





STORYLINES

- Illinois State is beginning its 109th season of collegiate basketball. The Redbirds rank No. 42 nationally with 1,378 victories in the history of the program, the most of the four teams in the field of the Colonial Classic.
- The last three times Illinois State has began its season at an exempt tournament, the Redbirds have left with a 2-1 record to open the campaign. The last coming in 2004, when ISU played in the BCA Classic in Milwaukee, Wis.
- Head coach Porter Moser is 3-0 in season openers at Illinois State and 4-2 in his head coaching career.
- The Redbirds tied for ninth place last season in the Missouri Valley Conference, which ranked as the No. 5 conference according to College RPI. The Mustangs finished 10th in Conference USA, the 14th rated league.
- With a start in today's game, Greg Dilligard will have earned his 81st career starting assignment, which ties him for No. 13 in Redbird history with Todd Wemhoener (1990-94).

SERIES HISTORY

- Series Record – SMU leads the all-time, regular-season series 1-0.
- First Meeting – SMU defeated the Redbirds 68-58 in the championship game of the 1985 *Dallas Morning News* Classic.
- Last Meeting – Same
- Current Streak – The Mustangs have won the only meeting in the series.

THE COACHES

- Porter Moser (Creighton '90) is in his seventh season as a college coach and his fourth season at Illinois State. He owns a 90-85 (.514) career mark, including a 36-51 (.414) record with the Redbirds. Prior to guiding ISU, Moser served three seasons at Arkansas-Little Rock. Moser is assisted by Chris Jans, Daniyal Robinson and Brian Barone.
- Matt Doherty (North Carolina '84) is in his first season at SMU. Prior to leading the Mustangs, Doherty has served as the head coach at Florida Atlantic, North Carolina and Notre Dame and carries a 90-71 (.559) career mark. He is assisted by Mike Garland, Steve Lutz and Lance Irvin.

ABOUT THE SMU MUSTANGS

- SMU is located in Dallas, Texas, and has an enrollment of 10,901. The Mustangs are members of Conference USA.
- The Mustangs return 10 lettermen, including four starters, from a team which finished with a 13-16 overall record and 4-10 in the conference.
- SMU played one exhibition game this season and posted a 70-51 victory over Houston Baptist on Nov. 4.
- The Mustangs held Houston Baptist to 26.2 percent shooting for the game (16-for-61), while shooting 49.1 percent themselves, including 58.3 percent in the second half.
- SMU had three players in double-figure scoring, led by Devon Pearson's 16 points. Pearson also added 11 rebounds in 25 minutes of action. A native of Miami, Fla., Pearson will be returning to his home state of Florida for the Colonial Classic.
- Senior Ike Ofoegbu posted 14 points in SMU's exhibition win, despite shooting 4-of-13 from the field. Freshman Cameron Spencer came off the bench to score 10 points and was perfect from the floor (5-for-5).

HOME GAMES IN CAPS.

FOR OPENERS

Under head coach Porter Moser, the Redbirds are a perfect 3-0 in season-opening games. In fact, the Redbirds have won six of their last seven season-opening contests.

PACKAGE DEAL

The last time ISU faced SMU on the hardwood it was in a four-team tournament. The Redbirds and Mustangs faced off in the championship game of the 1985 *Dallas Morning News* Classic. To make it to the championship game, the 'Birds defeated McNeese State. These three teams, along with host Florida State, comprise the 2006 Colonial Classic field.

A FAMILIAR FOE

If tonight's game was played in Redbird Arena, SMU assistant coach Lance Irvin might look familiar to the hometown crowd. Especially since Irvin was an assistant coach at Illinois State under Tom Richardson during the 2002-03 season. Greg Dilligard is the only current Redbird on the roster recruited by Richardson and his staff.

DROPPING DIMES

Junior point guard Boo Richardson showcased his talent of distributing the basketball in Illinois State's exhibition win over Missouri-St. Louis, but he also gave the fans a little taste of his showmanship. Richardson was dropping dimes all over the arena and finished with seven assists and only two turnovers in 24 minutes of action.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER REVISITED

Sure it was an exhibition game and nothing will officially go on record, but the Redbirds scored 83 points. The point total in ISU's 83-58 win over Missouri-St. Louis was higher than any offensive production by the 'Birds in the last two seasons. ISU hasn't scored more than 83 points since an 87-53 win over Bellarmine on Dec. 2, 2003.

ROAD WEARY

In order to compete for the Missouri Valley Conference championship, Illinois State will need to win some games away from Redbird Arena – something the Redbirds haven't done in a while. ISU has dropped 16 straight games away from Redbird Arena, with the last victory taking place on Feb. 19, 2005, with a 79-69 win at UW-Green Bay.

200 GAMES WITH A TREY

ISU enters tonight's game against SMU with at least one made three in 200 straight games. The last time ISU didn't sink a trey was an 82-43 loss at Creighton on Dec. 12, 1999.

