Trusting God's Timing

When man first stepped on the moon, President Nixon, without thinking,

called it the most important event in history. Billy Graham corrected him, "The most important event in history was not when man stepped on the moon, but when God stepped on the earth in the human form of Jesus Christ".

A lot of planning and timing, perfect timing, went into the landing on the moon. However, even more planning and timing went into Jesus's coming.

When was the last time you considered God's timing through history? How many times was His timing perfect for what He was planning?

In Genesis 37, Joseph was sold to Egypt at just the right time to be made second in command and ultimately save his own family from starvation...

In Exodus 2, Moses was pulled from the Nile River at just the right time by the Pharaoh's daughter...

In Esther 4, Esther was made queen at just the right time to save her people from extermination... Esther 4:14 says "God made you queen for such a time as this!"

Galatians 4:4 tells us that "just at the right time, God sent his Son..." Everything we have come to love in the Christmas story was God's perfect timing: the shepherds in the fields; the star in the east; the census in Bethlehem; the full inn; everything was all part of God's timing. It's all there in scripture and a part of history to teach us that God is in control, that He has a plan, and that He can be trusted.

Yes, even the cross was the perfect timing. "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly" Romans 5:6.

Now, consider one more thing; God's timing can be trusted in our lives too. I've found great comfort in Psalm 31:15, "My times are in your hand."

Today, you can relax and trust that whatever will happen will in someway work out for you. God's in control and his plans are in motion. So relax!

"He made all things beautiful in his time...who can even fathom what God has done from beginning to end." Ecclesiastes 3:11

Today, Lord, help me to trust you more!



Missions Spotlight: Bob Miller, Restoration House Ministries, New England

Bob's ministry position has changed from Director of Hospitality to Director of Church Planting. The newest church plant is Beacon Church in Derry, New Hampshire which launched on March 28. It is led by two families with several years of ministry experience. The church has established several partnerships to build relationships: volunteering in a soup kitchen, establishing four home groups, Family Day at the Movies. Their launch day on March 28 was attended by 100 plus people. Restoration House Ministries has also launched churches among Chinese, Korean, Cambodian, and African people groups. Eric Lee has taken the position as director of the ministry after the retirement of Danny Clymer, founding director in 1996.
