## Redbirds Open 112th Season at Memphis

The Illinois State baseball program will open its 112th season of competition with a three-game series at Conference USA foe Memphis. The weekend trip to Tennessee marks the first of three-consecutive weekends Illinois State visits the Volunteer state. The opener between the Redbirds and the Tigers is slated for 4:00 p.m. Friday from FedExPark.

The Redbirds open the 2013 season following their third-consecutive 30-plus win campaign, as they completed 2012, 33-19. The Redbirds went 10-9 in Missouri Valley Conference contests, finishing in fourth place. Illinois State returns 21 lettermen from last year's team, including six starters from an offense that averaged 6.9 runs-per-game, good for 12th best in NCAA Division I baseball.

Memphis opens its 100th season of college competition following a 31-28 record last year. The Tigers ended the regular season winning 10 of their final 12 games to qualify for the Conference USA tournament. After winning the first two games in conference tournament play, Memphis fell to Houston and UAB to close their season.

Illinois State is guided by fourth-year head coach Mark Kingston, who earned his 100th career victory in opening round action of the 2012 Missouri Valley Conference Championship. Kingston sports a 101-61 overall record.

The Tigers are led by veteran coach Daron Schoenrock, who is in his ninth season at the helm of the Memphis program. Schoenrock has amassed a 207-250 record at Memphis and is 233-302 overall as a college head coach. Memphis last made a NCAA appearance in 2007.

This weekend, senior right-hander Brad Sorkin (4-3, 4.31 ERA in 2012) takes the mound Friday for Illinois State and will face junior lefty Sam Moll (5-5, 3.48 ERA in 2012). Saturday pits sophomore Redbird southpaw Dylan Craig (8-4, 4.84 in 2012) versus Memphis lefty Erik Schoenrock (2-2, 5.33 ERA). The series-finale will feature Redbird right-hander Dan Savas (DNP, Redshirt in 2012) versus junior college transfer Alex Gunn (DNP in D-I in 2012).

This weekend's series will take place Friday at 4 p.m., Saturday at 2 p.m. and Sunday at 1 p.m.

### The Opposition: Memphis (31-28, 14-10 Conference USA)

- The University of Memphis is located in Memphis, Tenn. The Tigers are members of Conference USA.
Memphis went 31-28 last year and finished 14-10 (third) in C-USA competition.
UE was picked to finish sixth in the C-USA preseason poll.
UE is coached by Daron Schoenrock, who is in his ninth season as head coach. Schoenrock holds a 207-250 record at Memphis, and is 233-302 all-time as a head coach.
Illinois State is 5-20 all-time versus Memphis and the two teams last met in 2007.

### 2012 Season Recap

Illinois State baseball finished the 2012 season, 33-19, marking the first time in program history the Redbirds have registered three consecutive 30-plus win seasons. Highlights included a ten-game winning streak, a complete sweep of the RussMatt Central Florida Invitational and head coach Mark Kingston's 100th career victory.

The Redbirds ten-game winning streak began with a 10-1 victory at Austin Peay on Feb. 19 and extended through a 10-6 win over Iowa on March 11. The Redbirds offense scored at least seven runs in each of the ten wins, including a 28-2 win at Tennessee Tech, Feb. 26. It marked the longest Redbird winning streak since 1984 and fell one game shy of tying the program-record 11-game winning streak from 1976.

Mark Kingston, who enters his fourth season at the helm of the ISU program, earned his 100th career victory in opening round action of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. In his first year as head coach, Illinois State advanced to the NCAA Regional and won a NCAA tournament game. His second year was highlighted by a program-best 36-win season.

Offensively, Illinois State averaged 6.9-runs-per-game, 12th best amongst NCAA Division I baseball programs. Senior Ty Wiesemeyer led the team in batting average (.333) and slugging percentage (.536). Junior outfielder Chad Hinshaw posted a team-best on-base percentage (.442) and led the Redbirds in steals (23-for-26). Junior Eric Aguilera knocked seven home runs to lead the team.

Despite suffering multiple injuries, the pitching staff posted a 4.54 ERA and won 33 games. Freshman lefty Dylan Craig won a team-best eight games. Justin Hauer (3-1, 2.88 ERA) and Kenny Long (2-1, 2.29 ERA, 13 saves) provided one of the best one-two bullpen combos in the Valley.

The Redbirds went 10-9 in Missouri Valley Conference play and finished fourth in the Valley. Aguilera, Long and Zac Johnson earned first-team all-MVC honors.

### 2013 Season Preview

Illinois State returns 21 lettermen from a team that went 33-19 in 2012. Six starters return for an offense that averaged nearly seven runs-per-game last season. 12 pitchers also return to a staff that was injury-plagued in 2012. Additionally, 14 newcomers have been added to the roster.

