Redbirds Ride Win-Streak to RussMatt Invite

Illinois State brings a seven-game winning streak into the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational, where the Redbirds will play Maine Friday, Western Michigan Saturday and Iowa Sunday.

ISU (7-3) has swept back-to-back series, including last weekend's three-game sweep at Southeast Missouri. The Redbird offense is averaging 9.9 runs per game, which ranks third in NCAA Division I baseball. ISU has also belted 15 home runs this season, which is the sixth-highest total in the nation.

The Redbirds begin invitational play against Maine Friday, in hopes of extending their winning streak to the longest stretch since ISU won nine in a row in 1987.

"We look forward to getting to Florida for spring break," Illinois State head coach Mark Kingston said. "We will be playing some great teams in some great stadiums. As always, our goals will be to continue improving and competing at the highest level."

After ISU opens its 10-day, eight-game spring break trip this weekend, the Redbirds will play midweek games at No. 13 Miami and South Florida, before wrapping up against Navy and Army next weekend at the RussMatt Invitational.

The Redbirds will stay with their rotation of Chris Razo (1-1) Friday, Brad Sorkin (1-1) Saturday and Dylan Craig (1-0) Sunday.

America East member Maine (4-6), will counter in Friday's game with Stephen Perakslis (2-2). The Black Bears are led by Colin Gay, who is hitting .410 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.

Western Michigan (4-7), out of the Mid-American Conference, has not announced its Saturday starter. Troy Forton leads the Bronco scoring-attack with a .342 batting average.

Big Ten affiliate Iowa (3-6) is scheduled to start Matt Dermody (0-1). The Hawkeyes are led by Jacob Yacinich's .391 average.

Interview Policy

All interviews should be arranged through the Illinois State Athletics Communications Office. Players and coaches will be available for interviews throughout the week and at the conclusion of all games. In most situations, the most convenient opportunity for media interviews is following the team practice sessions. If this is not a convenient time for the media, return telephone calls from the student-athletes to the media will be arranged. Interviews on game days will be held approximately 10 minutes after the last game. There will be no interviews between games of doubleheaders.

The Opposition: Maine (4-6, 0-0 America East Conference)

- The University of Maine is located in Orono, Maine. The Black Bears are members of the America East Conference.
- Maine was 33-24 last season and went 18-6 (2nd) in America East play.
- Maine has been picked to finish second in the America East according to the preseason poll.
- Maine is coached by Steve Trimper, who is in his seventh season as Maine's head coach. Trimper holds a 180-156-2 record at Maine, and a 352-331-3 career record.
- Illinois State leads the all-time series, 2-0. ISU last played Maine Mar. 14, 1994, and the Redbirds won, 3-1.

The Opposition: Western Michigan (4-7, 0-0 Mid-American Conference)

- Western Michigan University is located in Kalamazoo, Mich. The Broncos are members of the Mid-American Conference.
- Western Michigan was 26-31 last season and went 12-4 (fifth in the West Division) in MAC play.
- Western Michigan has been picked to finish fifth in the MAC West Division according to the preseason poll.
- Western Michigan is coached by Billy Gernon, who is in his second season as Western Michigan's head coach. Gernon holds a 30-38 record at Western Michigan, and a 187-313-3 career record.
- The all-time series is tied, 2-2. ISU last played WMU Mar. 1, 2001, and the Redbirds won, 7-3.

The Opposition: Iowa (3-6, 0-0 Big Ten Conference)

- The University of Iowa is located in Iowa City, Iowa. The Hawkeyes are members of the Big Ten Conference.
- Iowa was 20-32 last season and went 9-15 (ninth) in the Big Ten Conference.
- Iowa was not among the six teams ranked in the Big Ten Conference preseason poll. However, starting pitchers Matt Dermody (who is scheduled to pitch against ISU) and Jared Hippen, and second baseman Mike McQuillan were named 2012 Big Ten Players to Watch.
- Iowa is coached by Jack Dahm, who is in his ninth season as Iowa's head coach. Dahm holds a 193-254 record at Iowa, and a 476-530-2 career record.
- Illinois State leads the all-time series, 10-8. ISU last played Iowa Feb. 20, 2010, and the Hawkeyes won, 19-11.

Striking Into Florida

After sweeping back-to-back series against Tennessee Tech and Southeast Missouri State, the Redbirds begin the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational on a seven-game winning streak. The stretch, which started with a 10-1 victory at Austin Peay Feb. 19, is ISU's first seven-game winning streak since 2001. In 1988, the Redbirds had a streak of seven wins and one tie, and in 1987, ISU won nine games in a row. Redbird catcher Matt Mirabal has had a hit in all but one of Illinois State's games during the current stretch, as Mirabal is currently on a team-best six-game hitting streak.

