There were 28 crashes the Lincoln Police Department responded to for the month.






Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR)

UCR Report for June 2018








Lincoln Police responded to 1155 incidents for the month of June and 90 case reports were written for the month.



Criminal Investigations

Monthly Cases Report Summary for June 2018

The detectives of the Criminal Investigation Division of the Lincoln Police Department conducted further investigation on <u>18</u> active criminal investigations in the month of June. The types of investigations are listed but due to the sensitivity of those investigations, specific information is not available to for release.

- (6) Investigations were narcotics related. These cases involved the manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance, the manufacture of methamphetamine and the production of cannabis.
- (4) Investigations involved sexual offenses. These crimes involved both adults and children with offenses of criminal sexual assault and criminal sexual abuse.
- (6) Investigations involved crimes against persons. These investigations child abuse and neglect, domestic violence, kidnapping, aggravated discharge of a firearm, and homicides which occurred in jurisdictions outside of Logan County.
- (2) Investigation was a property related crimes.
- Two officers of the Criminal Investigations Division continued to participate in a multijurisdictional drug task force, conducting joint investigations with other local, state, and federal agencies.
- One officer recently attended training on the changes to the asset forfeiture laws. Those include the drug forfeiture act and article 36 forfeitures.

Lincoln K9

Officer Sullivan and K9 Ace had 10 deployments for the month. Lincoln Police Department requested the K9 Unit 7 times and the Logan County Sheriff's Department requested the LPD K9 Unit 3 times. The K9 indicated 6 out of the 10 deployments. Out of the 6 indications, there were 5 items seized being drugs and/or drug paraphernalia. Total amount of drugs seized was 2.2 grams. The drugs indicated were Marijuana and Cocaine.
