The Illinois State baseball team will try to stay perfect at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational in 2012, as the Redbirds play the final three games of their spring break trip this weekend. ISU (10-5) is scheduled to face Navy (8-7) Friday at 1 p.m. CT, followed by a doubleheader versus Army (9-4) at 4 p.m. CT Saturday.

"I just want to see solid baseball this weekend," Illinois State head baseball coach Mark Kingston said. "I want to see Chris Razo come out and have a great outing on Friday. I want to see us continue to score a lot of runs, and I want to see our bullpen continue to be lock-down, like it has been.'

The Redbirds are coming off of midweek losses at No. 10 Miami and at South Florida. ISU had been riding a 10-game winning streak before losing to the Hurricanes. While Matt Mirabal's 10-game hitting streak also came to an end at USF. Tv Wiesemever extended his hitting stretch to 10 against the Bulls, marking the Redbirds' longest active streak.

Wiesemeyer is leading the Redbirds with a .411 batting average, including five doubles, 15 runs and 12 RBI, Meanwhile, Kevin Tokarski needs just five runs to set ISU's career-runs record. Navy is paced by Chance Jones' .378 average with 13 runs and 21 RBI. Army's offense is led by JT Watkins, who is hitting .353 with 11 runs, five doubles and 13 RBI.

Illinois State will once again counter the opposition with right-hander Razo (2-1) Friday, right-hander Brad Sorkin (1-1) in Saturday's first game and left-hander Dylan Craig (2-0) in Saturday's second game.

The Redbirds are playing Navy and Army for the first time in program history. Both teams are members of the Patriot League. ISU started competition at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational last weekend with wins against all three of its opponents, Maine, Western Michigan and Iowa.

Interview Policy

All interviews should be arranged through the Illinois State Athletics Communications Office. Players and coaches will be available for interviews throughout the week and at the conclusion of all games. In most situations, the most convenient opportunity for media interviews is following the team practice sessions. If this is not a convenient time for the media, return telephone calls from the student-athletes to the media will be arranged. Interviews on game days will be held approximately 10 minutes after the last game. There will be no interviews between games of doubleheaders.

The Opposition: U.S. Naval Academy (8-7, 0-0 Patriot League)

- The U.S. Naval Academy is located in Annapolis, Md. The Midshipmen are members of the Patriot League.
- Navy was 33-25-1 last season and went 12-8 (first) in Patriot League play.
- Navy tied with Bucknell for first in the Patriot League preseason poll.
- Navy is coached by Paul Kostacopoulos, who is in his seventh season as Navy's head coach. Kostacopoulos holds a 190-145-4 record at Miami, and a 694-477-6 career record in his 23rd season.
 This is the first-ever meeting between Navy and ISU.

The Opposition: U.S. Military Academy (9-4, 0-0 Patriot League)

- The U.S. Military Academy is located in West Point, N.Y. The Black Knights are members of the Patriot League.
- Army was 22-26 last season and went 11-9 (second) in Patriot League play.
- Army has been picked to finish second in the Patriot League according to the preseason poll.
- Army is coached by Joe Sottolano, who is in his 13th season as Army's head coach. Sottolano holds a 330-252-5 record at Army, which is also his career record.
- This is the first-ever meeting between Army and ISU.

Bats Stay Hot in the Sunshine State

ISU's offense has been red hot so far this season. The Redbirds rank third in the nation in scoring, averaging 9.1 runs per game. The current leader is Buffalo with 10.4 runs averaged per game. The Redbirds also rank 10th in the nation in runs scored this season. Illinois State has belted 15 home runs to rank ninth in the nation. The Redbirds also lead the Missouri Valley Conference with a .418 on-base percentage.

Tokarski Approaches Career-Runs Mark

After scoring three runs during Illinois State's mid-week games at No. 10 Miami and at USF, senior second baseman Kevin Tokarski moved into sole-possession of second place on the career-runs list. Tokarski needs four runs to tie the record, which is held by Seth Von Behren. Tokarski will set the record with five runs. He begins this weekend's series with 180 runs, while Von Behren (1997-00) had 184 career-runs. Tokarski already holds the career-stolen bases mark (99), and the season record for runs (70 in 2010), hits (84 in 2010), doubles (25 in 2010), walks (53 in 2010), on-base percentage (.538 in 2010) and stolen bases (33 in 2010).

Long Closes In On Another Record

Senior closer Kenny Long is in sole possession of third place on the career-appearance list. Long has appeared 75 times, while Eric Theisen ranks second with 86, and record holder Jim Sajewich made 90 appearances. Long already holds the career-saves mark (18), which he set last season after passing former record holder Jeremy Accardo.

