## FASTBREAK POINTS

- ISU has won its last four games by an average of 25 points.
- With a win over Creighton, Illinois State would ensure that they would finish ahead of Creighton and in the top-three in the Valley.
- Illinois State won both games of the Creighton-Drake road swing last season for the first time ever.
- ISU is 2-15 all-time on the road against Creighton, with both wins coming in the last two seasons.
- Creighton beat Illinois State, 75-71, on Feb. 2, snapping the Redbirds' 14-game winning streak and giving them their first road loss of the season.
- Creighton last swept the season series against Illinois State in 2004-05.
- In each of the past four seasons, Illinois State has posted a 4-5 record in the second half of conference play. The 'Birds are 4-1 so far this season.
- Illinois State was the last Division I team to lose a road game this season.
- ISU is one of four teams in the top-10 in scoring and field goal percentage in the nation (Connecticut, Maryland, North Carolina).

## PLAYER TO WATCH

### Kristi Cirone - G



Kristi Cirone picked up her third Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week award on Monday, after averaging 18 points, six steals and four assists in two Redbird wins. She is tied with Drake forward Jill Martin for the most conference awards this season. Cirone tied her career-high with eight steals against Wichita State and scored a team-best 21 points against Missouri State. She also moved into the top-10 in career scoring at Illinois State with 10 of ISU's first 12 points against the Lady Bears.

## REDBIRDS A BIG PART OF WILDCARD WEEKEND

The second-to last weekend of Missouri Valley Conference is dubbed Wildcard Weekend, as the conference has three television slots to fill with MVC games, and Illinois State had both of its games selected for the honor. Illinois State's final two road games of the season will be broadcast on FSN Midwest, Fox College Sports and Comcast SportsNet Chicago. The Redbirds game at Creighton (Feb. 29) has been moved to 7:30 p.m. and their game at Drake (March 2) has been shifted to 2:30 p.m. to accommodate the broadcasts. The games will be broadcast live on FSN Midwest and Fox College Sports, but will be shown on tape-delay on Comcast SportsNet. The Indiana State-Creighton game on March 2 is the other Wildcard Weekend game and will be shown on ESPNU.

## SHOW THEM THE SPOTLIGHT

Illinois State is 4-0 in televised games this season. The Redbirds have been on the MVC Game of the Week twice and posted big wins in both, beating Missouri State, 95-59, and Indiana State, 91-56. Both ISU games against Bradley were shown locally on WTVP and the Redbirds posted 33-point wins in both. The Redbirds have eclipsed 90 points in three of their televised games this year.

## THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** earned her third Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week award on Monday, Feb. 25. Cirone and Drake forward Jill Martin are the only players to collect three conference awards this season. She now has six MVC Player of the Week awards in her career, putting her in a tie with Shyla McKibbin (Evansville) and Tricia Wakeley (Drake) for the fourth-most all-time. ISU and Drake lead the conference with four player of the week awards each this year.

## CIRONE ENTERS TOP-10 IN ISU SCORING

Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** entered ISU's game against Missouri State needing only nine points to tie Marla Maupin for 10th place on the Illinois State all-time scoring list. She didn't let the suspense hang around for long, making three three-pointers and a free throw in the first six minutes of the game to collect 10 points and move past Maupin for the No. 10 spot. Cirone finished the night with a team-high 21 points and currently has 1,335 points with ninth-place LuAnn Robinson (1,385) next in her sights.

## JUST WIN, BABY!

The record speaks for itself: 22-3. Illinois State is one of just 15 teams with no more than three losses in the nation. The Redbirds' 22 wins this season are tied for the sixth-most all-time with the 2006-07 squad and they reached the 20-win plateau in 23 games, the fastest any ISU team ever has. With just two more wins, the 2007-08 squad will have the second-best win total ever.

## JACKSON MOVES INTO STARTING ROLE

Freshman guard **Shala Jackson** played a pivotal part in Illinois State's success through the first 21 games of the season as the Redbirds' first option off the bench in most games. After consecutive losses, ISU switched up its rotation slightly and Jackson became a part of the starting lineup. Since then, Jackson has flourished, averaging 8.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, and shooting .414 from the field (12-29), while the Redbirds have won four-straight. Jackson scored 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting and had six rebounds against Indiana State.

