Redbirds Host MacMurray and Webster

After playing 19-consecutive road games to start the 2012 season, the Illinois State baseball team opens the home schedule this weekend against MacMurray, Friday, at 3 p.m., followed by a game versus Webster Sunday at 1 p.m.

MacMurray (6-2) and Webster (7-7) are both NCAA Division III schools from the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Redbird homestand will continue Tuesday with a mid-week game against in-state rival Illinois.

"We are excited to finally be able to play at home," Illinois State head coach Mark Kingston said. "Our goal is to continue improving as we get closer to conference play.

ISU will try to bounce back, after losing Wednesday's non-conference matchup at SIU Edwardsville, 6-4. Redbird shortstop Brett Kay led Illinois State with a three-run home run, which was the third of his career and second of the season.

Outfielder Ty Wiesemeyer still leads ISU's offense with a .391 batting average and a team-best .494 on-base percentage. Catcher and designated hitter Mike Hollenbeck is close-behind with a .358 average, and he is riding a team-best seven-game hitting streak. Hollenbeck and Wiesemeyer have also reached base in 14-consecutive games.

Illinois State will start junior right-hander Chris Razo (2-1) Friday and freshman lefthander Dylan Craig (3-0) Sunday. Razo and Craig are each slated to make their fifth starts of the season. Razo has a 7.36 ERA this season with a team-high 26 strikeouts, while Craig has a 5.01 ERA. MacMurray is scheduled to counter with freshman lefthander Brock Robinson, while Webster's starter has not been announced. Last season, the Gorloks won the SLIAC.

The beginning of the 2012 season marks the start of free admission to every game played at Duffy Bass Field.

Interview Policy

All interviews should be arranged through the Illinois State Athletics Communications Office. Players and coaches will be available for interviews throughout the week and at the conclusion of all games. In most situations, the most convenient opportunity for media interviews is following the team practice sessions. If this is not a convenient time for the media, return telephone calls from the student-athletes to the media will be arranged. Interviews on game days will be held approximately 10 minutes after the last game. There will be no interviews between games of doubleheaders.

The Opposition: MacMurray (6-2, 0-0 SLIAC)

- MacMurray College is located in Jacksonville, III. The Highlanders are members of the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.
- MacMurray was 3-30 last season and went 2-23 (ninth) in SLIAC play.
- MacMurray has been picked to finish sixth in the SLIAC according to the preseason poll.
- MacMurray is coached by Andrew Bartman, who is in his first season as MacMurray's head coach.
- Illinois State leads the all-time series, 51-39-9. ISU last played MacMurray Apr. 18, 1979, and the Redbirds won, 6-0.

The Opposition: Webster (7-7, 0-0 SLIAC)

- Webster University is located in St. Louis. The Gorloks are members of the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.
- Webster was 32-13 last season and went 21-3 (first) in SLIAC play.
- Webster has been picked to win the SLIAC according to the preseason poll.
- Webster is coached by Bill Kurich, who is in his sixth season as Webster's head coach. Kurich holds a 157-68 record at Webster, which is the same as his career record.
- This is the first meeting between the two schools.

Lockdown Bullpen

The Redbird coaching staff can confidently turn the game over to the bullpen based on the pitching statistics so far this season. Collectively, the pen has amassed a 2.23 ERA with a 6-1 record and six saves through 72.2 innings of work. Meanwhile, ISU's starters have a 6.72 ERA with a 7-5 record through 85.2 innings. Illinois State's six saves ranks third in the Missouri Valley Conference.

Bats Stay Hot in the Sunshine State

Illinois State's offense has been red hot so far this season, and last week's spring break trip to Florida was no exception. The Redbirds started this week averaging 8.7 runs per game, which was the fifth-highest scoring average among NCAA Division I teams in the nation. The current leader is New Mexico State with 9.6 runs averaged per game. The Redbirds also rank 11th in the country in total runs scored this season (160). Illinois State has belted 17 home runs to rank 31st in the nation. Additionally, the Redbirds lead the Missouri Valley Conference with a .414 on-base percentage.

A Bunch of Basejackers

When it comes to stealing bases, the Redbirds are kleptomaniacs. Illinois State is averaging 2.2 stolen bases per game, which ranks eighth among NCAA Division I teams. The current leader is Hofstra with a 3.35 stolen bases averaged per game. ISU also ranks 14th in the country in total stolen bases (41). The Redbirds lead the Missouri Valley Conference in stolen bases as well.

