

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the cost to attend?

Admission to the portion of the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival held at the Logan County Airport is \$5.00 per person over the age of 12. The cost for children 12 and younger is \$1.00. Your admission wristband is valid for both Friday and Saturday night of the event at the airport. Parking is free with your admission.

Admission wristbands are non-refundable in case of inclement weather.

Admissions to the Lincoln Art Fair and Craft Fair/Flea Market are free to the public to enjoy. Activity fees downtown are determined by each individual vendor.

How do I get to the Logan County Airport?

Where are the downtown Lincoln activities located?

The Lincoln Art Fair is located in Latham Park on Kickapoo Street. The Craft Fair is located three blocks south in Scully Park. Between the two parks will be activities, food vendors, and much more for everyone to enjoy!

Where is the best place to park for downtown activities?

There will be limited parking along streets around the activities. Public parking lots are located on Kickapoo Street at the recycle bins, the parking lot next to the Public Library, and Shay Parking lot across from Scully Park off of Clinton Street.

Where can we watch the hot air balloons?

Any spot in the airport is perfect for viewing the balloons! We encourage our guests to walk among the balloons and talk with the pilots. Seating is also available throughout the airport and in the hospitality tent. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs.

How can I get a ride in a hot air balloon during the Festival weekend?

We invite you to take part in our early morning paid flights. These beautiful sunrise flights will take place both Saturday and Sunday from the Logan County Airport. Take this opportunity to soar above Logan County with our paid Balloon Rides. These one of a kind flights will give you breathtaking views and memories to last a lifetime. The best part about our rides is that you can experience this excitement with your friends and family; our pilot's special basket will hold up to 6 guests and accommodate riders with special needs. Please contact the Chamber Office at (217) 735-2385 for reservations or meet at the Logan County Airport on Thursday, August 26 at 5:30 p.m., both August 28 and

29 at 6 a.m. Flights are \$250 per person and available on a first come, first serve basis.

What is a launch?

A launch is the term used when the hot air balloons ascend into the air. The crew and pilot prepares the balloon for the launch which takes approximately 10 to 15 minutes total. All 34 hot air balloons will launch for each flight. Saturday about 6:30 a.m., balloons will launch at different locations around Logan County and fly into the airport for a breathtaking site – weather permitting.

What is a glow?

A glow takes place at dusk on Friday and Saturday night –weather permitting. A selected number of balloons will inflate while remaining tethered to the ground. An announcer will play games and fun activities with the pilots as they light up their balloon – essentially "glowing."

What do balloon crews do?

The balloon crew is responsible for assisting the pilot in inflating and deflating their hot air balloon for each flight and glow. Once the balloons launch from the Logan County Airport, it is essential for the chase crew to depart quickly and follow their balloon on their journey though Logan County. Most balloon sponsors provide the crew for the balloons they sponsor; however we often need additional help. If you are interested in crewing a balloon, please contact the Chamber prior to the week of the Festival. You can also fill out the Festival volunteer form on our website www.lincolnillinois.com/ABF.aspx.

Are pets allowed at the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival?

Pets are allowed at the LABF. We ask that all pet owners be responsible for keeping all pets on a leash at all times and for cleaning up after their pets out of respect for other visitors to the Festival. For the safety of other patrons, aggressive pets are not welcome at Festival site locations and will be asked to leave if there are any complaints.

Is smoking allowed at the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival?

There is no smoking allowed at the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival.

Are guests allowed to bring outside food and beverages?

Guests are not permitted to bring outside food and beverages into the gates of the Logan County Airport, unless you purchase tailgating passes. A beverage center is located on the airport grounds selling soft drinks and bottled water. A wide variety of concession stands are set-up in the airport as well. We are sure you will find something for everybody!

Throughout downtown Lincoln there will be concession vendors and beverage centers. Latham Park features a concession stand operated by the Lincoln Junior Women's Club while Scully Park features a stand operated by the Oasis Senior Center.

What are Tailgating passes?

We invite you and your guests to be VIPs for the Lincoln Art and Balloon Festival. This is a great opportunity for a company outing, family or class reunion, birthday party, or just a gathering with friends. Watch the balloons fill the sky while entertaining clients, customers, family and friends at the Logan County Airport during the 2010 Lincoln Art and Balloon Festival. Your "Tailgating Space" will be a private area for your group to eat and retreat before, during, and after the hot air balloon launches and glows. It's just steps away from the Hot Air Balloon launch site and live music and entertainment!

There is limited space, so first come, first served. Contact the Chamber at (217) 735-2385 for more details or go to www.lincolnillinois.com/ABF.aspx.

Are large backpacks and bags allowed at the Festival?

Yes, but any backpack or bag is subject to inspection at any time.

Are lawn chairs allowed at the Festival?

Yes, we encourage guests to bring lawn chairs to find their perfect seat to watch the balloons and live entertainment.

What types of entertainment will be available?

Live Entertainment will be playing at the airport on Friday and Saturday night and downtown on Saturday and Sunday. For a complete list of entertainment please see pages 16 and 17.

Who organizes the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival?