## THREE-COLA!!!

One of the keys to Illinois State's success this season has been the Redbirds' ability to shoot from long range. The Redbirds lead the Valley and rank 16th in the nation in three-point field goal percentage (.381). The 'Birds have made 163 three-pointers this season, the fourth-best total in school history. All of the top-five seasons in three-point field goals in ISU history have been accumulated during Robin Pingeton's time as head coach. Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** and sophomore guard **Maggie Krick** lead the way for ISU with 48 and 44 triples, respectively. Cirone has made multiple threes 12 times this season and Krick has done so on nine occasions.

## A KEEN OFFENSIVE PROWESS

While some may say defense wins championships, Illinois State's offense has guided the team to the best start in school history. The Redbirds have the sixth-best scoring offense (78.5 ppg) and the fourth-best field goal percentage (.483) in the nation. The Redbirds have eclipsed 70 points in 23 of their 25 games this year, including three 90-point and six 80-point contests, and have won by double-digit margins 16 times. The Redbirds have already scored the 17th-most points in ISU single-season history (1,962) and are on the brink of the 16th 2,000-point season at ISU. The Redbirds's scoring average (78.5) is the best ever for an ISU squad.

### BACK ON TRACK

After having its winning streak snapped at 14 games and suffering consecutive losses for the first time this season, Illinois State jumped back on the winning track in a big way. ISU has won the last four games by an average of 25.0 points and has held three of its opponents under 60 points. The Redbirds are shooting .547 from the field (129-236), are averaging 41.5 rebounds per game and have a 1.2 assists-to-turnover ratio.

### CIRONE NAMED FINAL NOMINEE FOR THE NANCY LIBERMAN AWARD

Having already made her mark in the Valley in her first two seasons, junior guard **Kristi Cirone** has emerged as one of the elite point guards in the nation this season. She is a final nominee for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given to the nation's top-point guard. Once a part of a field of 26 players, Cirone is now among nine finalists, including Matee Ajavon (Rutgers), Kimberley Beck (George Washington), Shannon Bobbitt (Tennessee), Leilani Mitchell (Utah), Renee Montgomery (Connecticut), Andrea Riley (Oklahoma State), Kristi Toliver (Maryland) and Erica White (LSU). Four finalists will be announced prior to the Final Four and the winner will be announced during Final Four weekend. Cirone leads the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.33) and is 15th in the country in assists per game (6.1).

### ROAD WARRIORS

Illinois State is 12-1 away from Bloomington-Normal, its best road star ever. The Redbirds average 79.6 ppg and hold their opponents to just 62.1 ppg, for a scoring margin of +17.5. ISU's 64-62 loss at Northern Iowa on Feb. 7 snapped an 11-game road winning streak, which is tied for the longest in school history with the 1983-84 team. The Redbirds started the season with 11-straight road victories for the first time ever and were the last Division I team to lose a road game this season. Senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** and sophomore center **Nicolle Lewis** both perform better in hostile environments. Hudson is averaging 11.2 ppg on the road, as opposed to 8.2 ppg at home, while Lewis is posting 11.7 ppg and 5.5 rpg on the road and 7.2 ppg and 4.5 rpg at Redbird Arena. All four of the duos 20-point games this season have come in road games.

### KRICK LEADS REDBIRDS' WINNING WAYS

During ISU's current four-game winning streak, sophomore guard Maggie Krick has led the Redbirds in scoring (17.0 ppg), field goals (29) and three-point field goals (9). She also has 22 assists and just five turnovers for a team-best 4.4 assist-to-turnover ratio. Krick has excelled in conference play, scoring in double-figures eight times and increased her overall scoring average from 11.9 ppg to 12.6 ppg.

### LEEN, MEAN REBOUNTING MACHINE

Sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** has transformed herself into one of the most imposing forwards in the Valley. She has started all 22 games this season and is the Redbirds' top-rebounder (7.7 rpg). Bracey has led the Redbirds in rebounding 16 times and had a career-high 15 boards at Northern Iowa. She has scored in double-figures 12 times, including five of the last six games, after not scoring in double-digits at all her freshman season. She leads the Redbirds with five double-doubles and has the best field goal percentage (.553).

