



COVID-19 Update: January 22, 2021

This is a joint communication from the Logan County Department of Public Health and Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital updating you on the status of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Logan County.

The Logan County Department of Public Health has confirmed the following new cases of COVID-19 in Logan County. Positives are from the last 11 days.

**** 165 individuals ranging in age from 4 years of age to 86 years of age both symptomatic and asymptomatic.

The total number of confirmed positive cases in Logan County is now 3,056 including 2,876 individuals who have recovered, 142 active cases and 38 fatalities.

We are saddened to announce the death of a Logan County resident to COVID-19.

We are beginning to vaccinate those in group 1b (65+, frontline essential workers, school personnel, police, fire, and EMS) and finishing up 1a (healthcare personnel). NOTE: A recovered individual is someone who has tracked their symptoms twice daily and reported that they have been fever free for 24 hours to the Logan County Department of Public Health. The total number of positives on the Logan County dashboard represents a historical running total of confirmed positive cases. Recovered individuals are never removed from the total number of positives.