Tokarski Approaches Career-Runs Mark

After scoring three runs during Illinois State's mid-week games at No. 10 Miami and at USF during this season's spring break trip, senior second baseman Kevin Tokarski moved into sole-possession of second place on the career-runs list. Tokarski needs four runs to tie the record, which is held by Seth Von Behren. Tokarski will set the record with five runs. He begins this weekend's two-game series with 180 runs, while Von Behren (1997-00) had 184 career runs. Tokarski already holds the career-stolen bases mark (99), and the season record for runs (70 in 2010), hits (84 in 2010), doubles (25 in 2010), walks (53 in 2010), on-base percentage (.538 in 2010) and stolen bases (33 in 2010).

Long Closes In On Another Record

Senior closer Kenny Long is in sole possession of third place on the career-appearance list. Long has appeared 79 times, while Eric Theisen ranks second with 86, and record holder Jim Sajewich made 90 appearances. Long already holds the career-saves mark (18), which he set last season after passing former record holder Jeremy Accardo.

Streak Snapped in Florida

After sweeping three-consecutive weekend series (at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational, at Southeast Missouri and at Tennessee Tech), the Redbirds saw their 10-game winning streak snapped at No. 10 Miami on Mar. 13. The stretch, which started with a 10-1 victory at Austin Peay Feb. 19, was ISU's first 10-game streak since the Redbirds had a stretch of 10 wins and one tie in 1984. Senior outfielder Ty Wiesemeyer also had his team-best 11-game hitting streak snapped, and junior centerfielder Chad Hinshaw saw his 15-game on-base streak come to an end.

Game-Saver

Following his three-save performance in each of Illinois State's wins against Navy and Army at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla., last weekend, senior closer Kenny Long has amassed six saves, which matches his total from last season. Long already holds the career saves record, which is now up to 21. During Friday's game versus Navy, Long retired the side in order during the ninth with one strikeout. In game one of Saturday's doubleheader, the left-handed closer pitched the final two innings without surrendering a run and striking out three batters. A few hours later, Long returned to pitch the final 1.2 frames of the second doubleheader game. The Fox River Grove, Ill., native was called to duty with runners on first and third base, one out, and the Redbirds leading by just two runs. Long not only pitched the Redbirds out of the jam, but he also did not allow an earned run during his 1.2 innings of work. In addition to the games Long saved, he also closed out Illinois State's loss Wednesday at South Florida. Long pitched a scoreless and hitless eighth inning with one strikeout against the Bulls.

What the Redbirds Return in 2012

The 2012 Redbirds combine 19 letterwinners with 13 newcomers. Illinois State returns: 56.9% Runs | 56.5% Hits | 47.7 % Doubles | 50% Triples | 33% Home Runs | 54.4% RBI | 82% Stolen Bases 41.7% Wins | 66.7% Saves| 38.5% Strikeouts | 37.9% Walks | 24.1% Starts | 52.8 % Appearances





Mirabal-ing

Senior catcher Matt Mirabal led Illinois State to victories against Navy and Army last weekend at the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational in Winter Haven, Fla. The senior outfielder went 6-for-12 (.500), slugged .833 and amassed a .500 on-base percentage during the three-game weekend series. Throughout all five of the ISU's games last week, Mirabal hit .381. With Illinois State trailing by one run in the sixth inning, Mirabal hit a two-run home run, which proved to drive in the game's winning run. The next day against Army, Mirabal went 5-for-8 with two RBI and three runs scored throughout two seven inning games. He also legged out one double. Mirabal now ranks second on the team with a .391 batting average.

Taking One For the Team

While junior centerfielder Chad Hinshaw has the lowest batting average among the starting-nine (.167) he boasts a .455 on-base percentage (fourth-highest). Even though Hinshaw has just seven hits in 42 at-bats, he has walked a team-best 18 times, and he has been hit by a team-high five pitches. Thanks in a large part to Hinshaw, the Redbirds not only lead the Missouri Valley Conference with a .414 on-base percentage, but ISU has also been issued 103 walks so far this season (second-most in the Valley), and the Redbirds have been hit by 21 pitches (fourth-most in the Valley).

Back-to-Back 30-Win Campaigns

With their May 14 win at Southern Illinois, the 2011 Redbirds won their 30th game of the season, giving Illinois State back-to-back 30-win seasons for the first time since 1998-99.

ISU Looks to Build Off Record-Breaking Season

With their 36th and final win of the season (against Evansville at the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, May 25), the 2011 Redbirds became the winningest team in program history. They broke the previous mark of 35 wins, set by the 1999 team. ISU also featured three record-setting milestones:

Career-Wins Record: With a 4-1 win over Bradley on Apr. 16, senior Corey Maines passed Doug Boehm for most Redbird career-wins. Boehm's record was 21, set in 1985, while Maines established the new record with 24 total victories. He also ranks first in career games started (53) and fourth in innings pitched (307) and strikeouts (272). He amassed a team-best 9-4 record and a 2.87 ERA in 2011.

