ORDINANCE REDISTRICTING THE WARD BOUNDARIES WITHIN
THE CITY OF LINCOLN, LOGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln is a municipal corporation situated in Logan County, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, Title 1, Chapter 15, Section 1 of the Lincoln City Code describes the 4 wards within the City of Lincoln; and,

WHEREAS, the population distribution in the existing wards has become unevenly distributed due to population shifts; and,

WHEREAS, the circumstances that currently exist within the City of Lincoln require that the City of Lincoln redistrict the ward boundaries to more equally distribute the population and to decrease the number of wards from 5 to 4, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/3. 1-20-10; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln has commissioned the drafting of a proposed ward map for the City of Lincoln, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and by this reference made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the citizens of the City of Lincoln, Logan County, Illinois, that the City of Lincoln be redistricted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Logan County, Illinois, as follows:

1. That all recitals are incorporated herein as if appearing verbatim.
2. That Title 1, Chapter 15, Section 1 is deleted, and the following is inserted in place thereof:

“1-15-1: City Divided Into Wards

1-15-1: CITY DIVIDED INTO WARDS: The City of Lincoln shall be and is hereby divided into four (4) wards as set forth on the ward map dated _____, and recorded in the Logan County Recorder’s Office and more specifically described as follows:

Ward 1: All that portion of said City that lies within the following limits: Beginning at the intersection of Union Street and ~~8th~~ 7th street, then Westerly along ~~8th~~ 7th street to the intersection of North State Street, then Northerly along North State Street to 11th Street, then Westerly along 11th Street to North Jackson Street, then Northerly along North Jackson Street to ~~Woodlawn Road~~ 16th Street, then Westerly along 16th Street to the intersection of Adams Street, then Northerly along Adams Street to the intersection of Woodlawn Road, then Westerly along Woodlawn Road to ~~North Monroe~~ North Jefferson Street, then Northerly along ~~North Monroe~~ North Jefferson Street to the Corporate Limits, the Easterly along the Corporate Limit line to the intersection of the ~~Illinois Central~~ Canadian National Railroad right of way, then Southeasterly along the ~~Illinois Central~~ Canadian National Railroad right of way to the Intersection of the municipal right of way between North Logan Street and Sangamon Street, then Southwesterly along the municipal right of way to the intersection of Peoria Street, then Northwesterly along Peoria Street to its intersection with Union Street, then Southerly along Union Street to the point of beginning.

Ward 2: All that portion of said City that lies within the following limits: Beginning at the intersection Union Street and 8th 7th Street, then Westerly along 8th 7th street to the intersection of North State Street, then Northerly along North State Street to 11th Street, then Westerly along 11th Street to North Jackson Street, then Northerly along North Jackson Street to the intersection of ~~Woodlawn road~~ 16th Street, , then Westerly along 16th Street to the intersection of Adams Street, then Northerly along Adams Street to the intersection of Woodlawn Road, then Westerly along Woodlawn Road to the intersection of ~~North Monroe~~ Jefferson Street, then Northerly along ~~North Monroe~~ Jefferson Street to the Corporate Limit line, then generally Westerly and Southerly along the Corporate Limit line to the intersection of Lincoln Parkway and Broadwell Drive, then Easterly along the Corporate Limit line to the ~~East/West Lincoln Township line~~ Union Pacific Railroad, then Northeasterly along the Union Pacific Railroad to the East/West Lincoln Township line, then Northerly to the point of beginning.

Ward 3: All that portion of said City that lies within the following limits: Beginning at the Intersection of Union Street and 8th 7th street, then Northerly along Union Street to the intersection of Union Street and Peoria Street, then Southeasterly along Peoria Street to North Sangamon Street, then Southeasterly to Pekin Street, then Southeasterly along Pekin Street to North Butler Street, then Northeasterly along North Butler Street to Tremont Street, then Southeasterly along Tremont street to Easterly end of Limit Street, then Northerly along Limit Street jogging slightly Northwesterly to Campus View Drive, then Northerly along Campus View Drive to Route 10, then Easterly on Route 10 to the Corporate Limit line, the generally Southerly and Westerly along the Corporate Limit line to the Southeast corner of the Corporate Limits, then generally ~~Easterly~~ Westerly along the Corporate Limit Line to the ~~East/West Lincoln Township line~~ Union Pacific Railroad, then Northeasterly along the Union Pacific Railroad to the East/West Lincoln Township line, then Northerly along the East/West Lincoln Township line to the point of beginning.

