For the second-consecutive weekend, Kristi Cirone averaged 18.0 ppg in two Redbird games. Cirone scored 17 points against Creighton and 19 against Drake, leading the Redbirds in scoring both games. In ISU's meeting with SIU in Carbondale earlier this season, Cirone scored a season-high 27 points on 8-of-14 shooting and a 10-for-11 performance from the free throw line, and had seven assists.

## AND DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME

Heading into the final weekend of play in the Missouri Valley Conference, no seeds for the State Farm MVC Women's basketball Tournament are set. One thing is for certain, Illinois State, Evansville, Creighton and Drake will be the top-four seeds in the tournament. Any of those four teams could claim the top-seed with two games left. Here are some tournament notables:

- If ISU wins both games this weekend...The Redbirds would at least have a share of the conference title. Winning out would put ISU in first place and clinch the top-seed in the tournament, regardless of the Evansville-Indiana State outcome. If the Aces beat the Sycamores, then ISU and UE would share the regular season crown and the Redbirds would have the top-weed in the tournament by virtue of beating the Aces twice in the regular season. If the Sycamores top the Aces, the title is ISU's outright.
- If ISU loses to Southern Illinois...The Evansville-Indiana State outcome becomes far more significant. If ISU falls to SIU and Evansville beats Indiana State, then Evansville would claim the regular season title and the top-seed. If the Sycamores knock off the Aces, then the winner of the ISU-UE game would be in first place. Evansville would win the title outright, but ISU would at least be tied with the Aces and possibly Creighton and Drake as well.
- If ISU beats SIU and loses to Evansville...The Redbirds would be 13-5 in conference and would finish second in the conference. Creighton and Drake could tie ISU for second place if either wins their final two games. Creighton holds the tiebreaker over ISU by sweeping the season series; while the ISU-Drake tiebreaker depends on how the Redbrids fare against Evansville.
- If ISU loses both games...ISU would fall to 12-6 in the conference and could finish anywhere from second to fourth, depending on what Creighton and Drake do. Two Redbird losses would make Evansville the regular season champion.
- Evansville controls its own destiny...With a one-game lead and two games remaining, Evansville is comfortable, but still has come challenges. Evansville is the only team that can win both games this weekend and claim the regular season conference title, regardless of what else happens. The Aces can lose the conference championship by losing their last two games and having either ISU win both or Creighton win both and ISU lose once.
- Creighton still in the hunt...Creighton is tied with Drake for third place in the conference with an 11-5 record. The Bluejays need to win their remaining two games against Wichita State and Missouri State and have ISU lose at least once and Evansville lose twice. If Evansville wins either of its remaining games, both Creighton and Drake would be eliminated from contention for the regular season championship.
- Drake has chance at regular season title...Drake can claim a share of the regular season title, but can't receive the top-seed in the tournament after being swept by Evansville in the regular season. The Bulldogs need to win their final two games, have Evansville lose twice and have ISU and Creighton lose at least once to take a piece of the regular season crown.


## REDBIRDS HIT ANOTHER LOSING SKID

For just the second time this season, Illinois State is on a losing streak. The Redbirds have lost their last two games, a skid that is tied for the longest of the season. The Redbirds went winless in the Creighton-Drake road swing last weekend and were outscored by an average of just 4.5 ppg . The Redbirds shot just .417 (55-132) from the field, including . 250 (8-32) from three-point range and had a -9.0 rebounding margin. ISU is 4-4 over its last eight games, all in MVC play. Despite the recent losing skid, ISU still has not lost a game by more than six points all year.

## THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

Junior guard Kristi Cirone earned her third Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week award on Monday, Feb. 25. Cirone and Drake forward Jill Martin are the only players to collect three conference awards this season. She now has six MVC Player of the Week awards in her career, putting her in a tie with Shyla McKibbon (Evansville) and Tricia Wakeley (Drake) for the fourth-most all-time. ISU and Drake lead the conference with four player of the week awards each this year. Cirone has also been named the Prairie Farms/MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Week each time she has won player of the week.