The 35-man roster features 18 upperclassmen, comprised of nine juniors and nine seniors. 12 players are junior college transfers, including five from Heartland Community College, which is located one mile north of Illinois State University in Normal, Ill.

The 2013 schedule features seven 2012 NCAA Tournament qualifiers (Ausin Peay, Belmont, Creighton, Indiana State, Miami, Missouri State and Purdue) and in addition to three teams that won at least 30 games (Memphis, Evansville and Southern Illinois). Illinois State will play a program-record 29 games at Duffy Bass Field and host the Missouri Valley Conference championship for the first time in program history.

### Redbirds Selected Third in Preseason MVC Coaches' Poll

The Illinois State baseball team was selected to finish third in the Missouri Valley Conference, according to the MVC Preseason Baseball Coaches' Poll released by the Valley offices in January. The Redbirds received 45 total votes, tied with Indiana State for third-highest in the conference. Missouri State was the preseason favorites with 60 points and Wichita State was tabbed second with 47 total points. Illinois State did receive one first-place vote.

### Illinois State Earns Multiple MVC Preseason Honors

Redbird seniors Eric Aguilera, Brett Kay and Zac Johnson were all named All-Missouri Valley Conference Preseason First-Team selections in the MVC Preseason Baseball Coaches' Poll.

Aguilera appeared in 52 games in 2012 and made 49 starts. The outfielder batted .330/.355/.483 with a team-leading seven home runs. The Cary, Ill., native added eight doubles, one triple and collected 36 RBI. Aguilera led the entire Missouri Valley Conference with a .407 batting average in Valley games.

Kay made 41 starts at shortstop and batted .269/.329/.343 with two home runs, 16 RBI and 33 runs scored. He also led the team with 11 sacrifice bunts and stole 14-of-16 (88%) bases.

Johnson, a transfer from Heartland Community College, started 50 games and batted .323/.396/.516 with six home runs and 43 RBI. He led the Redbirds with 15 doubles.

### Baseball America Honors Hollenbeck, Dylan Johnson

In its annual preseason college preview, Baseball America honored two Redbird starters. The publication named junior catcher Mike Hollenbeck as one of the premiere draft-eligible players in the Missouri Valley Conference. It also named Heartland Community College transfer Dylan Johnson as its preseason newcomer of the year.

Hollenbeck takes over the every day catcher duties after batting .298/.408/.416 as a designated hitter in 2012. The Joliet, Ill., native launched three home runs, 10 doubles and added 39 RBI.

Johnson comes to Illinois State after a successful two-year stint at Heartland Community College. As a sophomore, Johnson earned All-America honors after hitting .468 with 11 home runs.

### College Baseball Insider Awards ISU Preseason Accolades

College Baseball Insider issued four preseason awards to Illinois State baseball. The publication named Chad Hinshaw the top defensive outfielder in the MVC as well as the Valley's top baserunner. Eric Aguilera was dubbed a, "top pure hitter" and Zac Johnson was named the, "most underrated hitter."





### 'Birds Shine in Summer Leagues

Following the completion of the 2012 NCAA baseball season, 14 current Redbirds competed in summer collegiate baseball leagues, with five players earning all-star recognition. Each player participated in competitive wooden bat leagues, facing some of the best collegiate talent in the country. "We had many players continue their development this summer," head coach Mark Kingston said. "A number of guys made all-star teams, which shows that we match up well with talent from around the country. Development is very important to us, so summer baseball has become a key piece of that puzzle."

### Duffy Bass Field Receives Field Makeover

In an effort to minimize rainouts and give the Illinois State baseball program and opportunity to practice outside on mild winter days, the Illinois State athletic department has once again invested money into Duffy Bass Field. Following a multi-million dollar upgrade to the facility in 2008, crews have spent this past offseason improving the ballpark's playing surface.

The new playing surface will feature a FieldTurf infield and an improved drainage system for the natural grass outfield. The pitchers mound will remain dirt and be rebuilt. In addition, a new 20-foot tall batters eye has been installed beyond the center field fence.

Illinois State hosts a program-record 29 home games in 2012, starting with an eight-game homestand, March 15-24. Tickets will remain free for all contests at Duffy Bass Field.

### Illinois State to Host MVC Championship

Illinois State will host the 2013 Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Championship at Duffy Bass Field. The Redbirds will hold the eight-team baseball tournament for the first time in program history, after it was awarded to ISU last May.

