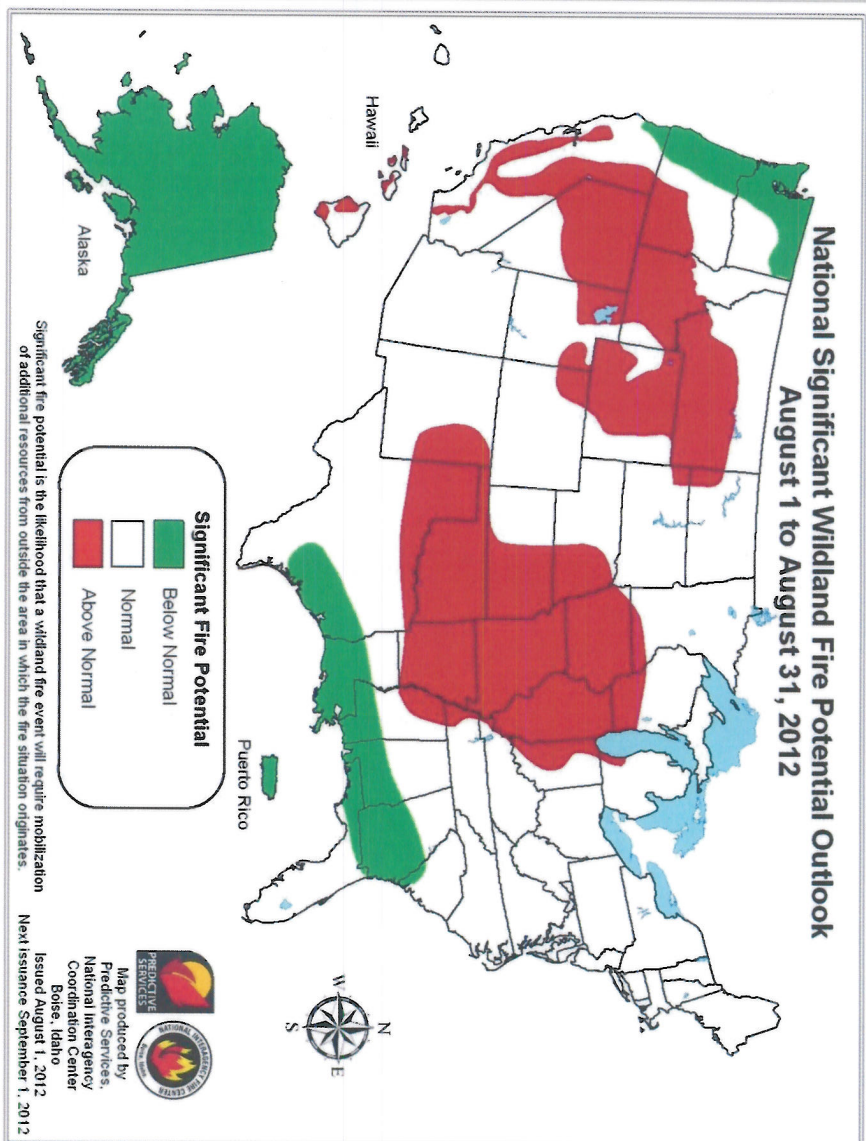




# Drought continues... Fire Weather increased danger remains

 likely remain.*

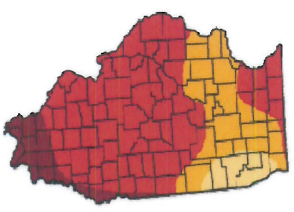
*Entire state of Illinois