Career-Saves Record: Junior closer Kenny Long allowed one hit and struck out three in a four-out save, giving him 13 in his career on May 1. Long moved past former Redbird Jeremy Accardo to become the school's all-time saves leader. Long finished his junior year with six saves, increasing his total to 15. Long is already among the single-season saves leaders with nine (set in 2010).

Career Stolen Bases Record: Junior second baseman Kevin Tokarski added to his career stolen base record, which was set in 2010. Tokarski's 25 stolen bases in 2011 increased the record to 91. Tokarski also moved up to second on the career-walks list, with 127.

Head Coach Mark Kingston

In his first two seasons as a head coach, Mark Kingston led Illinois State to two major milestones, including a programbest 36 wins in 2011 and the Redbirds' first-ever Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship in 2010. Additionally, 13 Redbirds have earned all-MVC honors and three have been drafted under Kingston's leadership.

During his second season at ISU, Kingston not only guided Illinois State to its highest single-season wins-total in school history, but he also coached seven players onto the 2011 All-MVC team. The Redbirds finished the season with a 36-18 record, a third-place MVC finish and a marquee victory at Miami.



the school he was an assistant at when the Hurricanes won the 2001 College World Series.

The most successful first-year head coach in ISU baseball history, Kingston coached the 2010 Redbirds to their first-ever share of the MVC regular-season championship, their first State Farm MVC Tournament title since 1994 and their first NCAA Tournament game win since 1976.

The winner of the 2010 MVC Coach of the Year award, Kingston helped second baseman Kevin Tokarski become the first-ever Redbird to earn the MVC Joe Carter Player of the Year Award, the State Farm MVC Tournament Most Outstanding Player Award and three All-America selections. Also during Kingston's first season, six Redbirds were named All-MVC selections.

Upon winning the 2010 State Farm MVC Tournament, six Redbirds earned a spot on the all-tournament team and one ISU player was named to the NCAA all-regional team. Under the direction of Kingston, Illinois State amassed a 32-24 record in 2010, which was not only the most wins for the Redbirds since 1999, but also the most ever by a first-year head coach.

Kingston was named Illinois State's ninth head baseball coach on June 10, 2009 after serving the previous season as the team's associate head coach. Prior to returning to ISU, Kingston spent seven years as recruiting coordinator at Tulane University and served as an assistant on the Miami team that won the 2001 College World Series. He has coached at the collegiate level for 13 years, reaching 500 wins as an assistant in 2009, and was widely respected throughout the sport as one of the top assistants in the nation.

Kingston spent five seasons as associate head coach for the Green Wave with the responsibility of building the Tulane team through recruiting, coaching Tulane hitters and developing catchers and infielders. At Tulane, Kingston's recruiting and coaching efforts helped the Green Wave to six postseason appearances, two NCAA Super Regionals and a berth in the College World Series. The 2005 Green Wave team was seeded as the top-team overall while also receiving the top-academic honor in Omaha. Tulane averaged nearly 42 wins per season with Kingston on staff.

Prior to joining the Green Wave staff, Kingston spent two years coaching at Miami (Fla.), where he helped the Hurricanes capture the 2001 College World Series.

Bill Mohl attacked the strike zone as a pitcher and, as a result, won a lot of games. In five years as an assistant coach, including the last two at Illinois State, he has helped his pitching staffs do the same. Mohl is now in charge of coaching pitchers at Illinois State, creating scouting reports and assisting in recruiting efforts. During his second season at ISU, Mohl guided the 2011 Redbird pitching staff to a 3.30 ERA, which was the second-lowest mark in the Missouri Valley Conference and the lowest ISU team-ERA since 1983. The Redbird staff also gave up the least amount of hits and runs in the league.





20 | Mike Current | Seventh Season

Mike Current's hard work and persistent effort have led to steady gains for the Illinois State baseball program in the past six years. Since the Bloomington, Ill., native joined the Redbirds' coaching staff in 2006, Illinois State has seen its winning percentage increase in each consecutive season, culminating in 2011 with the Redbirds' winningest $\,$ season in program history. Current also helped ISU earn its first-ever share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship and the Redbirds' first Valley Tournament title since 1994. He coached ISU to its first winning season in eight years during the 2009 campaign.





4 | Bo Durkac | Third Season

Bo Durkac brings a wealth of knowledge to the batter's box after two seasons as an assistant at Illinois State, seven seasons as the hitting coach at Charlotte and seven years of professional playing experience spanning the globe. Durkac's responsibilities at ISU include recruiting and coaching Redbird infielders and hitters. Durkac helped the 2011 Redbirds win a program-record 36 games, while hitting .271 with a Missouri Valley Conference-high .409 slugging percentage and a .385 on-base percentage. ISU also hit 39 home runs, which ranked second in the league.
