





# **Frequently Asked Questions**

### What is the cost to attend the Festival?

Admission to the activities at the Logan County Airport is \$5 per person over the age of 10. The cost of children 10 and under is \$1. Your \$5 or \$1 admission wristband is valid for both Friday and Saturday. Parking is \$1 per vehicle for every time you enter the parking area.

Admission wristbands are non-refundable in case of inclement weather, or non-balloon flights.

Admission to the Fine Art Fair and Craft Fair/Flea Market is free to the public. Activity fees downtown are determined by each individual vendor.

# How do I get to the Logan County Airport?

Free off-site parking and shuttle rides are available both Friday and Saturday night. (See off-site parking & shuttle info on page 19). Please see page 19 for directions or visit www.lincolnillinois. com/ABF.aspx.

# WHERE ARE THE DOWNTOWN LINCOLN ACTIVITIES LOCATED?

The Lincoln Art Fair is located in Latham Park on Kickapoo Street. The Craft Fair is located three blocks south in Scully Park. Between the two parks will be activities, food vendors, and much more for everyone to enjoy!

# WHERE CAN WE WATCH THE HOT AIR BALLOONS?

Any spot in the airport is perfect for viewing the balloons! We encourage our guests to walk among the balloons and talk with the pilots. Seating is also available throughout the airport and in the hospitality tent. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs.

# How can I get a ride in a hot air balloon during the Festival weekend?

We invite you to take part in our early morning paid flights. These beautiful sunrise flights will take place both Saturday and Sunday from the Logan County Airport. Take this opportunity to soar above Logan County with our paid balloon rides. These one of a kind flights will give you breathtaking views and memories to last a lifetime. The best part about our rides is that you can experience this excitement with your friends and family; our pilot's special basket will hold up to six guests and accommodate riders with special needs. Please contact the Chamber office at (217) 735-2385 for reservations. Flights are \$250 per person and available on a first come, first serve basis.

### WHAT IS A LAUNCH?

A launch is the term used when the hot air balloons ascend into the air. The crew and pilot prepares the balloon for the launch which takes approximately 10 to 15 minutes total. All 34 hot air balloons will launch for each flight. Saturday about 6:30 a.m., balloons will launch at different locations around Logan County and fly into the airport for a breathtaking site – weather permitting. Check schedule pages 4 and 5 for the launch times.

# WHAT IS A GLOW?

A glow takes place at dusk on Friday and Saturday night –weather permitting. A selected number of balloons will inflate while remaining tethered to the ground. An announcer will play games and fun activities with the pilots as they light up their balloon – essentially "glowing."

### WHAT DO BALLOON CREWS DO?

The balloon crew is responsible for assisting the pilot in inflating and deflating their hot air balloon for each flight and glow. Once the balloons launch from the Logan County Airport, it is essential for the chase crew to depart quickly and follow their balloon on their journey though Logan County. Most balloon sponsors provide the crew for the balloons they sponsor; however we often need additional help. If you are interested in crewing a balloon, please contact the Chamber prior to the week of the Festival. You can also fill out the Festival volunteer form on our website www.lincolnillinois.com/ABF.aspx.

# ARE PETS ALLOWED AT THE LINCOLN ART & BALLOON FESTIVAL?

Pets are allowed at the LABF. We ask that all pet owners be responsible for keeping all pets on a leash at all times and for cleaning up after their pets out of respect for other visitors to the Festival. For the safety of other patrons, aggressive pets are not welcome at Festival site locations and will be asked to leave if there are any complaints.

# Is smoking allowed at the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival?

There is no smoking allowed at the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival.

# ARE GUESTS ALLOWED TO BRING OUTSIDE FOOD AND BEVERAGES?

Guests are not permitted to bring outside food and beverages into the gates of the Logan County Airport, unless you purchase tailgating passes. A beverage center is located on the airport grounds selling soft drinks and bottled water. A wide variety of concession stands are set-up in the airport as well. We are sure you will find something for everybody!

Throughout downtown Lincoln there will be concession vendors and beverage centers.

# WHAT ARE TAILGATING PASSES?

We invite you and your guests to be VIPs for the Lincoln Art & Balloon Festival. This is a great opportunity for a company outing, family or class reunion, birthday party, or just a gathering with friends. Watch the balloons fill the sky while entertaining clients, customers, family and friends at the Logan County Airport during the Lincoln Art and Balloon Festival. Your "Tailgating Space" will be a private area for your group to eat and retreat before, during, and after the hot air balloon launches and glows. It's just steps away from the Hot Air Balloon launch site and live music and entertainment!

# ARE LARGE BACKPACKS AND BAGS ALLOWED AT THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, but any backpack or bag is subject to inspection at any time.

# ARE LAWN CHAIRS ALLOWED AT THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, we encourage guests to bring lawn chairs to find their perfect seat to watch the balloons and live entertainment.

# WHAT TYPES OF ENTERTAINMENT WILL BE AVAILABLE?

Live Entertainment will be playing at the airport on Friday and Saturday night and downtown on Saturday and Sunday. For a complete list of entertainment please see pages 16 and 17.