Streak Snapped in Coral Gables

After sweeping three-consecutive weekend series (last weekend at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational, and the previous two weekends at Southeast Missouri and Tennessee Tech), the Redbirds saw their 10-game winning streak snapped at No. 10 Miami. The stretch, which started with a 10-1 victory at Austin Peay Feb. 19, was ISU's first 10-game streak since the Redbirds had a stretch of 10 wins and one tie in 1984. Although the winning streak is over, senior outfielder Ty Wiesemeyer is now on a team-best 10-game hitting streak.

Walking Chad in Florida

While junior centerfielder Chad Hinshaw has the lowest batting average among the starting-nine (.194) he boasts the highest on-base percentage (.509). Even though Hinshaw has just six hits in 31 at-bats, he has walked a team-best 16 times, and he has been hit by a team-high five pitches. Thanks in a large part to Hinshaw, the Redbirds not only lead the Missouri Valley Conference with a .418 on-base percentage, but ISU has also walked more times than any other team. Illinois State has been issued 88 walks so far this season, and the Redbirds have been hit by 17 pitches (fourth most in the Valley).

Errorless Baseball

Illinois State's defensive fielding percentage ranks third-best (.974) in the Missouri Valley Conference, after finishing 2011 with just the seventh-best fielding percentage (.960). ISU has not committed an error in eight of its first 15 games.

Razo Begins to Dazzle

Junior college transfer and Friday night starter Chris Razo earned the victory against Maine Mar. 9 at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla. Razo pitched seven innings, allowing just one earned run on four hits and striking out five. Razo only issued two walks and limited opposing batters to a .174 batting average. He earned his second Division I collegiate win in four starts.

Wiesemeyer Keys Redbirds in Sweep at SEMO

Senior outfielder Ty Wiesemeyer led Illinois State in ISU's three-game sweep at Southeast Missouri State, Mar. 3-4. The senior outfielder collected six RBI with a 9-for-17 (.529) performance in the series. He also scored four runs and had three doubles with two stolen bases. Wiesemeyer amassed a .706 slugging percentage and a .556 on-base mark. The Troy, Ill., native was instrumental in ISU's comeback effort at SEMO Saturday evening. The Redbirds, who trailed, 11-2, in the fifth inning, scored 11-straight to beat SEMO in 10 innings. Wiesemeyer drove in the tying run with a two-RBI double, and he hit an RBI single to plate what proved to be the winning run. Wiesemeyer went 4-for-7 with a game-high six RBI in come-from-behind victory over the Redhawks. He is now hitting .371 with four doubles and one home run.





Two Grand Slams and Seven Home Runs ... In One Game

Illinois State hit seven home runs, including two grand slams, to beat Tennessee Tech, 28-2, Feb. 26 at Bush Stadium in Cookeville, Tenn. The game marked ISU's highest offensive output since the Redbirds scored 29 runs against James Madison Mar. 14, 2010. It was also Illinois State's first grand slam since Mike Hollenbeck hit one against Chicago State, Apr. 2, 2011.

What the Redbirds Return in 2012

The 2012 Redbirds combine 19 letterwinners with 13 newcomers. Illinois State returns: 56.9% Runs | 56.5% Hits | 47.7% Doubles | 50% Triples | 33% Home Runs | 54.4% RBI | 82% Stolen Bases 41.7% Wins | 66.7% Saves | 38.5% Strikeouts | 37.9% Walks | 24.1% Starts | 52.8% Appearances

Strength of Schedule

Six 2011 NCAA Division I Tournament participants and 11 teams that won 30 or more games highlight the 52-game 2012 Illinois State baseball schedule. 2011 NCAA Tournament participants and 30-plus game winners include Austin Peay, Creighton, Illinois, Maine, Miami and Navy. ISU is also scheduled to play five other teams with 30 or more victories last season, including Missouri State, Northern Illinois, Purdue, Southeast Missouri and Wichita State.

Back-to-Back 30-Win Campaigns

With the May 14 win at Southern İllinois, the 2011 Redbirds won their 30th game of the season, giving Illinois State back-to-back 30-win seasons for the first time since 1998-99.

ISU Looks to Build Off Record-Breaking Season

With their 36th and final win of the season (against Evansville at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, May 25), the 2011 Redbirds became the winningest team in program history. They broke the previous mark of 35 wins, set by the 1999 team. ISU also featured three record-setting milestones:

Career-Wins Record: With a 4-1 win over Bradley on Apr. 16, senior Corey Maines passed Doug Boehm for most Redbird career-wins. Boehm's record was 21, set in 1985, while Maines established the new record with 24 total victories. He also ranks first in career games started (53) and fourth in innings pitched (307) and strikeouts (272). He amassed a team-best 9-4 record and a 2.87 ERA in 2011.