Ward 4: All that portion of said City that lies within the following limits: Beginning at the intersection of Tremont Street and the Easterly end of Limit Street, then Northerly along Limit Street jogging slightly Northwesterly to Campus View Drive, then Northerly along Campus View Drive to Route 10, then generally Northerly and Easterly along the Corporate Limit line to the Northeast corner of the Corporate Limits, then Westerly along the Corporate Limit Line to the intersection of the ~~Illinois Central~~ Canadian National Railroad right of way, then Southeasterly along the ~~Illinois Central~~ Canadian National Railroad right of way to the intersection of the Municipal right of way between North Logan Street and Sangamon Street, then Southwesterly along the Municipal right of way to Peoria Street, then Southeasterly along Peoria Street to Sangamon Street, then Southwesterly along Sangamon Street to Pekin Street, the Southeasterly along Pekin Street to North Butler Street, then Northeasterly along North Butler Street to Tremont Street, then Easterly along Tremont Street to the point of beginning.”

3. That should any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be declared invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
5. That the City Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Logan County Recorder.

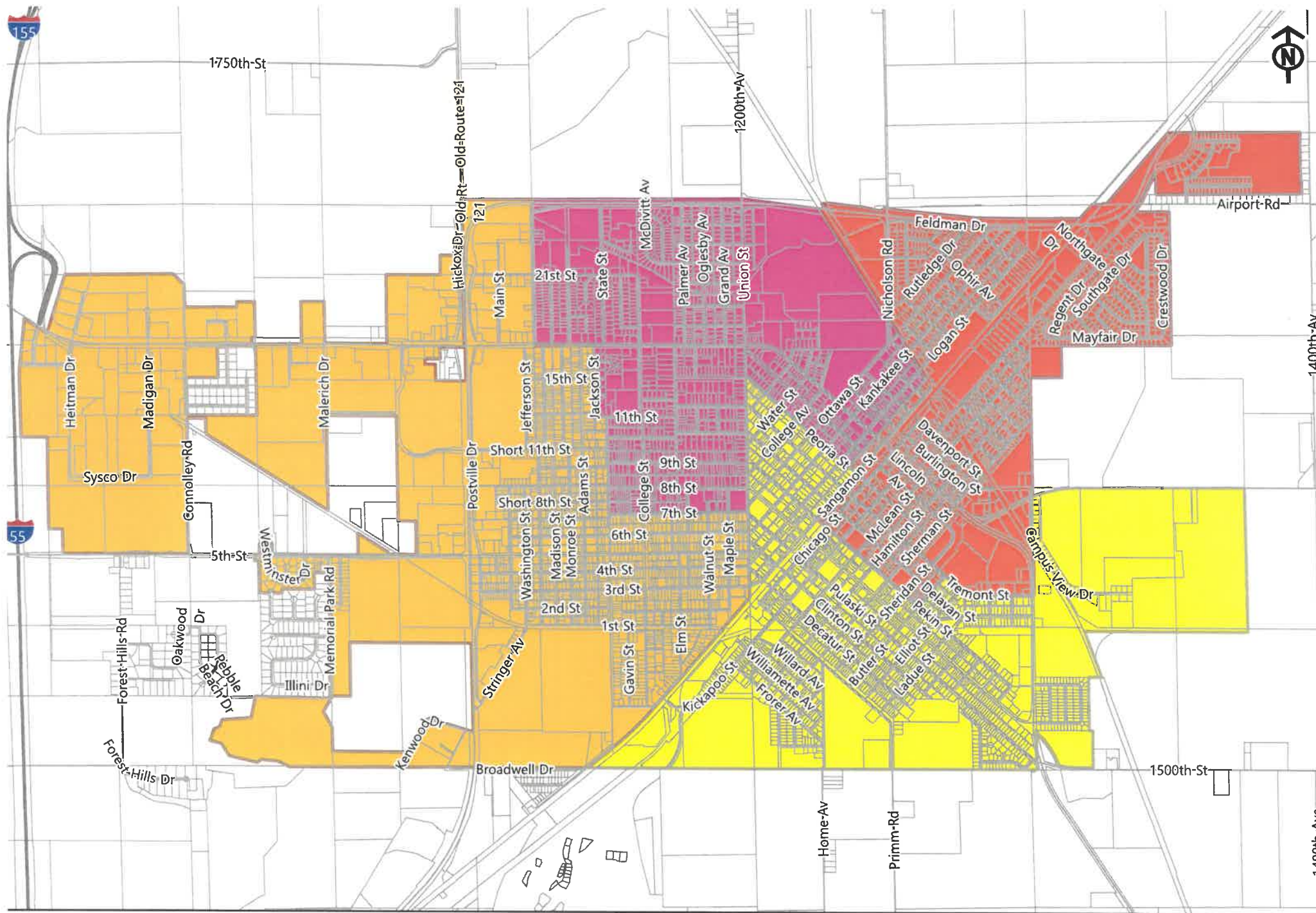

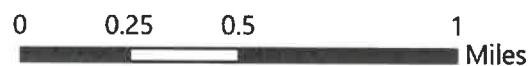

Logan County, Illinois

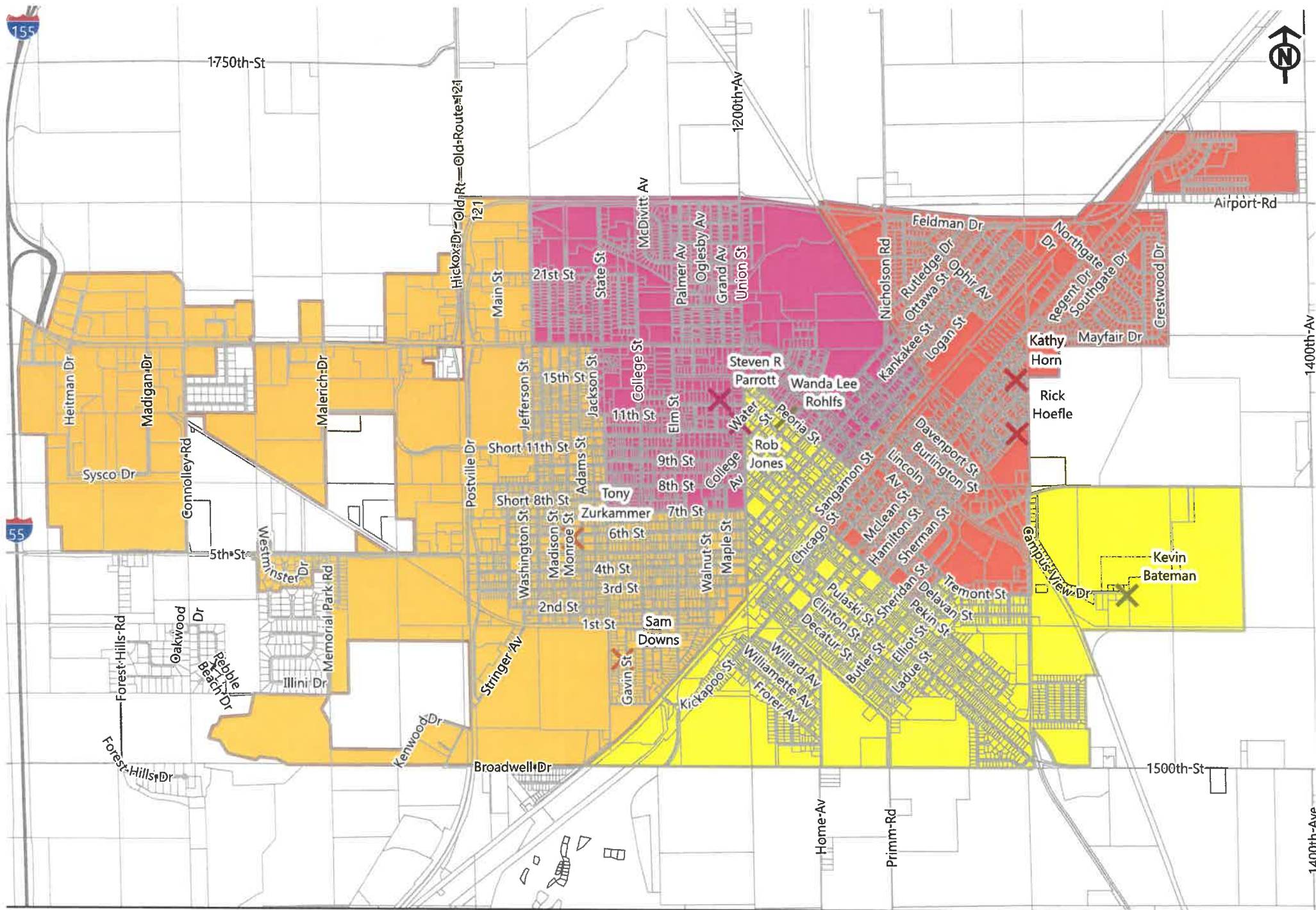

RE: Belt Filter Press Replacement Parts

Background

The current sludge belts on the belt filter press are starting to deteriorate, and need to be replaced.

Analysis/Discussion:

These are normal wear items that have to be replaced every couple of years. The currently installed belts have reached the end of their life cycle and must be replaced. This piece of equipment de-waters the solids in the plant, so that they may be land applied.

Fiscal Impact:

The belts will cost \$6,321.37 plus freight which is currently quoted at \$126.29 for a total of \$6,447.66.

Council Recommendation:

Approve the purchase and delivery of the belts, to be expensed from line item "50-7400-5116 Supplies-Materials".

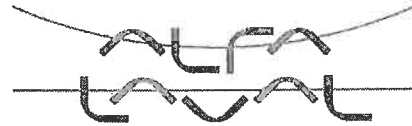
