

Illinois State Postgame Notes Illinois St. 81, Chicago St. 49

Nov. 27, 2007 • Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena • Normal, III.

ILLINOIS STATE INDIVIDUAL NOTES:

- Emmanuel Holloway made his first-career start at Illinois State.
- Levi Dyer's three-point basket at the 12:08 mark in the first half marked the 100th of his Illinois State career, becoming the 13th player in school history to reach the century mark in treys.
- Alex Rubin's three-point field goal at the 1:05 mark in the first half was his first made field goal since the season opener against UMSL.
- Dyer collected six rebounds in the first half, which was good for his season best. He finished with 10 boards and coupled with his 16 points, he posted his second-career double-double. It was only the second time in his career that Dyer collected 10 or more boards in a game.
- Dinma Odiakosa notched a career-high 12 points on 5-for-7 shooting.
- Senior forward **Anthony Slack** has scored in double figures every game this season. He finished tonight with 14 points. He now has 20 double-digit scoring games in his Redbird career.
- Boo Richardson dished out a season-high seven assists.
- Osiris Eldridge paced the Redbirds with 15 points. It was his fourth double-digit scoring game of the season and the 16th of his career.
- Slack's missed free throw at the 4:35 mark in the second half ended his string of eight-straight made charity tosses.
- Slack registered four steals tonight and now has 50 steals in his Illinois State career. He becomes the 47th Redbird to post 50 or more steals in a career.

ILLINOIS STATE TEAM NOTES:

- For the first time in six games, Illinois State had a different starting lineup, with Holloway replacing **Osiris Eldridge** in the starting five.
- Holloway's three-point basket at the 19:25 mark in the first half extended Illinois State's streak to 237-straight games with at least one made three-pointer.
- Illinois State's first 11 baskets had an assist attached to each of them, including five from Richardson. Of ISU's 13 firsthalf field goals, 12 were awarded assists. For the entire game, only six Redbird field goals were not accompanied with an assist.
- Midway in the first half, the Redbirds used a 25-0 run to build a 33-10 lead at the 5:53 mark. During the run, Chicago State was held scoreless for 10:21, while missing 14 field goals and committing five turnovers.
- ISU held a 39-21 advantage at halftime. It was the Redbirds' first halftime lead since holding a 23-14 edge over UMSL in the season opener.
- During a seven-minute span in the second half, Dyer (7) and Eldridge (8) combined to score all of ISU's 15 points scored during that time span.
- For the second time this season, the Redbirds had four players score in double figures with Dyer (16), Eldridge (15), Slack (14) and Odiakosa (12).
- The Redbirds have beaten Chicago State six-straight times and own a 19-1 record in the all-time series.
- For the third-straight season, Illinois State has won its first four home games.
- The Redbirds improved to 7-2 when playing on Nov. 27.
- ISU's average margin of victory in home games is now 25 points per game. The Redbirds have outscored their opponents by a combined 100 points in four home games.
- The Redbirds shot a season-best 44.4 percent from three-point range.