Hot Bats in Cold Weather

Even though the gametime temperature has averaged a chilly 49 degrees during Illinois State's first 10 games of the season, ISU's offense has been red hot. The Redbirds rank third in the nation in scoring, averaging 9.9 runs per game. The current leader is Cornell with 10.5 runs averaged per game. The Redbirds also rank eighth in the nation with 99 runs this season. Illinois State has belted 15 home runs to rank sixth in the nation, and ISU is averaging 1.5 home runs per game, which is the seventh-most in the country. The Redbirds also lead the Missouri Valley Conference with home runs, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and walks.

Errorless Baseball

Illinois State's defense ranks sixth in the nation with a .986 fielding percentage. The Redbirds' mark is second-best in the Missouri Valley Conference, after finishing 2011 with just the seventh-best fielding percentage (.960). ISU has not committed an error in seven of its first ten games.

Long Closes In On Another Record

With his one-inning appearance to close-out Illinois State's 14-4 win at Southeast Missouri State Mar. 4, senior closer Kenny Long made his 72nd-career appearance to move into a tie for third place on the career-appearance list, with former Redbird Ryan Copeland. Eric Theisen ranks second with 86, and record holder Jim Sajewich made 90 appearances. Long already holds the career-saves mark (16), which he set last season after passing former record holder Jeremy Accardo.

Wiesemeyer Keys Redbirds in Sweep at SEMO

Senior outfielder Ty Wiesemeyer led Illinois State in last weekend's three-game sweep at Southeast Missouri State. The senior outfielder collected six RBI with a 9-for-17 (.529) performance in the series. He also scored four runs and had three doubles with two stolen bases. Wiesemeyer amassed a .706 slugging percentage and a .556 on-base mark. The Troy, Ill., native was instrumental in ISU's comeback effort at SEMO Saturday evening. The Redbirds, who trailed, 11-2, in the fifth inning, scored 11-straight to beat SEMO in 10 innings. Wiesemeyer drove in the tying run with a two-RBI double, and he hit an RBI single to plate what proved to be the winning run. Wiesemeyer went 4-for-7 with a game-high six RBI in come-from-behind victory over the Redhawks. He is now hitting .371 with four doubles and one home run.

Two Grand Slams and Seven Home Runs ... In One Game

Illinois State hit seven home runs, including two grand slams, to beat Tennessee Tech, 28-2, Feb. 26 at Bush Stadium in Cookeville, Tenn. The game marked ISU's highest offensive output since the Redbirds scored 29 runs against James Madison Mar. 14, 2010. It was also Illinois State's first grand slam since Mike Hollenbeck hit one against Chicago State, Apr. 2, 2011.

Strength of Schedule

Six 2011 NCAA Division I Tournament participants and 11 teams that won 30 or more games highlight the 52-game 2012 Illinois State baseball schedule. 2011 NCAA Tournament participants and 30-plus game winners include Austin Peay, Creighton, Illinois, Maine, Miami and Navy. ISU is also scheduled to play five other teams with 30 or more victories last season, including Missouri State, Northern Illinois, Purdue, Southeast Missouri and Wichita State.

Back-to-Back 30-Win Campaigns

With the May 14 win at Southern Illinois, the 2011 Redbirds won their 30th game of the season, giving Illinois State back-to-back 30-win seasons for the first time since 1998-99.

ISU Looks to Build Off Record-Breaking Season

With their 36th and final win of the season (against Evansville at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, May 25), the 2011 Redbirds became the winningest team in program history. They broke the previous mark of 35 wins, set by the 1999 team. ISU also featured three record-setting milestones:

Career-Wins Record: With a 4-1 win over Bradley on Apr. 16, senior Corey Maines passed Doug Boehm for most Redbird career-wins. Boehm's record was 21, set in 1985, while Maines established the new record with 24 total victories. He also ranks first in career games started (53) and fourth in innings pitched (307) and strikeouts (272). He amassed a team-best 9-4 record and a 2.87 ERA in 2011.

Career-Saves Record: Junior closer Kenny Long allowed one hit and struck out three in a four-out save, giving him 13 in his career on May 1. Long moved past former Redbird Jeremy Accardo to become the school's all-time saves leader. Long finished his junior year with six saves, increasing his total to 15. Long is already among the single-season saves leaders with nine (set in 2010).

Career Stolen Bases Record: Junior second baseman Kevin Tokarski added to his career stolen base record, which was set in 2010. Tokarski's 25 stolen bases in 2011 increased the record to 91. Tokarski also moved up to second on the career-walks list, with 127.

Pitching Wins Games

The Redbird pitching staff boasted the second-lowest ERA in the MVC (3.30) in 2011 and allowed the fewest earned runs (174), runs (227), hits (437) and home runs (18). Illinois State's 3.30 ERA was the Redbirds' lowest team-ERA since the 1983 season.

