MEETING OF THE MOST IMPROVED

Evansville and Illinois State are the only two Valley teams that have already surpassed last season's victory total. Both are three wins ahead of 2003-04. Evansville is 10-7 after going 7-22 a year ago, while the Redbirds are 13-5 after finishing 10-19. In league play, Evansville is 4-5 after going 5-13 last season, and Illinois State is 5-3 after ending up last in the MVC at 4-14.

THE FIRST GAME

Four Evansville players scored in double figures to offset a 24-point, 14-rebound performance by Illinois State's Lorenzo Gordon in UE's 69-61 win on January 9 at Roberts Stadium. Andre Burton scored 17, and Matt Webster scored eight of his 14 in a two-minute stretch late in the second half when Evansville increased its lead from two to seven points. UE outscored the Redbirds 16-8 at the free throw line.

SINCE THEN

Since January 9, Evansville is 1-3 and Illinois State is 3-0. The Aces dropped three in a row, to Southern Illinois, Bradley and Wichita State, before beating Indiana State 64-59 on Saturday. The Redbirds won at home against Drake and then won two straight on the road, at Indiana State and Creighton. Saturday's OT win at Creighton moved Illinois State into third place in the league. Evansville is seventh.

UP TO SECOND ON 3-POINT LIST
