

## Illinois State Postgame Notes FINAL – Ball State 51, Illinois State 28

Aug. 29, 2013 • Scheumann Stadium • Muncie, Ind.

## PLAYER NOTES:

- Collin Keoshian scored from one yard out in the first quarter to record his first touchdown in a Redbird uniform. He ended the game with 13 yards and eight carries and two touchdown runs.
- Jared Barnett was a perfect 3-for-3 for 33 yards on ISU's first scoring drive of the game. He finished the game 20-for-29 with 282 yards passing and two touchdowns, with one interception.
- Senior running back Jonathon Miller returned from a knee injury to rush for 29 yards on nine carries.
- The first career catch for freshman **Anthony Warrum** went for a 47-yard touchdown pass late in the first quarter. He finished the game two grabs for 65 yards.
- Tight end James O'Shaughnessy hauled in a career-high five passes for 57 yards against the Cardinals.
- **Rickey Simpson** picked up his first career sack with on the final play of the first quarter. Simpson finished with a career-high three sacks, three tackles-for-loss and five tackles.
- Redshirt sophomore Pat Meehan tied for the team lead with a career-best eight tackles in the game.
- Matt Meyers hauled in his first career reception and his first touchdown at ISU, when the caught the 5-yard pass from Barnett in late in the second quarter.
- Chick Chatham also hauled in a 29-yard leaping pass on that drive, the first of his career at ISU.
- Senior **Brandon Westphal** recorded his first career sack in the game and finished with two tackles against the Cardinals.
- Former offensive lineman **Sam Campbell** recorded his first career sack as a defensive lineman in the contest.

## TEAM NOTES:

- A total of five different players carried the ball for the Redbirds and eight players caught passes, including four players with their first career receptions at ISU.
- Ball State scored 28 un-answered points in the third quarter to take a lead they would never relinquish, after the Redbirds led 21-9 early in the second quarter.
- ISU held Ball State to just 80 yards rushing, including just 49 yards to Jahwan Edwards who is on several lists as one of the best running backs in FBS football.
- ISU racked up 356 yards of total offense, compared to 420 for BSU.
- Ball State has now won eight-straight games in the series history between the two schools and leads 12-5 in the history of the series.
- Announced attendance was 16,327 at Scheumann Stadium, thanks to a large student crowd and a 'White Out' promotion.
