson at the helm, the 'Birds have made four or more treys in 77 of 105 games.

Second Half Resistance Has Been Futile

Only twice this season, Illinois State held its opponent below 50 percent shooting in the second half. In the Redbirds' 13 losses, ISU foes have shot 173-for-304 in the second half – for an insuperable 56.9%.

Who Ya Gonna Call?

Bracket Busters! In an effort to help "mid-major" programs bust into the NCAA Tournament field, conferences from around the country have joined forces with ESPN to form – Bracket Buster Saturday on Feb. 22, 2003. The event consists of 18 teams with one predetermined match-up with Gonzaga hosting Tulsa. The rest of the games will be announced on Feb. 1, 2003, with the intention of pitting the best-possible match-ups. By the end of the season, the 'Birds will have faced six opponents that are a part of Bracket Buster Saturday.

Bojang One of Valley's Elite

Senior **Baboucarr Bojang** was named to the preseason all-league team at the Missouri Valley Conference's media day. Bojang claimed second-team honors in 2001-02 and joined Creighton's Kyle Korver, Drake's Luke McDonald and Southern Illinois' Kent Williams and Jermaine Dearman on the All-Valley team.

FT Five-Peat ?

With the 77.5% effort from the line last season, the Redbirds eclipsed the 70% shooting mark for a fourth-straight season. This year the Redbirds are in line to accomplish the feat with a 72.0 percentage through the first 13 games. ISU shot 72.8% from the free throw line in 2000-01, 74% in 1999-2000 and 73.5% in 1998-99. The Redbirds have not had a stretch of five-straight seasons since it bettered 70% from 1975-1979.

The Addition of Size, Size and More Size

On November 13, 2002, the Illinois State basketball team added 241 inches and 670 pounds to the program next season with the inking of **Ronnie Carlwell** (6-10, 250, Maywood, III • Proviso East), **Greg Dilligard** (6-8, 215, LaBelle, Mo. • Highland) and **Michael Sams** (6-7, 205, Mt. Zion, III. • Mt. Zion) on the first day of the early signing period. The Redbirds have one scholarship left to fill.

Redbird Flashback

Since becoming an NCAA Division I program in 1970, the Redbirds have posted a 8-2 record when playing on January 20, one of Illinois State's eight wins happened in 1992 and it is today's Redbird Flashback: **Jan. 20, 1992 • Tulsa, Okla.** – Illinois State's Todd Kagel is fouled in the act of shooting a 3-point field goal with just five-tenths of one second left on the clock against Tulsa. Kagel steps to the line and calmly drops all three of his charity tosses in front of a hostile crowd to give the Redbirds a 73-72 win over the Golden Hurricane.

NORMAL, III. – Sophomore point guard Vince Greene scored a game-high 26 points, including six three-pointers, as Illinois State won its first exhibition of the season, 89-70, over SIU-Edwardsville at Redbird Arena.

Baboucarr Bojang finished with 14 points and six rebounds for the 'Birds, while true freshman Chris Burras came off the bench to score 12.

SIU-Edwardsville was led by Ron Jones with 19 points, 17 of which came in the second half. Rob Baumgardner and Ben Garwitz each contributed 13 points, and Baumgardner also led the Cougars in rebounding with six boards. The Cougars never led in the entire game and after the initial 12-point deficit never got closer than seven points.

Illinois State opened up the game with a 12-0 run, highlighted by two three-pointers and a cross-over lay-up by Greene. The 'Birds defense forced eight Cougar turnovers in the first 12 minutes of the game, including the team's first two possessions.

Greene led all scorers in the first half with 10 points, while Gregg Alexander chipped in eight first half points on 3-for-4 shooting. ISU shot 61 percent from the field in the first half, including 5-for-8 from beyond the arc.

Down 45-24 at halftime, the Cougars came out firing in the second half and outscored the 'Birds 26-15 over the first 8:30 minutes led by nine points apiece by junior Ron Jones and freshman Logan Glosser narrowing the Redbird lead to 10. Following a timeout with 11:05 remaining in the game, the 'Birds went on a 13-0 run to extend their lead back to 23, which tied their largest lead of the night.

NORMAL, III. – Vince Greene led all scorers with 16 points, but Illinois State could not pick up the victory, dropping its second and final exhibition game of the season, 66-65, to the EA Sports All-Stars Thursday night at Redbird Arena

Illinois State also got 15 points and 10 rebounds from Baboucarr Bojang, while Andy Strandmark, Gregg Alexander and Trey Guidry each contributed seven points. The 'Birds shot 54 percent from the field in the first half, but managed only 41 percent in the second half on 10-for-24 shooting.

EA Sports, 1-9, only shot 7-for-20 from the charity stripe, including 4-for-15 in the second half. EA Sports was led by former Fighting Illini player Sergio McClain with 13 points, while Doc Taylor, who played at Cleveland State, chipped in 12.

NORMAL, III. – Trey Guidry led Illinois State with 20 points, including six three-pointers, but it wasn't enough as the Utah State Aggies spoiled the Redbirds' season opener, 68-53, Saturday night at Redbird Arena.

Vince Greene was the only other Illinois State player to score in double figures with 10, while freshman Marcus Arnold turned in nine points. The 'Birds shot only 39 percent from the field and made only one of their eight (.125) free-throw attempts.

Desmond Penigar led Utah State with 22 points, going 4-for-4 from three-point range. Point guard Mark Brown scored 19 points for the Aggies. Utah State shot 50 percent from the field in the game, including 50 percent from beyond the arc on 6-for-12 shooting.