Career-Saves Record: Junior closer Kenny Long allowed one hit and struck out three in a four-out save, giving him 13 in his career on May 1. Long moved past former Redbird Jeremy Accardo to become the school's all-time saves leader. Long finished his junior year with six saves, increasing his total to 15. Long is already among the single-season saves leaders with nine (set in 2010).

Career Stolen Bases Record: Junior second baseman Kevin Tokarski added to his career stolen base record, which was set in 2010. Tokarski's 25 stolen bases in 2011 increased the record to 91. Tokarski also moved up to second on the career-walks list, with 127.

Head Coach Mark Kingston

In his first two seasons as a head coach, Mark Kingston led Illinois State to two major milestones, including a programbest 36 wins in 2011 and the Redbirds' first-ever Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship in 2010. Additionally, 13 Redbirds have earned all-MVC honors and three have been drafted under Kingston's leadership.

During his second season at ISU, Kingston not only guided Illinois State to its highest single-season wins-total in school history, but he also coached seven players onto the 2011 All-MVC team. The Redbirds finished the season with a 36-18 record, a third-place MVC finish and a marquee victory at Miami.



the school he was an assistant at when the Hurricanes won the 2001 College World Series.

The most successful first-year head coach in ISU baseball history, Kingston coached the 2010 Redbirds to their first-ever share of the MVC regular-season championship, their first State Farm MVC Tournament title since 1994 and their first NCAA Tournament game win since 1976.

The winner of the 2010 MVC Coach of the Year award, Kingston helped second baseman Kevin Tokarski become the first-ever Redbird to earn the MVC Joe Carter Player of the Year Award, the State Farm MVC Tournament Most Outstanding Player Award and three All-America selections. Also during Kingston's first season, six Redbirds were named All-MVC selections.

Upon winning the 2010 State Farm MVC Tournament, six Redbirds earned a spot on the all-tournament team and one ISU player was named to the NCAA all-regional team. Under the direction of Kingston, Illinois State amassed a 32-24 record in 2010, which was not only the most wins for the Redbirds since 1999, but also the most ever by a first-year head coach.

Kingston was named Illinois State's ninth head baseball coach on June 10, 2009 after serving the previous season as the team's associate head coach. Prior to returning to ISU, Kingston spent seven years as recruiting coordinator at Tulane University and served as an assistant on the Miami team that won the 2001 College World Series. He has coached at the collegiate level for 13 years, reaching 500 wins as an assistant in 2009, and was widely respected throughout the sport as one of the top assistants in the nation.

Kingston spent five seasons as associate head coach for the Green Wave with the responsibility of building the Tulane team through recruiting, coaching Tulane hitters and developing catchers and infielders. At Tulane, Kingston's recruiting and coaching efforts helped the Green Wave to six postseason appearances, two NCAA Super Regionals and a berth in the College World Series. The 2005 Green Wave team was seeded as the top-team overall while also receiving the top-academic honor in Omaha. Tulane averaged nearly 42 wins per season with Kingston on staff.

Prior to joining the Green Wave staff, Kingston spent two years coaching at Miami (Fla.), where he helped the Hurricanes capture the 2001 College World Series.

Bill Mohl attacked the strike zone as a pitcher and, as a result, won a lot of games. In five years as an assistant coach, including the last two at Illinois State, he has helped his pitching staffs do the same. Mohl is now in charge of coaching pitchers at Illinois State, creating scouting reports and assisting in recruiting efforts. During his second season at ISU, Mohl guided the 2011 Redbird pitching staff to a 3.30 ERA, which was the second-lowest mark in the Missouri Valley Conference and the lowest ISU team-ERA since 1983. The Redbird staff also gave up the least amount of hits and runs in the league.





20 | Mike Current | Seventh Season

Mike Current's hard work and persistent effort have led to steady gains for the Illinois State baseball program in the past six years. Since the Bloomington, Ill., native joined the Redbirds' coaching staff in 2006, Illinois State has seen its winning percentage increase in each consecutive season, culminating in 2011 with the Redbirds' winningest $\,$ season in program history. Current also helped ISU earn its first-ever share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship and the Redbirds' first Valley Tournament title since 1994. He coached ISU to its first winning season in eight years during the 2009 campaign.





4 | Bo Durkac | Third Season

Bo Durkac brings a wealth of knowledge to the batter's box after two seasons as an assistant at Illinois State, seven seasons as the hitting coach at Charlotte and seven years of professional playing experience spanning the globe. Durkac's responsibilities at ISU include recruiting and coaching Redbird infielders and hitters. Durkac helped the 2011 Redbirds win a program-record 36 games, while hitting .271 with a Missouri Valley Conference-high .409 slugging percentage and a .385 on-base percentage. ISU also hit 39 home runs, which ranked second in the league.
