Series History

• In a rivalry known as the "War on 74," Bradley owns a 50-42 series advantage versus its Interstate 74 rival Illinois State.

• The Redbirds own a 26-17 series advantage in Normal, including a 12-2 edge in Redbird Arena.

• Illinois State swept the 2001-02 season series and the Redbirds have won four of the last six meetings.

• Although it is not Bradley's most-played series, the rivaly versus Illinois State is Bradley's oldest, dating back to a 39-13 ISU victory during the 1904-05 season.

The Coaches

BRADLEY HEAD COACH JIM LES

• A star point guard for Bradley in the mid-80s, Jim Les is 7-12 (.368) in his first year as the head coach at his alma mater.

• As a senior in 1985-86, Les directed the Braves to a 32-3 record, the Missouri Valley Conference regularseason title and a first-round win in the NCAA Tournament while claiming the MVC Player-of-the-Year award and the Frances Pomeroy Naismith Award as the nation's top senior less than 6-feet tall.

• Following his all-star college career, Les enjoyed a seven-year NBA career.

ISU HEAD COACH TOM RICHARDSON

• Tom Richardson (St. Xavier '77) is in his fourth year as the head coach at Illinois State, following six years as an assistant to Kevin Stallings on the Redbird staff.

• Richardson owns a 50-58 (.463) career record in his first college head coaching position.

• During the 2000-01 season, Richardson's second as the head coach, he directed the Redbirds to a 21-9 overall record and a trip to the NIT.

• Despite a season-ending injury to league Playerof-the-Year favorite Tarise Bryson in the first game, Richardson guided the 2001-02 'Birds to a 17-14 mark and a third-place Valley finish.

Head-to-Head

• Saturday's game will be the first-ever head-tohead encounter between Bradley head coach Jim Les and Illinois State' Tom Richardson.

• Les did face the Redbirds seven times as a player and won the last four meetings to finish with a 4-3 record versus Bradley's I-74 rival.

• Les played before Redbird Arena was built, and as a player, Les' Bradley teams were 1-2 versus Illinois State at Horton Fieldhouse.

• Richardson owns a 4-3 record versus Bradley, including a 3-0 record versus the Braves at Redbird Arena.

About The Redbirds

• Coming off a third-place finish in the 2002 Valley standings, and picked for fourth in the league's preseason poll, Illinois State returned six lettermen and two starters from last year's team that finished 17-14 overall.

• The Redbirds endured a season-opening sixgame losing streak and snapped a nine-game slide with Wednesday's 76-71 victory versus Northern lowa.

• Illinois State is giving up 72.2 points per game by allowing its opponents to shoot 49.4 percent from the field and the Redbirds are being outrebounded by 3.6 boards per game.

• Illinois State's five starters each averaged at least 8.1 points per game, led by North Carolina State transfer Trey Guidry's 12.5 points per game.

• The Redbirds are shooting at a higher percentage from 3-point range (.430, 107-249) than they are from inside the arc (.425, 286-673).

Bradley Basketball Interview Policy

• To set up interviews with a Bradley player of member of the coaching staff, members of the media are instructed to first contact **Bobby Parker**, Assistant Athletic Director for Communications.

• Bradley Basketball players are NOT available for interviews on game days until the postgame press conference.

• The Bradley Basketball lockerroom is closed after games, but the Bradley SID staff will make requested coaches and players available to the media following the 10-minute cooling off period.

• At home, all postgame interviews will be conducted in the Press Hospitality Room at Carver Arena.

• On the road, postgame interviews will be conducted in the area designated by the host school.

Century of Celebration

• Bradley Basketball is in the second year of a three-year "Century of Celebration."

• The 2002-03 season is the 100th anniversary season since the Braves first tipped off hardwood competition Jan. 1, 1903 with a 12-8 victory versus Invincibles at Peoria's YMCA.

• Because Bradley Athletics was shut down for two years during World War II, next season will be the 100th season of competition for the Braves.

 Last season, fans selected "Teams of the Decade" and those 60 players are now eligible for the 15player Bradley Basketball "Team of the Century."

