Backaround

The attached quote is for repair of the influent motor control center air conditioning unit #2.

Analysis/Discussion:

This air conditioning unit is 1 of 4 that cool the influent motor control center. They protect all influent controls, breakers, and drives from thermal failure. We have repaired one other unit this fiscal year, and plan to repair the remaining two as well. This repair exceeded my expense limit, requiring the approval of the City Council. This repair differs from the first due to the fact the blower on this unit has failed; which creates an added cost differing from the first.

Background: The Building and Safety Department received a request to provide a Special Use Permit for the allowance of a Drive-Thru operation in conjunction with a new quick service restaurant to be located at the above noted property.

All public notices and certified mailings were completed per state statute by Building and Safety Department staff. There were no public comments on the request. This will allow the construction and creation of a new business in the City of Lincoln.

PART A. BACKGROUND:

1) **PUBLIC HEARING:** The Planning Commission of the City of Lincoln will conduct a public hearing on Thursday, January 7th, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 700 Broadway Street, Lincoln, Illinois with regards to case No. PC 2021-01. The appropriate Public Hearing notice was submitted on December 14th, 2020 for publication on December 16th,2020. In addition, 4 adjoining property owners within 150' of the subject property were notified by Registered Mail.

- 2) **REQUESTED ACTION:** Allow for a Special Use permit for a drive-thru window at 3103 Woodlawn Rd.
- APPLICANT: BLP Logan County Properties, LLC #1 Burwell Dr., PO Box 430 Lincoln, IL 62656

4) APPLICABLE ZONING REGULATIONS:

11-5-7: SPECIAL USES IN THE C-1 AND C-2 DISTRICTS:

(A) C-1 And C-2 Districts:

Cabinet shops, and specialty arts and crafts assembly shops when all assembly and millwork is done inside a building and any noise, dust, fumes, or odors that may emanate from such uses shall be effectively contained inside a building.

Drive-through facilities. Drive-up or through facilities designed for transactions of business from customers' vehicles, and not otherwise permitted to serve any retail or business use permitted in the district, shall obtain a special use permit. In considering the issuance of a special use permit, the planning commission and the city council shall consider the following, in addition to the other general standards for special uses in section $\underline{11-2-4}$ of this title:

1. Number Of Lanes: To minimize any negative impacts related to drive-through lanes or the potential for circulation conflicts, conflicts with vehicles entering or exiting the site, pedestrian conflicts, and the existing condition of relatively small commercial lot sizes located adjacent to a residential district, no more than one drive-through lane shall be permitted by special use permit in the C-1 or C-2 district where it abuts a residential district.

2. Sufficient Stacking Space: To establish safe stacking space, the following minimum stacking space required is: Four (4) vehicles at each bay window, ordering station or machine and does not obstruct the public right of way or interfere with the ingress or egress to the property.

3. Location: Drive-through facilities shall be prohibited from facing a public street. All drive-through facilities shall be located on the side or rear of the structure that is either facing the site's parking area or internal drive aisle.

4. Interference: There shall be no interference with the operations of other businesses or residential uses in the proximity of the drive-up facility.

5. Other Matter or Information: Any other matter or information determined to be relevant to the reasonableness of the proposed use. (Ord. 585, 1-20-2004; and. Ord. 2014-808, 5-19-2014)

PART B. ISSUE:

Representatives from BLP Logan County Properties, LLC approached the Building and Safety Department with a request for a Special Use Permit to allow for a drive thru facility. They intend on constructing a new, standalone Quick Service Restaurant at this location which would require the use of a drive thru window for appropriate customer service.

The intended parcel of land lies within an I-1 zoning district, while C-1 and C-2 uses are allowed in this district they must subsequently adhere to requirements set forth in the C districts and thereby require a Special Use Permit for a drive-thru.

PART C. ANALYSIS:

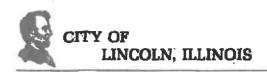
Upon review, with regards to city code, staff has surmised that all requirements as indicated in 11-5-7 of the Lincoln Municipal Code have been met.

