HEAD COACH SCOTT TROST – First-year head coach Scott Trost owns a 5-4 record at the Flyer helm. Now in his 10th season as a head coach, Trost has a 157-90 (.636) career mark.

Before coming to Lewis, Trost enjoyed a very successful five-year tenure at Illinois Wesleyan where he posted a 101-37 (.732) overall record and a 50-20 (.714) mark in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin (CCIW). The Titans captured three consecutive CCIW titles (2003-05) and made four straight NCAA Division III Championship tournament appearances (2003-06) under his guidance.

The 2005-06 Titans were 25-7 and finished third in the nation; Trost led IWU to the Division III round of 16 in 2003 and 2004. He was named CCIW Coach of the Year in 2003, 2004 and 2005.

Trost tallied a 51-49 ledger in four seasons at CCIW member Elmhurst before leaving for Michigan, where he served four seasons as assistant coach before being promoted to associate head coach for the 2000-01 campaign.

THE SERIES – Illinois State leads the all-time series with Lewis 15-4. The teams last met in the 1992-93 season, with ISU claiming an 82-69 victory in Normal. The Redbirds have won the last eight meetings; the Flyers' last win in the series was a 74-69 triumph in the 1960-61 campaign.

LAST TIME OUT – The Flyers' offense was stymied last Saturday in a 57-38 loss to Grand Valley State, the No. 18-ranked team in NCAA Division II. The defeat was Lewis' third in succession following a 5-1 start.

Grand Valley State limited the Flyers to season lows in points; field goals made and attempted, and field-goal percentage (15-of-51, .294); 3-point field-goal percentage (4-of-21, .190); free throws made and attempted, and free-throw percentage (4-of-8, .500); rebounds (26); and assists (6). On the positive side, Lewis had a season-low 13 turnovers and held Grand Valley State to its second-lowest point total of the season.

Brandon Dagans (13 points) was the only Flyer to score in double figures, and he also led the team in assists (3). Stephan Bolt and Brandon Alexander led Lewis with four rebounds apiece.

LETTING HIM PLAY – Despite ranking No. 2 in the GLVC in minutes played per game, Stephan Bolt has been whistled for just 12 fouls in nine games.

ADD BOLT – The junior forward is off to a respectable start at the foul line, hitting 31-of-46 for 67 percent. Bolt made just 56 percent last season.

CONTROLLING THE BOARDS – Lewis' 37-26 rebounding deficit against Grand Valley State marked the first time this season the Flyers have been outrebounded. Lewis has won control of the boards six times and battled two other opponents to a draw. In three of the six contests in which they have earned the advantage on the glass, the Flyers have beaten their opponent by at least 12 rebounds.

LIMITING OPPONENTS' FT CHANCES – Lewis leads the Great Lakes Valley Conference in fewest free throw attempts by the opponent. The Flyers allow an average of just 13 free throws per game. Lewis averages 17.1 charity tosses and has outscored its opponents 106-81 at the stripe so far this season.

EARNING A SECOND CHANCE – Lewis has been strong on the offensive glass in the early going, grabbing at least 10 offensive rebounds in seven of its first nine games. The Flyers have 102 offensive rebounds to their opponents' 59, allowing just one opponent – Lake Superior State (10) in the season opener – to reach double figures on the offensive glass.

FLYERS IN THE GLVC STATISTICAL RANKINGS – Lewis ranks No. 3 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference in rebounding margin (+5.7/game) and is fifth in scoring defense (66.8) and blocked shots (3.22/game).

Stephan Bolt is No. 2 in total rebounding (9.4 rpg), offensive rebounding (3.33 orpg) and minutes played (32.33/game), No. 11 in scoring (15.4 ppg) and tied for No. 12 in steals (1.56 spg).

Brandon Dagans is tied for No. 7 in steals (1.67 spg), No. 15 in assists (3.56 apg) and No. 23 in scoring (12.8 ppg).

Jason Genova leads the league in minutes played (34.56/game), is tied for No. 7 in 3-point field goals (2.33/game) and tied for No. 21 in scoring (13.1 ppg).

Dustin Warfield is No. 9 in 3-point field goal percentage (.455), tied for No. 10 in minutes played (31.22/game), No. 15 in field goal percentage (.556) and No. 18 in total rebounding (5.6 rpg).

Brandon Alexander is No. 11 in blocked shots (1.11 bpg) and tied for No. 14 in offensive rebounds (2.00 orpg).