• Voting for both the "Team of the Century" and a "Greatest Games" tournament will be done online at www.bubraves.com all season.



Short-Handed Braves

• Bradley began the season with only 11 scholarship players.

• Due to a variety of circumstances, the number of available scholarship players has dropped to seven as the Braves prepare for Saturday's game.

• Sophomore center **Brandyn Heemskerk** began a medical leave of absence from the school Dec. 5, but has returned to campus and will redshirt the season.

• Freshman forward **Stevan Marcetic** left the team Dec. 18 and has transferred to Cornell.

• Sophomore forward **Danny Granger** left the team Jan. 16 and has transferred to New Mexico.

 Junior forward Jason Faulknor, who missed the season's first 15 games with a stress fracture in his right foot, made a brief two-game return before reinjuring the foot in practice Jan. 24.

• Faulknor is expected to miss at least two weeks with another fracture in the fourth metatarsal of his right foot (same bone, but different break).

Road Struggles

• Bradley ended a 13-game road losing streak with a 63-45 win Jan. 22 at Indiana State, but could failed to string two road wins together by falling at leagueleading Southern Illinois Wednesday, 75-72.

• Since posting a 7-4 road record in 1995-96 season, the Braves have managed only a 19-61 (.238) record in their last 80 road games.

• That 7-4 road record in 1995-96 included a 7-2 Valley mark, which helped the Braves to their last regular-season league title.

• Since 1995-96, the Braves are just 17-31 (.354) in Valley road games, including 1-8 marks in two of the last three seasons.

Lap One Completed Saturday

• Bradley will complete the first half of its 18-game league schedule Saturay having played each of its other nine Valley rivals once.

• Bradley has played every league opponent once in the first half of the league season only one other time (1998-99) since the league adopted its current 18game format for its 10 current members in 1996-97.

• Like the 2002-03 season, the 1998-99 Braves played five road games in the first half of the league season.

• That fifth Valley road game in 1998-99 was a 69-68 victory Jan. 20 at Illinois State.

The Last Time Out

• Sophomore forward **Mike Suggs** posted his second straight double-double with 26 points and 15 rebounds, but it was not enough to prevent Southern Illinois from rallying for its 22nd straight home victory, 75-72, Wednesday at SIU Arena.

• The Braves led by as many as 11 points in the first half and took a 41-31 lead on James Gillingham's 3-pointer to open the second half.

• SIU made 14-of-24 (.583) field goal attempts in the second half and committed only four second-half turnovers.

Scoring Difference

Jim Les promised the Braves would play an uptempo game, and through the first 19 games of the year, the points are coming at a record quicker pace.
Last year, the Braves finished last in The Valley in

scoring a 60.7 points per game.

• Through games of Jan. 29, Bradley is third in The Valley in scoring at 75.0 points per game.

• The jump of 14.3 points per game currently would go down as the largest scoring increase from one season to the next in Bradley's 99-season men's basketball history:

But The Pace Is Slowing

• Since Bradley began The Valley portion of its schedule, however, its scoring pace has slowed dramatically.

• The Braves ranked among the nation's top 20 teams in scoring through the non-conference season by averaging 82.3 points per game.

• Through the first eight Valley games, though, the Braves are averaging only 65.0 points per game.

Louisiana Lightning

• Logic held that the departure of sophomore forward Danny Granger, and his 19.2 points and 7.9 rebounds per game, would be a tremendous setback for the Braves.

 In the five games since his departure, however, Granger's first cousin, sophomore forward Mike
 Suggs (Metairie, La./Grace King H.S.), has done a remarkable job filling the void.

• In 33 career games before Granger's departue, Suggs averaged 10.5 minutes per game (he did not play 10 games), while contributing 3.6 points and 1.9 rebounds per contest.

• Over the last five games, however, Suggs is averaging 28.0 minutes and contributing 11.6 points and 7.8 rebounds per game.

• In the last two games, Suggs' averages are 36.0 minutes, 22.5 points and 14.0 rebounds.