Head Coach Mark Kingston

In his first two seasons as a head coach, Mark Kingston led Illinois State to two major milestones, including a program-best 36 wins in 2011 and the Redbirds' first-ever Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship in 2010. Additionally, 13 Redbirds have earned all-MVC honors and three have been drafted under Kingston's leadership.



During his second season at ISU, Kingston not only guided Illinois State to its highest single-season wins-total in school history, but he also coached seven players onto the 2011 All-MVC team. The Redbirds finished the season with a 36-18 record, a third-place MVC finish and a marquee victory at Miami, the school he was an assistant at when the Hurricanes won the 2001 College World Series.

The most successful first-year head coach in ISU baseball history, Kingston coached the 2010 Redbirds to their first-ever share of the MVC regular-season championship, their first State Farm MVC Tournament title since 1994 and their first NCAA Tournament game win since 1976.

The winner of the 2010 MVC Coach of the Year award, Kingston helped second baseman Kevin Tokarski become the first-ever Redbird to earn the MVC Joe Carter Player of the Year Award, the State Farm MVC Tournament Most Outstanding Player Award and three All-America selections. Also during Kingston's first season, six Redbirds were named All-MVC selections.

Upon winning the 2010 State Farm MVC Tournament, six Redbirds earned a spot on the all-tournament team and one ISU player was named to the NCAA all-regional team. Under the direction of Kingston, Illinois State amassed a 32-24 record in 2010, which was not only the most wins for the Redbirds since 1999, but also the most ever by a first-year head coach.

Kingston was named Illinois State's ninth head baseball coach on June 10, 2009 after serving the previous season as the team's associate head coach. Prior to returning to ISU, Kingston spent seven years as recruiting coordinator at Tulane University and served as an assistant on the Miami team that won the 2001 College World Series. He has coached at the collegiate level for 13 years, reaching 500 wins as an assistant in 2009, and was widely respected throughout the sport as one of the top assistants in the nation.

Kingston spent five seasons as associate head coach for the Green Wave with the responsibility of building the Tulane team through recruiting, coaching Tulane hitters and developing catchers and infielders. At Tulane, Kingston's recruiting and coaching efforts helped the Green Wave to six postseason appearances, two NCAA Super Regionals and a berth in the College World Series. The 2005 Green Wave team was seeded as the top-team overall while also receiving the top-academic honor in Omaha. Tulane averaged nearly 42 wins per season with Kingston on staff.

Prior to joining the Green Wave staff, Kingston spent two years coaching at Miami (Fla.), where he helped the Hurricanes capture the 2001 College World Series.

Bill Mohl attacked the strike zone as a pitcher and, as a result, won a lot of games. In five years as an assistant coach, including the last two at Illinois State, he has helped his pitching staffs do the same. Mohl is now in charge of coaching pitchers at Illinois State, creating scouting reports and assisting in recruiting efforts. During his second season at ISU, Mohl guided the 2011 Redbird pitching staff to a 3.30 ERA, which was the second-lowest mark in the Missouri Valley Conference and the lowest ISU team-ERA since 1983. The Redbird staff also gave up the least amount of hits and runs in the league.

Mike Current's hard work and persistent effort have led to steady gains for the Illinois State baseball program in the past six years. Since the Bloomington, Ill., native joined the Redbirds' coaching staff in 2006, Illinois State has seen its winning percentage increase in each consecutive season, culminating in 2011 with the Redbirds' winningest season in program history. Current also helped ISU earn its first-ever share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship and the Redbirds' first Valley Tournament title since 1994. He coached ISU to its first winning season in eight years during the 2009 campaign.

Durkac helped the 2011 Redbirds win a program-record 36 games, while hitting .271 with a Missouri Valley Conference-high .409 slugging percentage and a .385 on-base percentage. 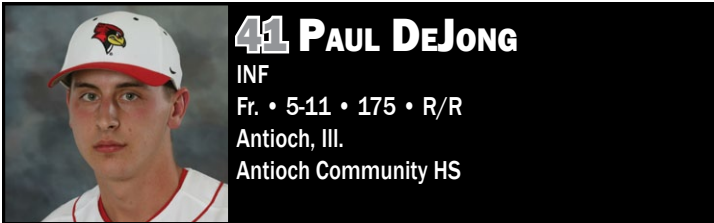

All interviews should be arranged through the Illinois State Athletics Communications Office. Players and coaches will be available for interviews throughout the week and at the conclusion of all games. In most situations, the most convenient opportunity for media interviews is following the team practice sessions. If this is not a convenient time for the media, return telephone calls from the student-athletes to the media will be arranged. Interviews on game days will be held approximately 10 minutes after the last game. There will be no interviews between games of doubleheaders.
