Kristi Cirone-G


Cirone has been named the Valley Player of the Week after the first two weeks of conference play. It is the first time in her career that she has earned back-to-back conference honors and she is the 15th player all-time to be honored in consecutive weeks. Cirone scored 20 points in each of the first three Valley games this year; marking just the second time in her career she had three-consecutive 20 -point games. She leads the Valley in scoring in conference games ( 22.0 ppg )) and ranks in the top-10 in five other categories. She has led the Redbirds in scoring in every Valley game and is shooting better than 60 percent overall and from three-point range.

## BIG THREE FOR KRICK

Sophomore guard Maggie Krick is only midway through her second season at ISU, but she has already established herself as one of the biggest threats from beyond the arc in program history. Krick made three trifectas against Bradley and became the 15th player in school history to amass 50 three-pointers in her career.

## VALLEY GIRL

Junior guard Kristi Cirone is making a bid for another MVC Player of the Year award with her performance in the beginning of conference play this season. Cirone leads the Valley in scoring ( 22.0 ppg ) and is third in assists ( 5.0 apg ), three-point field goal percentage (.611) and free throw percentage (.950), fourth in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.86), eighth in field goal percentage (.617) and 13th in steals (1.7 spg). She has been named Valley Player of the Week in each of the first two weeks of conference play. Cirone eclipsed 20 points in each of the first three Valley games this season for just the second time in her career and her 24.3 point average over those games is the best scoring stretch of her career. After leading the Redbirds in scoring just twice in the non-conference schedule, Cirone has been atop the ISU scoring column in all four conference games.

## HUDSON LENDS A HELPING HAND

Senior guard Tiffany Hudson has recorded five or more assists in each of the last six games, the first such streak of her career. Over the last six games, Hudson's scoring production has dropped off, but she has accumulated more assists than she did in the first nine games of the season and has increased her assist average from 2.9 to 3.9 .

## JACKSON IS OFFENSIVE ON THE GLASS

Freshman guard Shala Jackson is a talented offensive player with her ability to drive and shoot, but she has also shown a knack for tracking down offensive rebounds. Of her 58 rebounds on the season, nearly half (28) have come after her teammates have missed shots.

## WE'RE GOING STREAKINGI

After starting the season 4-0 for just the second time in program history, ISU suffered its first loss of the season to nationally-ranked DePaul, 80-75. The loss did not slow down the Redbirds, however, as they are on a 10-game winning streak since then, tied for the fourth-best in school history. It is the fifth double-digit winning streak in school history. Over the last 10 games, ISU is averaging 78.6 ppg and is outscoring its opponents by an average of 18.2 points per game. Southern Illinois is the only team to score more than 70 points against ISU during the streak and five teams have been held under 60 points. The Redbirds are shooting .494 from the field and hold an 8.8 rebounding margin over their opponents.

## DON'T HACK THE 'BIRDS

One of the major factors for ISU's recent eight-game winning streak has been the team's success at the free throw line. Over the first five games of the season, the Redbirds shot . 637 from the free throw line (58-91). Over the past 10 games, that percentage has risen to .779 (116-149). ISU was a perfect 10 -for-10 from the charity stripe against Ball State. Against Evansville, the Redbirds were 16 -of-18 from the free throw line and Cirone, senior guard Tiffany Hudson and sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey each made a pair of free throws in the final minute to seal the victory. In the win over Southern Illinois, the Redbirds made a season-high 25 free throws in 30 attempts. In the second half, they were 19-for-22 and made their first 12 free throws. Sophomore Nicolle Lewis made a string of 19-consecutive free throws, including perfect performances against Ball State ( $6-6$ ), Miami ( $8-8$ ) and Western Illinois (2-2). She has improved her season free throw percentage from $.500(7-14)$ to .767 (23-30).

## GETTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

Illinois State posted a 10-1 record in non-conference play this season, setting the Illinois State and Missouri Valley Conference records for non-conference wins. The Redbirds reached 10 wins faster than any other team in the history of the school (the fastest team to 10 wins under Robin Pingeton was the 2006-07 squad who did it in 14 games).. The 'Birds reached those milestones in commanding fashion: scoring 70 points in all but one game, including the first nine-consecutive, and outscoring their opponents by an average of 13.8 points per game.

