CRIMESTOPPERS RELEASE

On 8/23/2012 at 1:50 PM, the Lincoln Police Department was dispatched to 1200blk of Pekin St, Lincoln, Logan County, IL, in reference to an attempted Child Abduction. Victim reports that an older white male subject in his 60s or 70s, no facial hair, and wearing a yellow baseball cap with unknown writing on it attempted to lure the victim into his vehicle on two separate occasions near Washington Monroe School.

Vehicle is described as a maroon/purple SUV possibly Ford Expedition or Lincoln Navigator with chrome bottom trim. Video surveillance was obtained that captured a vehicle in the area at approximately the same time reported.