## CIRONE ENTERS TOP-10 IN ISU SCORING

Junior guard Kristi Cirone entered ISU's game against Missouri State needing only nine points to tie Marla Maupin for 10th place on the Illinois State all-time scoring list. She didn't let the suspense hang around for long, making three three-pointers and a free throw in the first six minutes of the game to collect 10 points and move past Maupin for the No. 10 spot. Cirone finished the night with a team-high 21 points and currently has 1,371 points with ninth-place LuAnn Robinson $(1,385)$ next in her sights.

## JUST WIN, BABY!

The record speaks for itself: 22-5. Illinois State is one of just 24 teams with no more than five losses in the nation. The Redbirds' 22 wins this season are tied for the sixth-most all-time with the 2006-07 squad and they reached the 20 -win plateau in 23 games, the fastest any ISU team ever has. With just two more wins, the 2007-08 squad will have the second-best win total ever.

## JACKSON MOVES INTO STARTING ROLE

Freshman guard Shala Jackson played a pivotal part in Illinois State's success through the first 21 games of the season as the Redbirds' first option off the bench in most games. After consecutive losses, ISU switched up its rotation slightly and Jackson became a part of the starting lineup. Since then, Jackson has flourished, averaging 9.2 ppg , 4.8 rpg , and shooting . 400 from the field ( $20-50$ ), while the Redbirds have posted a 4-2 record. Jackson scored 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting and had six rebounds against Indiana State.

## THREE-COLAI!!

One of the keys to Illinois State's success this season has been the Redbirds' ability to shoot from long range. The Redbirds lead the Valley and rank 16th in the nation in three-point field goal percentage (.381). The 'Birds have made 167 three-pointers this season, the fourth-best total in school history. All of the top-five seasons in three-point field goals in ISU history have been accumulated during Robin Pingeton's time as head coach. Junior guard Kristi Cirone and sophomore guard Maggie Krick lead the way for ISU with 50 and 44 triples, respectively. Cirone has made multiple threes 13 times this season and Krick has done so on nine occasions.

## A KEEN OFFENSIVE PROWESS

While some may say defense wins championships, Illinois State's offense has guided the team to the best start in school history. The Redbirds have the seventh-best scoring offense ( 78.0 ppg ) and the sixth-best field goal percentage (.483) in the nation. The Redbirds have eclipsed 70 points in 24 of their 27 games this year, including three 90 -point and six 80-point contests, and have won by double-digit margins 16 times. The Redbirds have already scored the 15th-most points in ISU single-season history $(2,105)$ and are are the 16th team to eclipse 2,000 points in a year. The Redbirds's scoring average (78.0) is the best ever for an ISU squad.

## CIRONE NAMED FINAL NOMINEE FOR THE NANCY LIBERMAN AWARD

Having already made her mark in the Valley in her first two seasons, junior guard Kristi Cirone has emerged as one of the elite point guards in the nation this season. She is a inal nominee for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given to the nation's top-point guard. Once a part of a field of 26 players, Cirone is now among nine finalists, including Matee Ajavon (Rutgers), Kimberley Beck (George Washington), Shannon Bobbitt (Tennessee), Leilani Mitchell (Utah), Renee Montgomery (Connecticut), Andrea Riley (Oklahoma State), Kristi Toliver (Maryland) and Erica White (LSU). Four finalists will be announced prior to the Final Four and the winner will be announced during Final Four weekend. Cirone leads the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.08) and is 18th in the country in assists per game (5.7).

## ROAD WARRIORS

Despite losing two -straight road games last weekend, Illinois State is still 12-3 away from BloomingtonNormal. The Redbirds average 78.5 ppg and hold their opponents to just 63.9 ppg , for a scoring margin of +14.6. ISU's 64-62 loss at Northern lowa on Feb. 7 snapped an 11-game road winning streak, which is tied for the longest in school history with the 1983-84 team. The Redbirds started the season with 11 -straight road victories for the first time ever and were the last Division I team to lose a road game this season.

