## GOVERNOR'S SALE OF CHAMPIONS SMASHES SEVEN RECORDS

SPRINGFIELD, Ill. – This was an amazing year for the Governor's Sale of Champions, an auction of prize-winning Illinois State Fair junior livestock. Seven records were broken, including two that more than doubled, and an eighth was tied!

The junior producers who raised the champion animals receive 80 percent of the sales price. The 4-H and FFA programs split the remaining 20 percent equally.