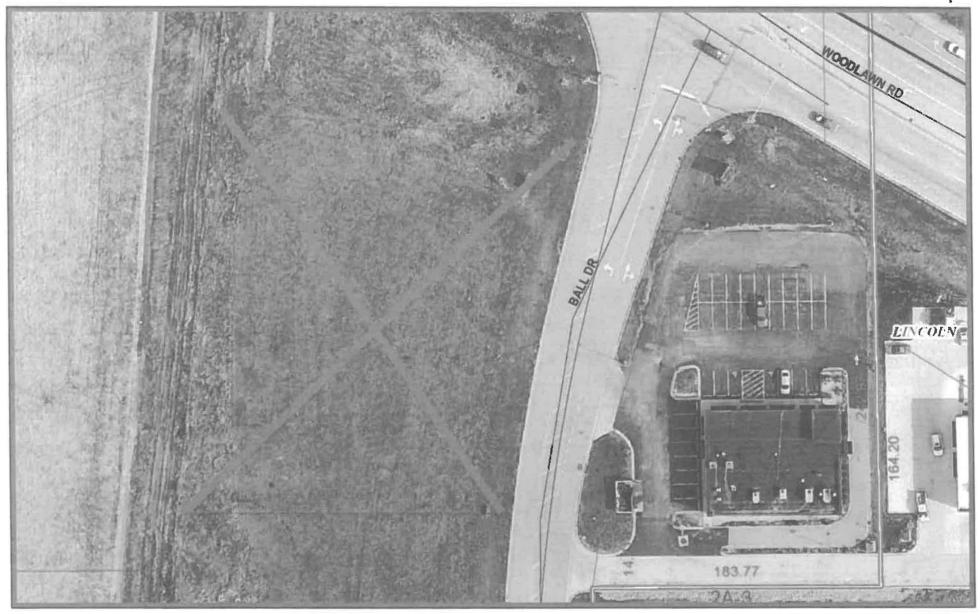

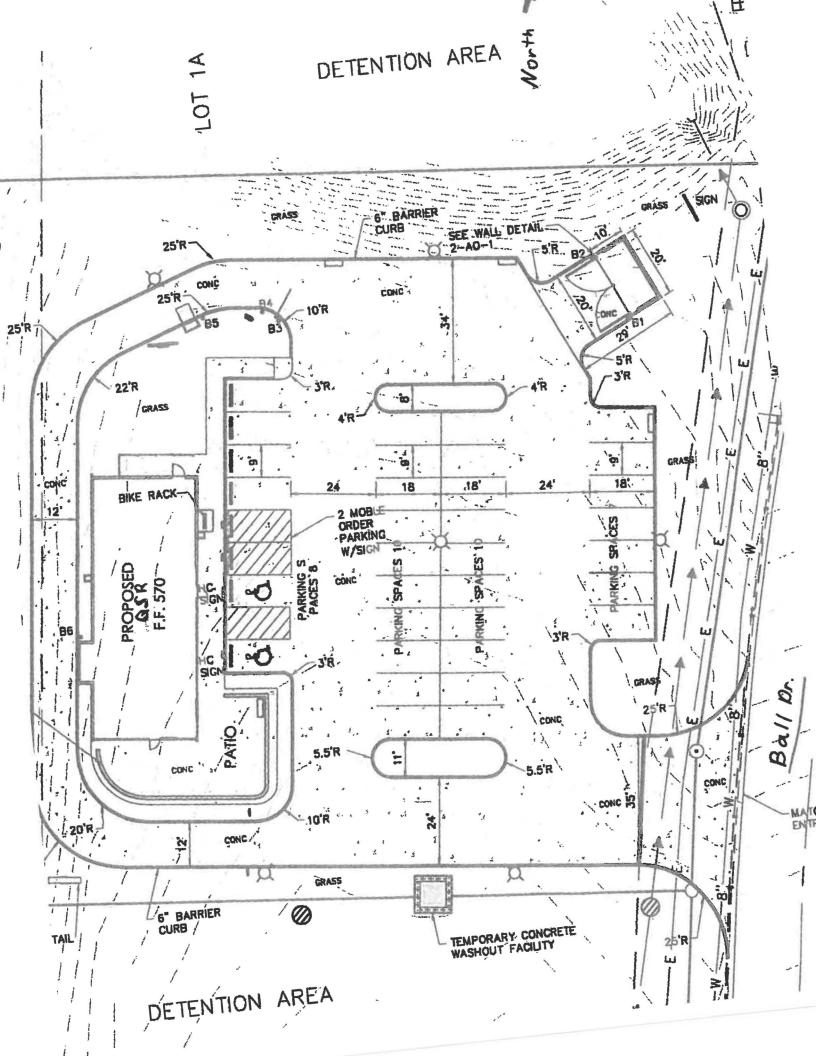

Re: Courthouse Fiber Connection

Background

Many years ago Logan County received funding to build a fiber optic network between their buildings with the Courthouse being the central point of connection. This project also connected Lincoln City Hall to the Courthouse with a fiber optic line. It was never hooked up as nothing was being shared at that time to do the actual network connections.

Analysis/Discussion

With the consolidation of Logan County and Sangamon County using the same servers Lincoln Fire Department will need a connection to the Illinois Century Network (ICN) which comes into the Safety Complex.

Also City Hall will be connected to the Police Station so that we could consolidate servers in the futures and share resources. This will help to build out a City Network hopefully connecting all of our buildings in the future.

The fiber is terminated on our side, all connections completed, however the fiber will need to be terminated and connected on the Courthouse side. We will need to buy fiber optic transceivers and run a fiber cable from the basement to our network firewall.

Fiscal Impact

To terminate the fiber at the Courthouse will cost \$1985, per quote from Anderson Electric. There is about \$300 in equipment and fiber cabling patch cables to be purchased and labor to install those items.

Recommendation

Approve the quote from Anderson Electric for \$1985 to terminate and test fiber optic cabling.

<u>Background:</u> Due to Covid restrictions and the shutdown of Local Businesses this past year, I propose the council to vote on reduction of certain Liquor License Packages.

Class A – Package Fee to remain the same with no reduction Class B – Restaurant/Tavern Fee to be reduced 50% going from \$1,250.00 to \$625.00 Class B Restaurant/Tavern with Gaming Fee to be reduced 50% going from \$2,250.00 to \$1,125.00 Class C Wine Cellar Fee to be reduced 50% going from \$700.00 to \$350.00 Class D- Microbrewery, Class E-Caterer, Class F-Recurring Fee to remain the same with no reduction Club License without Gaming Fee to be reduced 50% going from \$350.00 to \$175.00 Club License with Gaming Fee to be reduced 50% going from \$350.00 to \$175.00

Total reduction in fees for F.Y. 21/22 would be \$38,250.00 based on the number of Licenses paid in F.Y. 20/21. Applications and fees will be due by April 9, 2021. This allows time for Applications and License to be processed for Liquor Commission to approve. This proposed reduction excludes any new Liquor License applicants.
