# TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

### CITY OF LINCOLN

### ORDINANCE NO. 2022-

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVYING OF TAXES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES, IN FOR THE CITY OF LINCOLN, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2022 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2023.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lincoln, Logan County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as man be authorized by law, and the same are here? levied upon all property subject to taxation within the municipality as that property is assessed and equalized of the current year, and for such purposes as General corporate, Police Protection, Fire Protection, Streets and Alleys (Streets & Bridge), Audit, ESDA, Forestry, Liability Insurance, IMRF-Soc. Security, Public Benefits, Crossing Guards, Debt Service, Sewerage O. & M. (Chlorination), Police Pension, Firemen's Pension and Firemen's Spouse Benefit for the City of Lincoln, Logan County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2022 and ending April 30, 2023.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose is placed in a separate column under the heading, "Amount Of Tax Levy which appears over same being as follows, to wit:



WITNESSETH:	

WHEREAS, the CITY OF LINCOLN is a municipal corporation located in Logan County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF LINCOLN acknowledges that the City of Lincoln had, at one point in the past, included provisions within the Lincoln City Code that provided for the 10% discount of constituents paid for their sewer bill a year in advance; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF LINCOLN desires to reintroduce those provisions in reinsert them into the city code provision "method of payment" under 7-8-1-14, which is where said terms for the 10% discount previously existed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, as follows:

- 1. That the City of Lincoln will amend 7-8-1-24 to add language providing for an avenue for constituents whose residential accounts are in good standing to have a 10% discount if they pay a year in advance when they receive their February bill and pay for the whole year
  - 2. Effective Date. That this Ordinance is effective upon passage of the same.

# **EXHIBIT A**

§ 7-8-1-14 **Method Of Payment.** 

[Ord. No. 2018-877, 4-16-2018; amended by Ord. 2018-878, 5-21-2018, eff. 6-1-2018]

All charges for sewerage service should accrue monthly on the first day of each month. The owner of the premises, the occupant, or the user of the sewerage system shall be jointly and severally liable to pay for the service on the premises, and the service is furnished to the premises by the City only upon the condition that the owner of the premises, the occupant, or the user of the service are jointly and severally liable for the payment of all charges to the City. All monthly bills for services shall be rendered as of the first day of the previous month for which the service is billed, and shall be payable not later than the close of business on the 20th day from the date of the bill. An additional charge in the amount of \$5 shall be added to any bill not paid by the 20th day after the date that the bill is rendered. An additional penalty of \$25 per month shall be added for so long as the bill remains unpaid, effective on the 45th day after the original billing.

Constituents whose residential accounts are in good standing can avail themselves of a ten percent (10%) discount if they pay a year in advance. The window for a citizen of Lincoln to take advantage of the discount shall be between receiving the February bill and that February bill's due date. Once the due date of the February bill has passed a constituent can no longer take advantage of the discount. It shall be the responsibility of the constituent to proactively inform the clerk's office if they intend to take advantage of this program. This discount can only be utilized with residential accounts.