## a KEEN OFFENSIVE PROWESS

While some may say defense wins championships, Illinois State's offense has guided the team to the best start in school history. The Redbirds have the ninth-best scoring offense in the nation ( 78.2 ppg ) and the fourth-best field goal percentage (.490). The Redbirds have eclipsed 70 points in 14 of 15 games this year, and scored 69 in the other game. ISU scored a season-high 94 points against Bradley, has surpassed 80 points four other times and has won by a double-digit margin 11 times.

## REDBIRDS RECEIVE NATIONAL ATTENTION

Illinois State's strong start to the season has garnered some national attention. ISU has received votes in the last nine Associated Press Top-25 polls. In the poll released on Tuesday, Jan. 15, the Redbirds received a season-high 26 votes, putting them at No. 30 in the nation. For the past three weeks, ISU has received votes ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll, and is currently tied with Florida State, Liberty and Xavier for 41st in the nation with three votes. In the latest CollegeRPI.com rankings (Jan. 8), Illinois State came in at 36, the highest Valley team, and has been as high as 22 this season.

## ROAD WARRIORS

Illinois State is 9-0 away from Bloomington-Normal, its best road start ever and the third-longest road winning streak in program history. The Redbirds average 77.8 ppg and have a 13.5 scoring margin on the road. Senior guard Tiffany Hudson performs much better on the road, averaging 14.9 ppg as opposed to 10.0 ppg in Redbird Arena. Both of her 20-point games this season were on the road and 17 of her 22 three-point field goals on the season have come in road contests.

## WHAT SOPHOMORE JINK?

The ISU sophomore class is proving that there is no drop off between the first and second season. Center Nicolle Lewis, forwards Ashleen Bracey and Kenyatta Shelton, and guard Maggie Krick are making an impact in their second full seasons. Together, the quartet has provided 41.3 percent of the team's scoring, 55.7 percent of its rebounding and is shooting . $726(201-277)$ from the field and $.822(60-73)$ from the free throw line. Bracey, Krick and Lewis are all in the top-six on the team in scoring and are the Redbirds' topthree rebounders. Shelton is coming back from offseason knee surgery and has increased her productivity every game.

## LEEN, MEAN REBOUNDING MACHINE

Sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey has transformed herself into one of the most imposing forwards in the Valley. She has started all 15 games this season, after averaging just 5.3 minutes per game in 16 games last season, and is the Redbirds' top-rebounder ( 8.3 rpg ). Bracey has led the Redbirds in rebounding 11 times, including a career-high 12 against Southern Illinois. She has been one of the catalyst for the 'Birds during their current 10-game winning streak, leading the team in rebounding (9.0) and field goal percentage (.625), while everaging 12.0 ppg . She has recorded four double-doubles and scored in double-figures seven times during that stretch.

## SETTING 'EM UP...

The Redbirds know how to handle and distribute the basketball. ISU is ranked fifth in the nation in assists per game (19.4) and is 20th in turnovers per game (14.8). Those stats combined create the fourth-best assist-toturnover ratio in the country (1.31). ISU has recorded 15 or more assists in every game this season, including five games with more than 20 helpers. Junior guard Kristi Cirone leads the way for the' Birds, ranking eighth in the nation in assists per game (6.5) and second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.97), while leading the Valley in both categories. She isn't the only one taking care of the rock; senior guard Tiffany Hudson is 30th in the nation in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.03) and sophomore guard Maggie Krick ranks 85th (1.61)

## ... AND KNOCKING EM DOWN

Illinois State has the No. nine scoring offense in the nation (78.2 PPG) and ranks fourth in the nation in field goal percentage (.490). The top-offensive team in the Valley, ISU has six players in the top-30 in scoring and five players in the top-15 in field goal percentage, more than any other Valley team. Sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey (.571) and sophomore center Nicolle Lewis (.570) rank second and third in the conference in field goal percentage, respectively.

