FASTBREAK POINTS

- Illinois State's 12-1 record is the best start in program history.
- ISU is one of 10 one-loss teams in Division I (Baylor, Georgia, Maryland, North Carolina, Oklahoma State, Syracuse, Tennessee, VCU, Wyoming).
- ISU's 10 non-conference wins this season are a school and Missouri Valley Conference single-season record.
- The Redbirds have had three or more players score in double-digits in every game this season. Six different players have had game-high scoring totals.
- The Redbirds have scored at least 70 points in every game this season except for the game against Western Illinois, when they scored 69. ISU eclipsed 70 points in the first nine games of the season for the first time in the history of the program.
- Illinois State has received votes in the Associated Press Top-25 poll the past seven weeks and has received votes in the ESPN/USA Today/WBCA Coaches Poll for the past two.
- ISU was picked second in the MVC preseason poll, its highest selection since 1989-90. The 'Birds also received 12 first place votes, their most ever.

PLAYER TO WATCH

Kristi Cirone-G



Cirone was named MVC Player of the Week after averaging 20.0 points and 6.0 assists in the last three games. Against Northern Illinois in the non-conference finale, Cirone posted 12 points and five assists. She scored a game-high 21 points against Evansville, including 12 points during a pivotal 22-6 Redbird run. She followed that performance with 27 points, one shy of her career-high, and seven assists against Southern Illinois. It was her first back-to-back 20-point performances since Feb. 12 and 18, 2007. She leads the Valley in scoring (24.0 ppg) and assists (6.5 apg) and is off to the best start to conference play in her career. Cirone was 19-for-21 from the free throw line over the three games and became the fourth player in ISU history to amass more than 300 career free throws (311).

CIRONE NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** picked up her fourth Valley Player of the Week accolade on Jan. 7 after she got off to the best start in conference play of her career. Cirone averaged 20.0 ppg and 6.0 apg in three contests the previous week. When Missouri Valley Conference play began, the reigning player of the year brought her game to an even higher level, averaging 24.0 ppg and 6.5 apg while leading the Redbirds to a pair of wins. Cirone scored 21 points against Evansville, including 12 during a pivotal 22-6 run in the second half. Against Southern Illinois, she came within a point of tying her career-high with 27 points to go along with seven assists. She was 10-for-11 from the free throw line in the game and made two free throws in the final 11 seconds to help seal the victory.

HUDSON HAS BIG WEEKEND

Senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** continued her remarkable final season with two big games to open Valley play. Hudson had nine points and five assists against Evansville and 19 points and six assists against Southern Illinois. She scored seven points in the final three minutes against the Salukis, including a pair of free throws with five second left that iced the win for ISU. She has recorded five or more assists in each of the last four games.

GETTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

For the first time in program history, Illinois State is 12-1. The Redbirds reached 10 wins faster than any other team in the history of the school (the fastest team to 10 wins under **Robin Pingeton** was the 2006-07 squad who did it in 14 games) and their 10 non-conference wins are an Illinois State and Missouri Valley Conference record. The 'Birds reached those milestones in commanding fashion: scoring 70 points in all but one game, including the first nine-consecutive, and outscoring their opponents by an average of 13.8 points per game.

REDBIRDS DON'T BREAK STRIDE

After starting the season 4-0 for just the second time in program history, ISU suffered its first loss of the season to nationally-ranked DePaul, 80-75. The loss did not slow down the Redbirds, however, as they are on an eight-game winning streak since then. Over the last seven games, ISU is averaging 77.2 ppg and is outscoring its opponents by an average of 16.0 points per game. The Redbirds are shooting .482 from the field and hold a 9.1 rebounding margin over their opponents.

DON'T HACK THE 'BIRDS

One of the major factors for ISU's recent eight-game winning streak has been the team's success at the free throw line. Over the first five games of the season, the Redbirds shot .637 from the free throw line (58-91). Over the past eight games, that percentage has risen to .805 (70-88). ISU was a perfect 10-for-10 from the charity stripe against Ball State. Against Evansville, the Redbirds were 16-of-18 from the free throw line and Cirone, senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** and sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** each made a pair of free throws in the final minute to seal the victory. In the win over Southern Illinois, the Redbirds made a season-high 25 free throws in 30 attempts. In the second half, they were 19-for-22 and made their first 12 free throws. Sophomore **Nicolle Lewis** has made her last 16-consecutive free throws with perfect performances against Ball State (6-6), Miami (8-8) and Western Illinois (2-2). She has improved her season free throw percentage from .500 (7-14) to .767 (23-30).

REDBIRDS RECEIVE NATIONAL ATTENTION

Illinois State's strong start to the season has garnered some national attention. ISU has received votes in the last eight Associated Press Top-25 polls. In the poll released on Tuesday, Jan. 8, the Redbirds received 16 votes, putting them at No. 30 in the nation. For the past three weeks, ISU has received votes ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll, and is currently tied with Florida State, Liberty and Xavier for 41st in the nation with three votes. In the latest CollegeRPI.com rankings (Jan. 8), Illinois State came in at 44, the highest Valley team, and has been as high as 22 this season.

