City of Lincoln Restaurant and Bar Reopening Guidelines

- 1. A maximum of 3 city parking spaces are permitted. More parking spaces can be allowed with committee approval taking into consideration the needs of adjacent businesses.
- 2. A maximum of 4 picnic tables allowed per establishment, on request, while tables are available.
- City will provide a maximum of 200' of snow fencing, or approved barriers, to fence of dining
 areas. The business is responsible for erecting the fence and must be approved by the Code
 Enforcement Officer.
- 4. Approved barriers cannot be used on sidewalks.
- 5. Tables are permitted on sidewalks but must allow for 4' of passage to meet ADA requirements.
- The use of tents is permitted only within approved parking spaces. If they are left in the parking spaces overnight, they must be collapsed if possible and secured to the street using tap cons or other approved devices.
- 7. Electric cords are permitted as long as they are secured to sidewalks properly to prevent trip hazards.
- 8. Proof of liability insurance must be submitted to the City Clerk's office.
- 9. Business that sell alcohol are encouraged to consult with their insurance company to verify insurability for this period.
- 10. A liability waiver must be signed by all establishments that choose to take advantage of outdoor dining.
- 11. Alcohol is only permitted in approved fenced in areas.
- 12. Alcohol in outdoor dining areas must be served in plastic or aluminum single serving containers.
- 13. The City will provide barricades and signage to instruct drivers to slow down, outdoor dining ahead.
- 14. No burning fire pits are permitted on sidewalks or in outdoor dining areas.
- 15. Limited use of City parking lots may be permitted based on committee approval.
- 16. The City will provide trash receptacles to those establishments with outdoor dining areas.