The Granger Comparison

• While the loss of Danny Granger's 19.2 points and 7.9 rebounds per game would appear to be difficult to overcome, Bradley has won three of its first five games since Granger's departure.

• The chart at the top of the next column shows the statistical breakdown during Granger's 14 games, compared to the numbers posted during the last five games.

Bradley's "G-Men"

• While Mike Suggs' contributions in the last two games have been remarkable, the Bradley attack still begins with the duo of junior guards **Phillip Gilbert** and **James Gillingham**.

• Through games of Jan. 29, the two players are the second- and fourth-leading scorers in The Valley -- and have combined for 33.5 points per game.

• One of the two players has scored at least 20 points in 16 of Bradley's first 19 games and both went for 24 points in the Jan. 18 win versus Northern Iowa.

• Gilbert has assumed the title of team rebounding leader (5.1 boards per game) now that Danny Granger has left.

• Gillingham currently ranks third in The Valley in steals (2.05 per game) and remains one of the league's top defensive players.

Triple 30s

• With junior guard **Phillip Gilbert** joining the trio with a career-best 32 points last Saturday, three different Braves have topped 30 points in the last six games.

• Former Brave Danny Granger started the trend with 37 points in his Bradley finale Jan. 11 at Evansville.

• Junior guard **James Gillingham** scored a careerbest 34 points Jan. 15 versus Drake.

• The three 30-point games are the most in a season for the Braves since Curtis Stuckey scored at least 30 nine times during the 1990-91 season.

• Bradley has not had three different Braves score at least 30 points in a game during one season since the 1988-89 campaign when Anthony Manuel, Dion Thurman and Paul Wilson pulled off the feat.

And Quadruple 30s

• Since sophomore forward **Mike Suggs** approached a 30-point night with 26 points Wednesday, it is worth noting the Brave have never featured four different 30-point scorers during the course of a season.

• Suggs' effort, however, has given Bradley four different 25-point scorers this year.

• Bradley had not featured four different 25-point scorers since the 1988-89 campaign when Luke Jackson, Anthony Manuel, Dion Thurman and Paul Wilson each went for at least 25 points during the first six games of the season.

Gilbert Making Quick Climb

• The 38th Brave to join Bradley's 1,000-Point Club, junior guard **Phillip Gilbert** is making a quick climb up Bradley's all-time scoring list.

• Now 27th on Bradley's career scoring list with 1,127 career points, Gilbert is primed for another surge up the chart (see chart after Player Notes).

• At his current season average of 18.1 points per game, Gilbert is on pace to finish the season with at least 1,327 points, which would make him the sixth highest-scoring junior in program history.

It's Not Rocket Science

• The keys to victory for Bradley this season remain pretty simple.

• Bradley is 7-3 (.700) when shooting at a higher percentage than its opponents from the floor, but is 0-9 when its opponents own a higher shooting percentage.

• The Braves also are 0-6 when they commit more turnovers than their opponents and 3-9 when they do not outrebound their opponents.

Margins Matter

• Through the first 19 games of the season, Bradley is 7-4 (.636) in games decided by double digits, but winless (0-8) in games decided by less than 10 points.

• Four of those six single-digit losses were decided by only one basket (three points or less).

• Bradley did win its season-opener in overtime, pulling away for a 95-81 victory in the extra session.

• Among those eight single-digit defeats are five losses to Butler (16-2), Central Michigan (12-5), #15 Creighton (18-2), UNLV (12-5) and Wichita State (11-6), five teams with a combined 69-20 (.775) record.



Quick Starts

• The common denominator in Bradley's last five games has been quick starts as the Braves have raced to double-digit leads in the first half of each game.

• Versus both Drake and Indiana State, Bradley jumped to 20-4 leads.

 Versus Northern Iowa, Bradley grabbed an early 19-7 lead and in Saturday's game versus Wichita State.

• Bradley led Wichita State 40-26 late in the first half and led by as many as 11, 24-13, Saturday at Southern Illinois.

Early Signings

• Bradley signed three high school players during the NCAA Early Signing period in November and now has two scholarships available following the departures of Stevan Marcetic and Danny Granger.