ROAD WARRIORS

Illinois State is 8-0 away from Bloomington-Normal, its best road start ever. The Redbirds average 77.8 ppg and have a 13.5 scoring margin on the road. Senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** performs much better on the road, averaging 14.9 ppg as opposed to 10.0 ppg in Redbird Arena. Both of her 20-point games this season were on the road and 17 of her 22 three-point field goals on the season have come in road contests.

WHAT SOPHOMORE JINX?

The ISU sophomore class is proving that there is no drop off between the first and second season. Center **Nicolle Lewis**, forwards **Ashleen Bracey** and **Kenyatta Shelton**, and guard **Maggie Krick** are making an impact in their second full seasons. Together, the quartet has provided 41.5 percent of the team's scoring, 55.9 percent of its rebounding and is shooting .725 (174-240) from the field. Bracey, Krick and Lewis are all in the top-five on the team in scoring and are the Redbirds' top-three rebounders. Shelton is coming back from offseason knee surgery and has increased her productivity every game.

INSIDE TRACK

As strong as the Redbirds have been on the perimeter this season, their play in the paint has been equally as impressive. ISU has averaged 33 points in the paint per game so far this year. In the last seven games, the 'Birds have struggled from the outside with a .321 three-point shooting percentage (34-106) and have begun to move the ball inside and score more in transition. During that stretch, ISU is averaging 33.4 points in the paint per game, while its opponents are averaging just 21.4 ppg. Against Ball State, the Redbirds held a 50-14 advantage in points in the paint over the Cardinals.

LEEN, MEAN REBOUNDING MACHINE

Sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** has transformed herself into one of the most imposing forwards in the Valley. After not seeing the playing time she would have liked as a freshman, Bracey hit the gym hard over the summer, improving her game and her physique. All of the hard work has paid off as Bracey has started all 13 games this season and is the Redbirds' top-rebounder (8.5) and ranks second in the Valley. Bracey has led the Redbirds in rebounding 10 times, including a career-high 12 against Southern Illinois. She has been the catalyst for the 'Birds during their current eight-game winning streak, leading the team in rebounding (9.5) and field goal percentage (.640), while averaging 13.3 ppg. She has recorded four double-doubles and scored in double-figures six times during that stretch.

SETTING 'EM UP...

The Redbirds know how to handle and distribute the basketball. ISU is ranked fifth in the nation in assists per game (19.4) and is 20th in turnovers per game (14.8). Those stats combined create the fourth-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the country (1.31). Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** leads the way for the 'Birds, ranking seventh in the nation in assists per game (7.0) and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.00), while leading the Valley in both categories. She isn't the only one taking care of the rock; senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** is 66th in the nation in assists-to-turnover ratio (1.74) and three other Redbirds have positive assist-to-turnover ratios on the season: junior guard **Brooke Singleton** (1.4), sophomore guard **Maggie Krick** (1.4) and freshman guard **Amanda Clifton** (1.7).

... AND KNOCKING EM DOWN

Illinois State has the No. 12 scoring offense in the nation (77.3 PPG) and also leads the Valley in field goal percentage (.481). The top-offensive team in the conference, ISU has six players in the top-30 in scoring and five players in the top-15 in field goal percentage, more than any other Valley team. Sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** leads the Valley in field goal percentage (.575) and sophomore center **Nicolle Lewis** is right behind her in third place (.563).

KEEPING OF THE GUARD

Strong guard play has been a staple of recent Redbird teams and that has never been more true than this season as the 'Birds have a guard in every class stepping up big. Senior **Tiffany Hudson**, junior **Kristi Cirone**, sophomore **Maggie Krick** and freshman **Shala Jackson** are four of the top-six scorers on the team. The quartet has combined for 635 points (63.2% of the team's total), 73 three-point field goals (89.0%), 183 rebounds (39.4%), 187 assists (74.2%) and 54 steals (68.4%). Each of the four players ranks in the top-30 in the Valley in scoring.

SECOND TO NONE

Illinois State has used the same starting lineup the entire season and those players are each averaging more than 21 minutes per game, but that doesn't mean that the rest of the roster isn't making an impact. The Redbird bench is averaging 18.0 ppg and has outscored the opponents non-starters nine times. ISU is 8-1 when its bench outscores the opponents. Against Loyola, the Redbird bench scored 40 of the team's 82 points, on a 15-for-37 performance from the field (.405), and had 30 rebounds and nine assists. Junior forward **Brea Banks** scored a career-high 13 points on 5-for-5 shooting. In the Redbird win over Northern Illinois, the bench contributed 27 points to just nine for the Huskies.

REDBIRD CONFERENCE HONORS

Freshman guard **Shala Jackson** was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 19 after averaging 14.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per game in three Redbird wins. Jackson scored a career-high 20 points to lead the Redbirds to their first ever win over Green Bay. Sophomore forward **Ashleen Bracey** earned the Valley Player of the Week award after posting a double-double of with 16 points and and a career-high tying 11 rebounds against Miami (Ohio).