PLAYER PROFILES

#33 STEPHAN BOLT – Registered eighth career double-double (13 points, 11 rebounds) and 12th double-digit rebounding total vs. Quincy ... double-double (21 points, 12 rebounds) and career-high 39 minutes in win over Drury ... career-high 28 points (10-of-17 FG, career-best 8-of-9 FT) and Lewis season-best 15 rebounds (one shy of tying his career high) vs. Northwood ... scored then-career-high 27 points on 12-of-18 shooting (career highs in FGM and FGA), including game-winning basket at the buzzer, tied career best of three blocked shots (also tied for the Lewis season high) and added seven rebounds and three steals vs. Trinity Christian ... his 12 field goals in that game are the Lewis season high ... 13 rebounds vs. Michigan Tech ... 15 points, eight rebounds and career-high four steals vs. Lake Superior State.

#30 JASON GENOVA – Scored 18 points vs. Quincy, making 5-of-10 shots from 3-point range ... the five treys in that game are his career high and the Flyers' season high ... hit game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer in overtime to beat Drury, part of a 21-point effort ... 4-of-10 from 3-point range and career-high 42 minutes in that game ... began Flyer career with 22 points vs. Lake Superior State and Michigan Tech in his first two games ... made four 3-pointers in each game (4-of-8 vs. Michigan Tech, 4-of-10 vs. Lake Superior State) ... season bests of seven rebounds and two blocked shots vs. Michigan Tech, and four assists and four steals vs. Trinity Christian ... also had six rebounds vs. Trinity Christian.

#24 BRANDON DAGANS – Led the team with 13 points vs. Grand Valley State ... had a career-high two blocked shots and seven rebounds, just one shy of tying his career high, vs. SIU Edwardsville ... career-high 32 points, including career-high nine field goals and career-best 11-of-11 at the foul line, vs. Rockhurst ... the FT effort in that game is the best by a GLVC player this year, and the 32 points are a Lewis season high ... also had five rebounds, three assists and three steals vs. Rockhurst ... then career-high 20 points (career highs of four 3-point FGM and seven 3-point FGA), career-high 39 minutes and five assists in the previous game vs. Drury ... named GLVC Player of the Week for his efforts vs. Drury and Rockhurst ... 18 points on 8-of-12 shooting and tallied career-best and team season-high five steals vs. Trinity Christian ... the five steals in that game are tied for the most by a GLVC player this season ... 12 points, five rebounds and team season-high six assists vs. Northwood ... six rebounds vs. Michigan Tech.

#44 DUSTIN WARFIELD – Scored 12 points vs. SIU Edwardsville ... career highs of 11 rebounds and 37 minutes, and tied career best of four assists vs. Drury ... 12 points vs. Northwood (5-of-5 FG) ... 10 points and seven rebounds vs. Michigan Tech ... season-high 17 points (6-of-6 FG) and tied career high of four assists vs. Lake Superior State.

#10 MATTHEW MARINO – Has only one game in which he had fewer assists than turnovers ... played a season-high 28 minutes and logged his first start of the season vs. Grand Valley State ... tied season best of four rebounds vs. SIU Edwardsville ... eight points with season-best two 3-pointers (2-of-2) vs. Quincy ... season-best 3-of-3 at the foul line vs. Drury ... season highs of 10 points and four rebounds vs. Lake Superior State ... season-best five assists vs. Trinity Christian.

#22 KEELAN DONALD – Earned a career-high eight free throw attempts vs. Rockhurst, making five ... career highs of four assists and 35 minutes vs. Drury ... career-high nine points vs. Michigan Tech, including 2-of-2 from 3-point range ... career-high three rebounds vs. Drury, Northwood and Michigan Tech.

#23 KENDALL PATTERSON – Registered three assists in 13 minutes vs. Lake Superior State.

#32 BRANDON ALEXANDER – Three of his four rebounds vs. Grand Valley State were on the offensive glass ... tied for the team season high with three blocked shots vs. SIU Edwardsville ... season-high three steals vs. Quincy ... season highs of 10 points and six rebounds (five offensive) in just 13 minutes vs. Trinity Christian.

#12 BRANDEN HUNTER – Had a season-high three rebounds, two blocked shots and no turnovers vs. Grand Valley State ... season highs of three points and three assists vs. Northwood.

#4 MATT BOGUE – Career-high four assists in just seven minutes vs. Northwood.