# WHO ORGANIZES THE LINCOLN ART & BALLOON FESTIVAL?

The Lincoln/Logan County Chamber of Commerce organizes the Festival each year. The staff includes Executive Director—Andi Hake, Events Coordinator—Jennifer Lovett, Business Manager—Robin Keys and Office Assistant—Sara Anderson along with hundreds of volunteers.

# IS THE FESTIVAL HANDICAP ACCESSIBLE?

Yes. The airport features handicap accessible parking right by the hot air balloon launch site. This allows for easy viewing of the hot air balloons. There will also be shuttles from the parking lot to the activities for guests that would like to take advantage of this free service.

Downtown, handicap parking is located around both parks and throughout the downtown area.

# WHAT IS THE VIP TENT?

The VIP tent is a great opportunity to view the hot air balloons and live entertainment in a prime location at the Logan County Airport. The VIP tent is located adjacent to the beer garden and live entertainment. This tent is open to sponsors, pilots, and crew on Friday and Saturday—for a small fee the general public can purchase tickets. Tickets need to be purchased in advance of the Festival. Contact the chamber office.

# WHAT TYPES OF COMPETITIONS DO THE PILOTS COMPETE IN AT THE FESTIVAL?

There is a competition during each flight. Competitions include bean bag tosses to a target, races, and more! In most cases pilots are required to hit a target placed on the ground with a bean bag. This task can be quite challenging and takes skill.

# WHERE CAN I PURCHASE FESTIVAL SOUVENIRS?

Both downtown and airport locations have booths that sell official Festival souvenirs. The souvenir tent is located at the Logan County Airport across from the food vendors. Downtown, souvenirs and merchandise can be found in Latham Park at the Art Fair headquarters tent. Both locations offer merchandise for adults and children.





# **Tourist Attractions in Logan County**

### **Postville Courthouse State Historic Site**

914 5th St. Lincoln, IL

The original seat of County Government in Logan County, Postville Courthouse State Historic Site is a reproduction of the original courthouse where Abraham Lincoln once practiced law. See one of his authentic favorite rocking chairs and be sure to visit during the 1800's craft fair. Hours are Tuesday–Saturday 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. (Open Sunday during the festival).

# **Lincoln Heritage Museum**

300 Keokuk St, Lincoln, IL

This museum is located on the campus of Lincoln College and houses many rare Abraham Lincoln artifacts, including an 1860 campaign poster, a lock of his hair, Mary Lincoln's jewelry and Tad Lincoln's rocking chair. Also includes a permanent 9/11 exhibit and other presidential artifacts. Hours are Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Saturday 1 to 4 p.m.

# **Courthouse Square Historic District**

Downtown Lincoln

The 14-block Courthouse Square Historic District in Lincoln is filled with beautifully restored historic buildings and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visitors are encouraged to stroll along the picturesque streets, enjoy the local hospitality and charm of gift and antique shops as well as locally owned eateries. Located in the center is the Logan County Courthouse, open for touring on Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Also located on the Courthouse grounds is the Civil War Statue, the Indian Mother statue and an authentic Civil War cannon. Across from the Courthouse at 600 Broadway St, atop the Lincoln

City Hall is the infamous phone booth which was originally used to spot inclement weather. **Interstate 55 take exit 123** toward Lincoln, travel north on Business 55/Route 66 approximately seven miles, turn right traveling east onto N. Kickapoo St, turn left traveling east onto Airport Rd., the airport will be on the right.

Interstate 55 take exit 126 left toward Lincoln traveling east on Route 10/Woodlawn Rd. through town to Kickapoo St., turn left onto N. Kickapoo St. and travel north to Airport Rd., take a right onto Airport Rd., the airport will be on the right. (Free Park' N Ride service)

Interstate 55 take exit 133 take a left traveling south on Route 66/Business 55 approximately one mile turn left onto N. Kickapoo St. and left onto Airport Rd. The Logan County Airport will be immediately on the right.

# To downtown Lincoln

**Interstate 55 take Exit 123** toward Lincoln, travel north on Business 55/Route 66, turn right onto 5'h St. traveling east until it curves into Logan St., then turn right onto Broadway St., traveling east to the downtown activities.

Interstate 55 take exit 126 travel left into Lincoln on Route 10/Woodlawn Rd., traveling east through town. Continue on Route 10/Woodlawn Rd., traveling east until you reach Kickapoo St. Turn right onto Kickapoo St., traveling south seven blocks to Latham Park. All downtown events follow for the next five blocks. (Free Park' N Ride)

Interstate 55 take exit 133 turning left traveling south on Route 66/Business 55, approximately one mile turn left onto N. Kickapoo St., traveling south to Latham Park on the left. All downtown events follow in the next five blocks.

\* Most activities take place off of Kickapoo Street. Travel north to the Logan County Airport or south to Downtown Lincoln.

# Transportation Art & Balloon Festival

- Pick-ups at the airport after 10 p.m. may be dropped off at Burger King or the downtown location until service is discontinued for the evening.

Free Trolley Service in downtown Lincoln Saturday and Sunday:

Open Trolley's pulled by tractors will provide free transportation around downtown Lincoln on Saturday beginning at 10 a.m. and run until 5 p.m., and Sunday Trolley service will run from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The primary pick-up for the Trolley service will be on the corner of Pulaski and Chicago. All other drop-offs and pick-ups are based on riders' need.
