Setting the Stage

Southern Illinois clinched the #1 seed in the MVC Tournament by beating Creighton Saturday...The Salukis will play the winner of the Illinois State/Drake first round matchup... Since 1994, every team that's won at least a share of the MVC regular-season title has advanced to the NCAA Tournament, either by automatic or at-large bid.

What's at Stake

Southern Illinois has already clinched at least a share of first place and can win the Valley title outright by either beating Illinois State or a Creighton loss to Wichita State.

More importantly, the Salukis' RPI has climbed to 38, and a win over

Illinois State will boost the team's chances for an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament should it falter in the conference tournament.

15 MVC Wins

Southern Illinois, which joined the MVC in 1975, has already broken the school record for conference wins with 15.

With one more win, SIU will become just the fifth Valley team in modern history to record 16 regular-season MVC wins.

Williams At His Best

Senior G Kent Williams is leading the team in scoring (15.7 ppg) for the fourth

consecutive season. He could become the first player in school history to lead the team in scoring all four years.

Williams has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.7. He is also making 49.2 percent from 3-point range, up from his career 36.9 percent mark.

Williams, Dearman Climb Scoring Ladder

Both Kent Williams and Jermaine Dearman rank among the top scorers in school history. Williams is second in career scoring (1,944), while Dearman stands 13th (1,358). Dearman is also 7th in rebounds (76) and 10th in blocked shots (68). Williams is on pace to have the best 3-point shooting percentage in a season in school history (49.2).

Don't Forget Brooks and Hairston

Sophomore guards Darren Brooks and Stetson Hairston were named to the MVC's Most Improved Team in a vote of conference beat writers.

Brooks (12.7 ppg) has scored 20 points five times and leads the team in steals (51) and blocked shots (17). Hairston (11.4 ppg) is an athletic guard who shoots 41 percent from 3-point range and leads the team in assists and is second in steals (82).

3-Point Attack

SIU began the week ranked fourth in the nation in 3-point shooting percentage at 41.3 percent.

Two players have been especially hot lately. Stetson Hairston has made 12-of-19 attempts from 3-point range in the last five games, while Bryan Turner has made 12-of-16 shots from behind the arc in the last seven contests.

Dawg Bites

SIU has won 20 games for the second straight season and the 21st time in school history...Darren Brooks has 51 steals this season, the most by a Saluki since Marcus Timmons had 70 in the 1994-95 season.

Home Winning Streak

The Salukis have won 27 in a row at home, the fourth-longest active streak in Division I basketball behind Oklahoma (36), Western Kentucky (36) and Duke (27).

It is the second longest streak in school history.

Backcourt Triple Threat

The Salukis play a three-guard offense, and starting guards Kent Williams (15.7 ppg), Darren Brooks (12.7 ppg) and Stetson Hairston (11.4 ppg) account for 53 percent of SIU's scoring, 73 percent of its 3-pointers, and 67 percent of its assists.

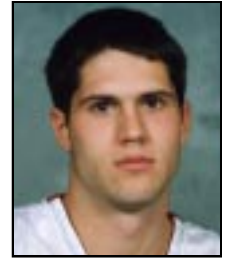