FUN IN THE SUN DOME

ISU won the Best Western Roundball Classic in Tampa, Fla., to claim its first regular season tournament title since the 1988 Ohio State Buckeye Classic. Senior guard **Tiffany Hudson** was named the MVP after averaging 19.0 points over the two games. Junior guard **Kristi Cirone**, sophomore guard **Maggie Krick** and freshman guard **Shala Jackson** were all named to the all-tournament team, giving the Redbirds four of the six honors at the tournament.

CIRONE ACHIEVES SCORING MILESTONE

Junior guard **Kristi Cirone** made a 18-foot jumper as the horn sounded at the end of the first half against DePaul that cut the Redbirds' halftime deficit to eight points, but also held even greater significance. Thhsroe two points gave Cirone 1,001 in her career at Illinois State, making her the 23rd player in program history to reach quadruple digits in points. Cirone became the seventh junior and the eighth non-senior to reach the 1,000 point plateau. She finished the game with 25 points and is currently in 22nd place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,042.

FRESHMEN MAKE IT OFFICIAL

Two members of the Illinois State freshman class officially etched their names into the ISU basketball record books in the season opener. Forward **Danielle Calef** and guard **Shala Jackson** both saw action against Eastern Illinois in their first collegiate games. Calef was the first sub off the bench for ISU and made her first-career jump shot 16 seconds into the action. She finished the night with five points, two rebounds and two assists. Jackson was the Redbirds' third-leading scorer with 10 points. She was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line and filled out her stat line with two rebounds, an assists, a block and a steal. Classmate guard **Amanda Clifton** saw her first action in the final minute against Green Bay after missing the opener with a knee injury. Forward **Taylor Lawless**, who is rehabilitating a knee injury with assistant athletic trainer **Karri Miller**, is schedule to redshirt the 2007-08 season.

BROADWAY, HELLICKSON SIGN NLI'S TO JOIN WOMEN'S HOOPS PROGRAM

Continuing a trend of successful and impactful recruiting, head coach **Robin Pingeton** and her staff had two recruits sign National Letters of Intent to play at ISU on Friday, Nov. 16. Guard **Katie Broadway** (Beltatho, Ill.) and forward **Danielle Hellickson** (St. Louis, Mo.) will make up the Class of 2012 and begin their eligibility in 2008-09. Broadway is already the all-time leader in points and steals at Civic Memorial High School and is a three-time all-conference selection. Hellickson transferred to Incarnate Word last year after two all-conference seasons at Tower Grove Christian. She averaged 4.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game as a key reserve for the Red Knights.

REDBIRDS TABBED SECOND IN MVC PRESEASON POLL

In the 2007-08 Missouri Valley Conference preseason poll, the Illinois State Redbirds were projected to finish in second place. The Redbirds received received 342 votes, including 12 first-place votes. The second place pick was the highest the Redbirds have been projected since 1989-90 and the 12 first place votes were their most ever.

THE REDBIRDS-PANTHERS SERIES

Illinois State leads the all-time series with Northern Iowa, 32-20. After losing the first meeting in 1976, the Redbirds won 28 of the next 30 games against the Panthers, including a string of 22-consecutive victories. Since then, UNI has exacted its revenge with 17 wins in the last 21 meetings, including a 74-73 overtime victory at Redbird Arena last season. ISU is 3-7 against UNI in the four years that head coach **Robin Pingeton** has been at the helm.

Northern Iowa senior Tara King poured in a game-high 31 points, including the go-ahead jumper with 5.5 seconds remaining, to lift the visiting Panthers to a 74-73 overtime win over Illinois State. It was ISU's first overtime game of the season.

Nicolle Lewis scored a career-high 26 points to go along with a game-high nine rebounds. **Kristi Cirone** finished with 19 points and nine assists, and did not commit a single turnover. King's 31 points led the UNI scoring output, while Jessie Biggs contributed 17 points, and Lindsey Swanson chipped in 10 points on a perfect 3-for-3 shooting effort off the Panther bench.

Illinois State overcame a combined five ties and lead changes in the initial 13 minutes of the first half, and strung together a 13-4 run to end the stanza, taking a 34-25 lead at halftime. Despite Northern Iowa's quick start to the second half, the Redbirds owned a seven-point lead with 5:04 remaining in the game, but the Panthers ended regulation on an 11-4 spurt. In the extra period, Cirone scored eight points, but her potential game-winning driving jump shot as time expired circled the rim and missed, giving UNI the one-point win.

Driving Directions to Redbird Arena: Bloomington-Normal is located at the convergence of Interstates 55 (Chicago to St. Louis), 74 (Indianapolis to Iowa) and 39 (north to Rockford). From I-55, take exit 165, U.S. 51-South Main St., south to College Ave. From I-39, exit at I-55 east, and the first exit is 165. From I-74, follow I-55 North to exit 165. From the airport, turn left on Empire (Rt. 9) for approximately two miles, right on Veterans Parkway for approximately four miles, left on College Ave. for approximately six miles. Redbird Arena is at the corner of College Ave. and Main St., two miles south of exit 165.