LITTLE O

Oscar Robertson honed his craft in the Missouri Valley Conference at Cincinnati, now Osiris Eldridge hopes to do the same at Illinois State. In the exhibition win over Missouri-St. Louis, Eldridge offered a taste of things to come. With a pair of steals resulting in break-away dunks, Eldridge finished with a team-high 13 points in 21 minutes of action. He also added four rebounds, three steals and two assists.

SLACK ATTACK

In his first appearance in a Redbird uniform, junior college transfer Anthony Slack exhibited his inside presence against Missouri-St. Louis. Slack logged only 20 minutes, but collected 10 points and 11 rebounds to register a double-double in essentially one half of playing time.

ESTABLISHING A FORTES

It took a little longer than expected, but by the end of last season Roberto Fortes started to showcase his forte -- being able to score. Despite tossing in 22 points in ISU's first 21 games of the season, Fortes finished the year scoring 96 points in the final seven games of the season.

DYER MAKER

Despite his 6-foot-11 frame, Levi Dyer's shooting range can make Redbird opponents sad, sad, sad. Last season, Dyer made five triples in two different games. In the last five games, Dyer finished the season shooting 16-for-39 on treys, or 41 percent.

TAKING THE 'NORM' OUT OF NORMAL

After finishing the 2005-06 season with a 9-19 record, the 'Birds were in the midst of an aberration. The campaign marked only the sixth losing season in ISU's 35 years of being a Division I program.

DILLIGARD JOINS CENTURY CLUB

When it is all said and done, Greg Dilligard will go down in history as one of the best defensive players to suit up for ISU. Entering his final season, Dilligard ranks No. 4 in career blocked shots with 124 and is only the fifth player to post 100 or more career blocks as a Redbird. He also finished his junior season with 62 blocks, which is second best single-season effort all-time.

THAT 70's SHOW

Under head coach Porter Moser, ISU has limited its foes to 70 points or fewer in 58 of its 87 games (66.7 percent). There is also some significance when the 'Birds reach 70 points. When ISU scores 70 or more, the 'Birds are 20-4 under Moser.

MAKING THE GRADE

The Illinois State men's basketball team set a record GPA during the Fall 2005 semester by posting a collective 2.81 GPA, topping the old mark of 2.75. The athletic department as a whole also netted a new standard during the Spring 2006 semester with a 2.99 GPA.

GONE IN 60 POINTS

It wasn't the sequel to Nicholas Cage's car thief film, but it did prove to be the recipe for success, or lack thereof, for the Redbirds last season. The formula was easy to follow. When opponents scored less than 60 points, the Redbirds were 9-6. When ISU foes scored 60 or more, the 'Birds were 0-13. It was that simple.

POINT-N-SHOOT

It wasn't just the points either; shooting percentage was also a key factor for ISU in terms of wins and losses last season. When ISU shot better than its opponent, the 'Birds were 9-3. But, when they were out shot, the Redbirds were 0-15.

JUCO ALL-AMERICA U.

Dominitrix Johnson and Keith "Boo" Richardson became the second and third junior college all-Americans respectively, to sign with ISU since Porter Moser's arrival. Richardson claimed first-team honors, while Johnson was a third team selection. The duo joins Lorenzo Gordon, who went on to earn Valley Newcomer of the Year honors in 2005.

D-FENCE, D-FENCE

In 2005-06, ISU opponents averaged 59.1 points per contest. Because of that defensive effort, it marked the first time ISU opponents had been held below 66 points per game for three straight seasons since the 1985-86, 1984-85 and 1983-84 campaigns. Also, the 59.1 points allowed ranks as the lowest in school history, topping the record of 60.2 points per game set in both the 1980-81 and 1981-82 seasons.





Redbirds Win Lone Exhibition, 60-49

NORMAL, Ill. – The newcomers made quite an opening impression for the Illinois State men's basketball team, as freshman guard Osiris Eldridge led the team with 13 points, on 3-for-4 shooting from beyond the arc, and junior-transfer Anthony Slack recorded a double-double with 10 points and a team-leading 11 rebounds in ISU's 83-58 victory over Division II Missouri-St. Louis in exhibition action Wednesday night at Redbird Arena.

Eldridge and Slack were two of four Redbirds to score in double figures as junior center Levi Dyer and senior forward Greg Diligard each chipped in 10 points a piece.

The 'Birds also had a fantastic shooting night, connecting on 57 percent of their shots, including 9-of-22 from long distance. The Redbird defense proved to be equally up to the challenge, holding the Rivermen to 33 percent from the floor and scoring 16 points off UMSL turnovers.

Illinois State opened the second half on a 17-4 run and never looked back. Junior Dominatrix Johnson poured in five points for the 'Birds during the run that put the game out of reach. The Redbirds' hot shooting touch carried over from the first half as ISU built its lead to as many as 28 points.