### VALLEY GIRLS

Illinois State remains in sole possession of first place in the MVC with four games remaining. The Redbirds are averaging 79.6 ppg, have scored more than 90 points in two games and are holding their Valley opponents to just 63.5 ppg. ISU leads the Valley in scoring offense, scoring margin (16.1 ppg), field goal percentage (.485), three-point field goal percentage (.396), rebounding defense (31.2), assists (18.6), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.31) and blocks (4.1) in conference games. Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** is making a bid for her second-consecutive Valley Player of the Year award, as she ranks in the top-10 in seven different categories in conference play and has won MVC Player of the Week three times during conference play. Sophomore center **Nicolle Lewis** is averaging 11.2 ppg and 5.5 rpg in Valley play after averaging 8.1 ppg and 4.6 rpg in non-conference play.

### HALF AND HALF

The Redbirds sat in first place in the Valley after the first half of the conference season with an 8-1 record, one game ahead of Evansville (7-2) and two games ahead of Creighton and Drake (6-3). It was the 11th time a team posted an 8-1 record through the first half of conference play. In the 25 years of Valley play, the team that held or shared the conference lead at the midway point won the regular season title 23 times and the conference tournament crown 11 times.

### LEWIS LEADS REDBIRD BLOCK PARTY AGAINST INDIANA STATE

Illinois State turned up its defensive intensity against Indiana State on Feb. 15; limiting the Sycamores to 56 points on 26.9 percent shooting from the field (18-67). The Redbirds also blocked 10 shots in the game, which was the fourth-double-digit total in ISU history and tied for the third-most all-time. Sophomore center **Nicolle Lewis** set the pace with a career-high seven rejections, the second-best single-game total by a Redbird, and became just the second player to record more than 100 blocks in her career.

**SETTING 'EM UP...**

The Redbirds know how to handle and distribute the basketball. ISU is ranked third in the nation in assists per game (19.1) and 18th in turnovers per game (14.2). Those stats combined create the third-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the country (1.35). ISU has recorded 15 or more assists in 22 games this season, including nine games with more than 20 helpers. Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** leads the way for the 'Birds, ranking 15th in the nation in assists per game (6.0) and first in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.33), while leading the Valley in both categories. Senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** is ninth in the nation in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.17) and sophomore guard **Maggie Krick** is 47th (1.77). They are the only trio of teammates in the top-100 in that category.

**... AND KNOCKING EM DOWN**

Illinois State has the sixth-best scoring offense in the nation (78.5 ppg) and ranks fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (.483). The top-offensive team in the Valley, ISU has five players in the top-30 in scoring and four in the top-15 in field goal percentage, more than any other Valley team. Sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** and sophomore center **Nicolle Lewis** are the top-two players in the Valley in field goal percentage, respectively, in all games and conference games.

**CREIGHTON SNAPS ISU WINNING STREAK**

With the 75-71 loss to Creighton on Feb. 2, ISU had its winning streak snapped at 14 games. The streak was the second-longest in program history, behind the 1983-84 team's 16-consecutive wins, and at the time it was ended, was the second-longest in the nation. It was the fifth-longest winning streak in Division I this season and the 32nd double-digit winning streak.

**REDBIRDS BREAK INTO ASSOCIATED PRESS TOP-25**

After receiving votes in the Associated Press poll for 10-consecutive weeks, Illinois State broke into the top-25 on Monday, Jan. 28. The Redbirds were 24th in the nation with 84 votes in the poll, five votes ahead of 25th-ranked Texas and 78 votes behind 23rd-ranked DePaul. It was the eighth week all-time that ISU has been ranked in the AP poll and the first time since Dec. 12, 1988.

**GETTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT**

Illinois State posted a 10-1 record in non-conference play this season, setting the Illinois State and Missouri Valley Conference records for non-conference wins. The Redbirds reached 10 wins faster than any other team in the history of the school (the fastest team to 10 wins under **Robin Pingeton** was the 2006-07 squad who did it in 14 games). The 'Birds reached those milestones in commanding fashion: scoring 70 points in all but one game, including the first nine-consecutive, and outscoring their opponents by an average of 13.8 points per game.

**FUN IN THE SUN DOME**

ISU won the Best Western Roundball Classic in Tampa, Fla., to claim its first regular season tournament title since the 1988 Ohio State Buckeye Classic.