## KEEPING OF THE GUARD

Strong guard play has been a staple of recent Redbird teams and that has never been more true than this season as the 'Birds have a guard in every class stepping up big. Senior Tiffany Hudson, junior Kristi Cirone, sophomore Maggie Krick and freshman Shala Jackson are four of the top-six scorers on the team. The quartet has combined for 729 points ( $62.1 \%$ of the team's total), 87 three-point field goals ( $86.1 \%$ ), 203 rebounds ( $38.1 \%$ ), 214 assists ( $72.5 \%$ ) and 61 steals ( $64.2 \%$ ). Each of the four players ranks in the top- 30 in the Valley in scoring.

## SECOND TO NONE

Illinois State has used the same starting lineup the entire season and those players are each averaging more than 21 minutes per game, but that doesn't mean that the rest of the roster isn't making an impact. The Redbird bench is averaging 18.0 ppg and has outscored the opponents non-starters nine times. ISU is 11-1 when its bench outscores the opponents. Against Loyola, the Redbird bench scored 40 of the team's 82 points, on a 15 -for- 37 performance from the field (.405), and had 30 rebounds and nine assists. In the Redbird win over Northern Illinois, the bench contributed 27 points to just nine for the Huskies. Against Bradley, the Redbird non-starters again poured in 40 points, nearly half of the team-s season-high 94 total.

## REDBIRD CONFERENCE HONORS

Freshman guard Shala Jackson was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 19 after averaging 14.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per game in three Redbird wins. Jackson scored a career-high 20 points to lead the Redbirds to their first ever win over Green Bay. Sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey earned the Valley Player of the Week award after posting a double-double of with 16 points and and a career-high tying 11 rebounds against Miami (Ohio). Junior guard Kristi Cirone back-to-back conference honors after averaging 22.0 ppg in the first two weeks of Valley play.

## FUN IN THE SUN DOME

ISU won the Best Western Roundball Classic in Tampa, Fla., to claim its first regular season tournament title since the 1988 Ohio State Buckeye Classic. Senior guard Tiffany Hudson was named the MVP after averaging 19.0 points over the two games. Junior guard Kristi Cirone, sophomore guard Maggie Krick and freshman guard Shala Jackson were all named to the all-tournament team, giving the Redbirds four of the six honors at the tournament.

## CIRONE ACHIEVES SCORING MILESTONE

Junior guard Kristi Cirone made a 18 -foot jumper as the horn sounded at the end of the first half against DePaul that cut the Redbirds' halftime deficit to eight points, but also held even greater significance. Thhsoe two points gave Cirone 1,001 in her career at Illinois State, making her the 23rd player in program history to reach quadruple digits in points. Cirone became the seventh junior and the eighth non-senior to reach the 1,000 point plateau. She finished the game with 25 points and is currently in 22nd place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,042 .

## BROADWAY, HELLICKSON SICN NLI'S TO JOIN WOMEN'S HOOPS PROGRAM

Continuing a trend of successful and impactful recruiting, head coach Robin Pingeton and her staff had two recruits sign National Letters of Intent to play at ISU on Friday, Nov. 16. Guard Katie Broadway (Beltatho, III.) and forward Danielle Hellickson (St. Louis, Mo.) will make up the Class of 2012 and begin their eligibility in 2008-09. Broadway is already the all-time leader in points and steals at Civic Memorial High School and is a three-time all-conference selection. Hellickson transferred to Incarnate Word last year after two all-conference seasons at Tower Grove Christian. She averaged 4.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game as a reserve

## redbirds tabbed second in mve preseason poll

In the 2007-08 Missouri Valley Conference preseason poll, the Illinois State Redbrids were projected to finish in second place. The Redbirds received received 342 votes, including 12 first-place votes. With the win, Indiana State earned a regular season split with the Redbirds, who captured an 89-81 win at the Hulman Center on Jan. 19.

Despite slow offensive starts by both teams, the Redbirds and Sycamores were deadlocked at 12-12 through the first eight and a half minutes. Megan McCracken hit two three-pointers in the stretch, while Maenpaa chipped in six quick points to lead the early Indiana State attack. The Sycamores broke a $21-21$ tie with a quick 5-0 spurt, and claimed a 26-21 advantage after back-to-back free throws by Maria Olsthoorn. After Cirone pulled the Redbirds within two (27-25) with 3:13 left, Indiana State finished the frame on an 8-4 spree. Illinois State's Lori Trumblee hit a jumper as time expired in the half to pull the `Birds within six, 35-29.
