
Triangle of Opportunity 2012 Bike Route

(West and South of Bloomington-Normal, IL)



(Course will be Marked)

Starting at Olympia North taking Old Peoria Road south and east turning right on 750 E., turning right on 1175 N to our first stop at Darnall Gun Club (8.2 miles). Continuing on and going south on 600 E. going by the Stanford Sportsman's Club then left on 1000 N. Next stop at SIRS (remote controlled plane field 13 miles). On to right on 975 E., left on 850 N., right on 1075 E., right on 550 N., left on 800 E. to Sudden Impact Paintball in Funks Grove (21.9 miles). Continuing to right on 525 N., right on 600 E., left on 600 N., right on 525 E., to 1000 N., stop at Brad Glenn's (29 miles). East to 900 E. then north, to 1100 N., going right to Covell (FYI 33 miles), left on 900 E., with a stop either at the intersection of 900 E. by 1520 North (38.1 miles) or left on 1520 N. with stop at Dry Grove Township shed. North on 700 E., left on 1800 N. left on 500 E., left on Park back to school (45.7 total miles).
