Lincoln, IL – Lincoln College head basketball coach Pat Lepper has signed Xavier Martin and Jagger Anderson to National Letters of Intent. The duo joins the Lynx for the 2013-14 season.



Xavier Martin, a 6'6" forward, played high school basketball at Champaign Central High School in Champaign, IL. Martin averaged 15 points and eight rebounds per game. Martin plays AAU basketball for Team D-Rose.
