

Illinois State Bar Association 2020 Primary Election

JUDICIAL ADVISORY POLL

The advisory poll is conducted by email and mail and is sent to all ISBA members in the circuit or district from which a candidate seeks election (except Cook County). Licensed attorneys who are not members of ISBA, or any attorney outside the circuit or district may request a ballot. Opinions expressed in the poll are of those attorneys who chose to respond and do not reflect the opinion of the Illinois State Bar Association or the opinion of all Illinois Attorneys.

Candidates are rated “recommended” or “not recommended” based on whether respondents agree that the candidate “meets acceptable requirements for the office.” Candidates must receive 65% “yes” responses to that question in order to be “Recommended”. Percentage is based on "yes" responses to each question; "no opinion" responses are not included.