The Lincoln/Logan County Chamber of Commerce organizes the Festival each year. The staff includes Executive Director—Andi Hake, Events Coordinator—Heidi Browne, Business Manager—Robin Keys, Member Services—Ally Leesman and Office Assistants—Haley Casper and Starry Skelton along with hundreds of volunteers.

Is the Festival handicap accessible?

Yes. The airport features handicap accessible parking right by the hot air balloon launch site. This allows for easy viewing of the hot air balloons. There will also be shuttles from the parking lot to the

activities for guests that would like to take advantage of this free service.

Downtown, handicap parking is located around both parks and throughout the downtown area.

What is the VIP tent?

The VIP tent is a great opportunity to view the hot air balloons and live entertainment in a prime location at the Logan County Airport. The VIP tent is located adjacent to the Beer Garden. This tent is only open to sponsors, pilots, and crew on Friday evening. Saturday evening at 8:30 p.m. will be the VIP dinner. This dinner is open to the general public. Tickets need to be purchased in advance of the Festival.

What types of competitions do the pilots compete in at the Festival?

There is a competition during each flight. Competitions include bean bag tosses to a target, races, and more! In most cases pilots are required to hit a target placed on the ground with a bean bag. This task can be quite challenging and takes skill.

Where can I purchase Festival souvenirs?

Both downtown and airport locations have booths that sell official Festival souvenirs. The merchandise tent is located at the Logan County Airport across from the food vendors. Downtown, souvenirs and merchandise can be found in Latham Park at the Art Fair headquarters tent. Both locations offer merchandise for adults and children.

What are the dates of future Lincoln Art & Balloon Festivals?

Can we park our RV at the Logan County Airport?

No, but RV parking is available at the Logan County Fairgrounds in Lincoln, IL. The fairgrounds are just a short drive to both the airport and downtown activities. To make a reservation for your RV please call the Fair office at (217) 732-3311.





Postville Courthouse State Historic Site

914 5th St. Lincoln, IL

The original seat of County Government in Logan County, Postville Courthouse State Historic Site is a reproduction of the original courthouse where Abraham Lincoln once practiced law. See one of his authentic favorite rocking chairs and be sure to visit during the 1800s craft fair. Hours are Tuesday–Saturday 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. (Open Sunday during the festival).

Lincoln Heritage Museum

300 Keokuk St, Lincoln, IL

This museum is located on the campus of Lincoln College and houses many rare Abraham Lincoln artifacts, including an 1860 campaign poster, a lock of his hair, Mary Lincoln's jewelry and Tad Lincoln's rocking chair. Also includes a permanent 9/11 exhibit and other presidential artifacts. Hours are Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday 1 to 4 p.m.

The Railsplitter Covered Wagon, recognized by the Guinness Book of World Records as the largest in the world, recently moved to the front lawn of the Best Western Lincoln Inn, west of Route 66. This great addition to Logan County which was donated by Larry Van Bibber, was also named the #1 Roadside Attraction in the United States in a recent poll through Reader's Digest.

HOT AIR BALLOON LAUNCHES-Friday, 6 p.m., Saturday 6:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Balloons will launch from locations around Logan County and land at the Logan County Airport on Saturday at 6:30 a.m. Friday and Saturday evening, balloons launch from the airport and fly to locations around Logan County. Come enjoy the mass ascension of the hot air balloons in the skies of Logan County. These balloon glows and launches will take place weather permitting.

HOT AIR BALLOON GLOWS-Friday & Saturday at dusk At dusk the balloons will come back to the airport and reinflate for evening glows. This glow is a spectacular event that is enjoyed by the young and old alike.

LIVE ON THE ENTERTAINMENT STAGE

The 2010 Festival brings **Rock of Ages** to the stage on Friday, August 27, beginning immediately after the balloon glow (approximately 8:30 p.m.)

On Saturday the stage opens at 2 p.m. with **Stephanie Foster**–country act. Then **Reverend Ed & The Sunday Drive**, a rock & blues band, will start playing at 5 p.m.

Our featured act again this year will be **The Brat Pack**, an entertaining 80's cover band, immediately after the balloon glow (approximately 8:30 p.m.)

CARNIVAL MIDWAY—Come enjoy fun and family entertainment for all with games and thrilling rides. The Carnival will be open Friday from 4 to 10 p.m. and Saturday from 1 to 10 p.m.

PWE-Professional Wrestling Entertainment-

Come enjoy six matches of live professional wrestling. The first match begins at 5 p.m. at the airport on Saturday evening. This fun, free entertainment promises to thrill the young and old. Gather around the center ring between balloon flights and glows to be entertained. This great entertainment is brought to you by PWE, (*Professional Wrestling Entertainment*).

RAILSPLITTING DEMONSTRATION will take place at the Logan County Airport on Saturday, from 3–3:30 p.m. Travel back in time and watch a true craftsman split rails, as Abraham Lincoln once did. This is a sneak peek of the National Railsplitting Festival that will be held in September.

TETHERED BALLOON RIDES are a great way to have the true balloon festival experience. Take this opportunity to soar above the airport in a hot air balloon. Rides

will be offered for \$5 per child and \$10 per adult (weather permitting). Tethered balloon rides will start at approximately 5 p.m. Friday and Saturday–located at the airport on the south area of the balloon launching field.


To downtown Lincoln