"A primary focus during the stadium design phase was to have a stadium of sufficient size with proper fan and media amenities to allow us to host postseason baseball, and we certainly accomplished that goal," Illinois State Executive Associate Athletic Director Larry Lyons said. "The stadium is very fan friendly and the media will work in a first-class press box. With the new artificial surface on the infield and new sod in the outfield in line to be installed for the 2013 season, Duffy Bass Field will have a playing surface that is also championship caliber. We are thankful the Valley has chosen us to host the 2013 Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Championship, and we look forward to being in the rotation in future years."

The 2013 Missouri Valley Championship will be played May 21-25, and the champion of the tournament will receive an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

# Head Coach Mark Kingston

In his first three seasons as a head coach, Mark Kingston led Illinois State to three major milestones, including a program-best 36 wins in 2011 and the Redbirds' first-ever Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship in 2010. With a 33-19 overall record in 2012, Kingston became the first coach in Illinois State history to guide the Redbirds to three-straight 30-plus win seasons. Additionally, 16 Redbirds have earned all-MVC honors and four have been drafted under Kingston's leadership.



During his second season at ISU, Kingston not only guided Illinois State to its highest single-season wins-total in school history, but he also coached seven players onto the 2011 All-MVC team. The Redbirds finished the season with a 36-18 record, a third-place MVC finish and a marquee victory at Miami, the school he was an assistant at when the Hurricanes won the 2001 College World Series.

The most successful first-year head coach in ISU baseball history, Kingston coached the 2010 Redbirds to their first-ever share of the MVC regular-season championship, their first State Farm MVC Tournament title since 1994 and their first NCAA Tournament game win since 1976.

The winner of the 2010 MVC Coach of the Year award, Kingston helped second baseman Kevin Tokarski become the first-ever Redbird to earn the MVC Joe Carter Player of the Year Award, the State Farm MVC Tournament Most Outstanding Player Award and three All-America selections. Also during Kingston's first season, six Redbirds were named All-MVC selections.

Upon winning the 2010 State Farm MVC Tournament, six Redbirds earned a spot on the all-tournament team and one ISU player was named to the NCAA all-regional team. Under the direction of Kingston, Illinois State amassed a 32-24 record in 2010, which was not only the most wins for the Redbirds since 1999, but also the most ever by a first-year head coach.

Kingston was named Illinois State's ninth head baseball coach on June 10, 2009 after serving the previous season as the team's associate head coach. Prior to returning to ISU, Kingston spent seven years as recruiting coordinator at Tulane University and served as an assistant on the Miami team that won the 2001 College World Series. He has coached at the collegiate level for 13 years, reaching 500 wins as an assistant in 2009, and was widely respected throughout the sport as one of the top assistants in the nation.

Kingston spent five seasons as associate head coach for the Green Wave with the responsibility of building the Tulane team through recruiting, coaching Tulane hitters and developing catchers and infielders. At Tulane, Kingston's recruiting and coaching efforts helped the Green Wave to six postseason appearances, two NCAA Super Regionals and a berth in the College World Series. The 2005 Green Wave team was seeded as the top-team overall while also receiving the top-academic honor in Omaha. Tulane averaged nearly 42 wins per season with Kingston on staff.

### 31 | Bill Mohl | Fourth Season

After pitching for Mark Kingston as an undergraduate at Tulane, Bill Mohl returns to Illinois State for his fourth season as an assistant coach. Mohl has six years of college coaching experience working closely with pitching staffs. In addition to working with pitchers, Mohl creates scouting reports and assists in recruiting efforts. During his second season at ISU, Mohl guided the 2011 Redbird pitching staff to a 3.30 ERA, which was the second-lowest mark in the Missouri Valley Conference and the lowest ISU team-ERA since 1983. He helped an injury-plagued pitching staff win 33 games in 2012.



### 20 | Mike Current | Eighth Season

Mike Current's hard work and persistent effort have led to steady gains for the Illinois State baseball program in the past eight years. Since the Bloomington, Ill., native joined the Redbirds' coaching staff in 2006, Illinois State has seen its winning percentage increase in each consecutive season, culminating in 2011 with the Redbirds' winningest season in program history. Current also helped ISU earn its first-ever share of the Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championship and the Redbirds' first Valley Tournament title since 1994. He coached ISU to its first winning season in eight years during the 2009 campaign.

### 4 | Bo Durkac | Associate Head Coach | 4th Season

Following the 2012 season, Bo Durkac was elevated to associate head coach. The former professional baseball player spent seven years as an assistant coach at Charlotte before taking over the hitting duties at Illinois State. Durkac's responsibilities at ISU include recruiting and coaching Redbird infielders and hitters. Durkac helped the 2011 Redbirds win a program-record 36 games, while hitting .271 with a Missouri Valley Conference-high .409 slugging percentage and a .385 on-base percentage. ISU also hit 39 home runs, which ranked second in the league. The Redbirds led the MVC in batting average and on-base percentage in 2012.
