COVID-19 Update: April 9, 2020

This is a daily joint communication from the Logan County Department of Public Health and Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital updating you on the status of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Logan County. This communication will come each day as necessary.

A Logan County female in her 30s has been confirmed to be COVID-19 positive. The individual is isolated at home.

The total number of confirmed cases in Logan County is now **3**. Currently, a confirmed positive case from Mason County is hospitalized at Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital.
