

Illinois State Postgame Notes

FINAL – Illinois State 28, South Dakota 14 Oct. 26, 2013 • Hancock Stadium • Normal, Ill.

PLAYER NOTES:

- Marshaun Coprich recorded his fourth-straight 100-plus rushing yard performance with 108 yards on career-high 34 carries against the Coyotes. He recorded one touchdown, bringing up his total to eight for the season.
- Coprich is the first Illinois State running back to tally four-consecutive 100-plus yard rushing games since 2007.
- Senior **Matt Goldsmith** recorded his first career forced-fumble, leading to Coprich's 27-yard touchdown in the third-quarter. Goldsmith ended the game with eight tackles, including a tackle-for-loss.
- Senior wide receiver Corey Shandrick recorded his first touchdown this season, and just the second of his four-year career at ISU. The other came in 2010 in a win over Central Missouri.
- Senior wide receiver **Phil Dudley** recorded his second career touchdown, as he caught a career-long 43-yard pass from **Blake Winkler**.
- Junior wide receiver **Scott Kuehn** scored his first career touchdown, when he caught a career-long 35-yard reception from Winkler.
- Junior defensive lineman **Bradon Prate** recorded his first career interception and returned it for 43 yards. Prate finished the game with three tackles, a sack, three pass breakups and the interception.
- Junior defensive back **Mike Banks** recorded his second interception of the season and the fifth of his career in the final minutes of the game to seal the Redbird victory.
- Sophomore Pat Meehan tied his career high with 11 tackles against the Coyotes.

TEAM NOTES:

- Illinois State tied its record with fewest points allowed this season (14).
- The offical attendance was 11,868, the largest crowd thus far in the newly renovated Hancock Stadium, and marked the third time this season the Redbirds were able to draw a crowd of over 11,000.
- With the victory, the Redbirds improve to 4-0 this season at Hancock Stadium and fifth year head coach Brock Spack is now 21-6 in home games.
- The Redbirds had a pair of one-play scoring drives, each taking just nine seconds off the clock. ISU now has three
 scoring drives of just one play this season, with the other a 12-yard touchdown pass from Winkler to Cameron
 Meredith against Indiana State.
- Saturday's contest marked the third overall meeting between Illinois State and South Dakota, with Illinois State
 improving to 3-0 all-time versus the Coyotes.