## LEEN, MEAN REBOUNDING MACHINE

Sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey has transformed herself into one of the most imposing forwards in the Valley. She has started all 22 games this season and is the Redbirds' top-rebounder ( 7.6 rpg ). Bracey has led the Redbirds in rebounding 17 times and had a career-high 15 boards at Northern lowa. She has scored in double-figures 12 times, including five of the last six games, after not scoring in double-digits at all her freshman season. She leads the Redbirds with five double-doubles and has the best field goal percentage (.553).

## HALF AND HALF

The Redbirds sat in first place in the Valley after the first half of the conference season with an 8-1 record, one game ahead of Evansville (7-2) and two games ahead of Creighton and Drake (6-3). It was the 11 th time a team posted an $8-1$ record through the first half of conference play. In the 25 years of Valley play, the team that held or shared the conference lead at the midway point won the regular season title 23 times and the conference tournament crown 11 times.

## SETTING 'EM UP...

The Redbirds know how to handle and distribute the basketball. ISU is ranked fourth in the nation in assists per game (18.5) and 15th in turnovers per game (14.0). Those stats combined create the third-best assist-toturnover ratio in the country (1.32). ISU has recorded 15 or more assists in 23 games this season, including 10 games with more than 20 helpers. Junior guard Kristi Cirone leads the way for the' Birds, ranking 18th in the nation in assists per game (5.7) and first in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.08), while leading the Valley in both categories. Senior guard Tiffany Hudson is 10th in the nation in assists-to-turnover ratio (2.14) and sophomore guard Maggie Krick is 43 rd (1.80). They are the only trio of teammates in the top-100 in that category.

## ... AND KNOCKING EM DOWN

Illinois State has the seventh-best scoring offense in the nation ( 78.0 ppg ) and ranks sixth in the nation in field goal percentage (.478). The top-offensive team in the Valley, ISU has five players in the top-30 in scoring and four in the top-15 in field goal percentage, more than any other Valley team. Sophomore forward Ashleen Bracey and sophomore center Nicolle Lewis are the top-two players in the Valley in field goal percentage, respectively, in all games and conference games.

## CREIGHTON SNAPS ISU WINNING STREAK

With the $75-71$ loss to Creighton on Feb. 2, ISU had its winning streak snapped at 14 games. The streak was the second-longest in program history, behind the 1983-84 team's 16-consecutive wins, and at the time it was ended, was the second-longest in the nation. It was the fifth-longest winning streak in Division I this season and the 32nd double-digit winning streak.

## REDBIRDS BREAK INTO ASSOCIATED PRESS TOP-25

After receiving votes in the Associated Press poll for 10-consecutive weeks, Illinois State broke into the top- 25 on Monday, Jan. 28. The Redbirds were 24th in the nation with 84 votes in the poll, five votes ahead of 25 th-ranked Texas and 78 votes behind 23rd-ranked DePaul. It was the eighth week all-time that ISU has been ranked in the AP poll and the first time since Dec. 12, 1988.

## GETTING OFF ON THE RICHT FOOT

Illinois State posted a 10-1 record in non-conference play this season, setting the Illinois State and Missouri Valley Conference records for non-conference wins. The Redbirds reached 10 wins faster than any other team in the history of the school (the fastest team to 10 wins under Robin Pingeton was the 2006-07 squad who did it in 14 games). The 'Birds reached those milestones in commanding fashion: scoring 70 points in all but one game, including the first nine-consecutive, and outscoring their opponents by an average of 13.8 points per game.

## FUN IN THE SUN DOME

ISU won the Best Western Roundball Classic in Tampa, Fla., to claim its first regular season tournament title since the 1988 Ohio State Buckeye Classic. Senior guard Tiffany Hudson was named the MVP after averaging 19.0 points over the two games. Junior guard Kristi Cirone, sophomore guard Maggie Krick and freshman guard Shala Jackson were all named to the all-tournament team, giving the Redbirds four of the six honors at the tournament.