Utah State (1-0) went on a 16-5 run over the final six minutes of the half, including holding the Redbirds scoreless for nearly three minutes, to take a 10-point lead into the locker room, 32-22. Brown ignited the Utah State run with pine points, including three layaurs

State run with nine points, including three lay-ups.

The Redbirds came out firing in the second half, scoring 15 of their first 17 second-half points from beyond the arc. Guidry helped lead the charge with three three-pointers, while Gregg Alexander contributed two. Illinois State used the offensive surge to shred the Aggies' halftime lead and close to within two points, 43-41, with just over 12 minutes remaining in the game.

Illinois State went into a scoring draught, however, over the game's next six minutes, which allowed the Aggies to build a 10-point lead at 51-41. Penigar led Utah State during the 8-0 run with seven points. Greene scored the Redbirds' next seven points, but Utah State was able to keep Illinois State from getting any closer than eight in the game's closing minutes.

Greene led the Redbirds into the lockerroom with nine first-half points on perfect 3-for-3 shooting from the field, including 2-for-2 from the line.

The Huskies came out firing in the second half outscoring the 'Birds 13-4 in the first five minutes and keeping Illinois State without a field goal. Peterson hit two three-pointers to pace the NIU run. Greene hit a jumper from the left baseline to give the Redbirds their first field goal and bring ISU to within 14 points, 44-30, with 14:34 remaining in the game.

NORMAL, III. - Vince Greene and Marcus Arnold each scored 14 points, but Illinois State suffered its worst defeat ever in Redbird Arena falling 76-48 to Southwest Missouri State in the Missouri Valley Conference opener for both teams.

Illinois State (1-8, 0-1 MVC) shot only 37 percent (15-of-41) from the field in the game and Greene and Arnold were the only two Redbirds in double figures. The Birds were outrebounded 33-18 and committed 18 turnovers.

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. - Vince Greene and Trey Guidry combined for 29 Illinois State points but the SMS defense was too much for the Redbirds, who committed 22 turnovers in the game, as the Bears handed the Redbirds their fifth Missouri Valley Conference loss, twelfth of the season, in league basketball action Wednesday night at the

The Redbirds (1-12, 0-5) shot 31 percent from the field and was outrebounded 41-31, 17 of which were offensive for the Bears.

Illinois State was held without a field goal until the 11:42 mark of the first half, when Guidry connected for a three-point basket. With SMS up 9-5, the lead continued to weigh on the home side after Kellen Easley hit a trey and jumper. Up by 11 with 4:39 to play before the break, foul trouble loomed for the 'Birds and free throws were the difference. Five free throws in the final four minutes of the half helped SMS to a 13-point halftime lead, 28-15.

Illinois State never pulled to within 10 points in the second half and a foul on Marcus Arnold and Rebert Harris in the first two minutes of play put Terrance McGee at the line. He hit both free throws and SMS remained on top, 30-19, with 17:31 on the clock.

The closest the Redbirds got in the final minutes was within 12 with 3:52 to play after a made free throw by Gregg Alexander. Tamarr Maclin made sure the 'Birds got no closer than that, however, hitting two free throws of his own twenty seconds later. SMS didn't hit a field goal from the 7:36 mark on, but was 10-of-14 at the free throw line through those final minutes til the buzzer.

SMS improves to 7-6, 4-1 in the Valley and was led by 15 points from McGee, who also pulled down nine boards. Easley also contributed 14 points while Maclin had seven rebounds.

Wichita State Edges Illinois State 69-66

NORMAL, III. — Trey Guidry scored all of his team-high 15 points in the second half but his final shot rimmed out with 3.4 seconds left on the clock to shatter Illinois State's hopes to end its seven-game losing streak as Wichita State beat the Redbirds, 69-66, in Missouri Valley Conference action Saturday.

The Redbirds, 1-13, 0-6 in the Valley, had five players in double figures led by Guidry's 15. Vince Greene added 14, Baboucarr Bojang had 12, Gregg Alexander scored 11 and Marcus Arnold had 10.

Wichita State, 9-5, 4-1 in the Valley, got 20 points from Jamar Howard. Rob Kampman hit all five of his first-half shots including three three-pointers on the way to a 17-point performance for WSU, which shot 51 percent from the field vs. Illinois State's 42 percent. The Birds had a 34-30 advantage on the boards led by Bojang's nine.

WSU had a 30-28 halfitme lead thanks to Kampman's 13 points. A pair of Burns three-pointers helped WSU open a 41-37 lead in the first five minutes of the second half, but a Bojang jumper, Guidry's first basket of the game—a three-pointer—and Greene's steal and layup put the Birds on top 44-41 with 13:07 left. Miller, Randy Burns and Howard scored in succession to put the Shockers back on top by three, 47-44 at the 12:01 mark.

With Guidry hitting a pair of free throws and a three-pointer and Gregg Alexander hitting two free throws and a long two-pointer, ISU scored the next nine points to take a 53-47 lead into the final eight minutes. Another Kampman shot at the six-minute mark put the Shockers within one at 55. Howard hit a three-pointer on WSU's next drive to improve the Shocker's score to 58. Greene answered with a three-point shot of his own to put the Redbirds ahead once again, 59-58. Guidry brought the crowd of 5,970 to its feet once again with another three-point bucket at the 1.45 mark to put the 'Birds at 64-62.

Aaron Hogg answered with a three for WSU--his only basket in eight tries in the game. Guidry's driving shot with 1:18 left put the Birds back on top 66-65, but Miller scored off a set play to put the Shockers ahead to stay.
