## UNI TRAVELS TO ILLINOIS STATE

The University of Northern Iowa men's basketball team (16-8, 7-6 Missouri Valley Conference) heads to Normal, Ill., to face Illinois State on Saturday. The Panthers lost to Creighton on Wednesday night, 83-82, in Omaha.

## SCOUTING THE REDBIRDS

**Illinois State** is 16-7 overall and 8-5 in the MVC. ISU is 10-2 at home this season after Thursday night's loss to Wichita State in Normal. Forward Gordon Lorenzo leads the team with 17.3 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. Guard Trey Guidry is the only other player in double figures at 14.4 points per game. ISU is shooting 46.3 percent from the field, including 36.3 percent from beyond the arc, and 65.1 percent at the line while averaging 68.0 points and 32.8 rebounds per game. Its opponents are shooting 43.6 percent from the field, 34.7 percent from three-point range, and 67.0 percent at the charity stripe while averaging 64.1 points and 33.6 rebounds

## SERIES HISTORY

**Illinois State** leads this series, which began in the 1959-60 season, 30-13 but the Panthers have a two-game win streak after defeating the Redbirds 75-55 on Jan. 3 in the UNI-Dome. UNI is 3-17 in Normal. The Panthers won 64-61 at Redbird Arena last year.

## UNI-ISU ON FOX 28

Saturday's 4:05 p.m. game at Illinois State will be carried live by FOX 28. Rob Brooks and Kevin Boyle are the announcers. Satellite coordinates are SBS 6, Transponder 2, KU band. The downlink frequency is 11749 vertical.

## BRACKET BUSTER OPPONENT

UNI will host Western Michigan (15-8, 8-5 Mid-American Conference) on Feb. 19 in Bracket Buster Saturday, ESPN announced Jan. 31. The Panthers' clash with the Broncos will be one of 11 games televised that day -- one on ESPN, five on ESPN2 and five on ESPN Full Court. UNI's game versus WMU will be carried on ESPN2 at 3 p.m. central time. UNI has gone on the road the first two years of BBS and posted wins at Louisiana Tech (76-71, 2003) and Wisconsin-Green Bay (82-75, 2004). The Panthers also won both of those return games to the UNI-Dome the following seasons and thus is a perfect 4-0 in BBS-scheduled games. As part of the Bracket Buster arrangement, the Panthers will play at Western Michigan in 2005-06.

**UNI HEAD COACH GREG McDERMOTT**

**Greg McDermott (UNI '88)** is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater, and in his 11th season as a head coach overall. He has compiled a 62-50 mark at UNI, 34-33 in the MVC. Overall, he has a career coaching record of 193-114, including six years at Wayne State (Neb.), and one year at North Dakota State.

Last season, McDermott led UNI to a 21-10 record, a first-ever Missouri Valley Conference championship, and the team's second-ever NCAA I tournament appearance. The Panthers' 12-6 MVC record and #2 seed in the league tournament were program-bests since joining the Valley in 1992.

Prior to coming to UNI, McDermott guided Wayne State to four consecutive 20-win seasons with a conference championship and an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance. He was the 1998-99 NABC/Chevrolet North Central District Coach of the Year, and the 1999-2000 Northern Sun Coach of the Year. A native of Cascade, Iowa, McDermott played for UNI from 1984-88, scoring 1,033 points (currently 24th on the Panthers' all-time scoring list), and led the team in field goal percentage three straight seasons.

**McDERMOTT SHOWS**

UNI head coach Greg McDermott's weekly call-in show can be heard each Thursday from 6-7 p.m. on KXEL. The show airs live from Pepper's Grill and Sports Pub in Cedar Falls. KFXA (Fox 28) airs McDermott's weekly coach's television show each Saturday morning at 11:00 a.m., and the show also airs on Fox College Sports each Wednesday afternoon at 3:30 p.m.

**PANTHERS ON THE RADIO**

UNI's men's basketball games can be heard on the UNI Sports Network, with KXEL 1540-AM serving as the flagship station. Affiliates include KGLO (1300 AM, Mason City), KPSZ (940 AM, Des Moines) and KQWC (1570 AM/95.7 FM, Webster City). Long-time Panther announcer Gary Rima handles play-by-play duties, while former UNI assistant coach Kevin Boyle serves as analyst. All Panther games also are streamed on UNI's official athletics website, [www.unipanthers.com](http://www.unipanthers.com).

**UNI ON TELEVISION**

The Panthers appear numerous times on television again this season. Local affiliate KFXA (Fox 28) will broadcast one more UNI game, this Saturday afternoon (Feb. 12) at Illinois State.

The Panthers will appear twice more on the Missouri Valley Conference's regional television package -- Feb. 23 at Southern Illinois and Feb. 28 at Wichita State. UNI also will appear on ESPN2 on Feb. 19 at 3:00 p.m. as part of Bracket Buster III against Western Michigan. That game will be played in the UNI-Dome and will be the first regular-season game from Cedar Falls ever telecast nationally. In addition, the Panthers' Feb. 26 game with Bradley at the UNI-Dome will be telecast by HDNet, a nationwide high-definition network.

**LAST TIME OUT FOR THE PANTHERS...**

Omaha, Neb.—Junior guard Ben Jacobson (Sioux City, Iowa) scored a career-high 31 points, but it was not enough as the University of Northern Iowa fell to Creighton, 83-82, Wednesday night at the Qwest Center.

Jacobson hit 14-of-24 shots from the field on the night, including 3-of-6 from three-point range, and also grabbed seven rebounds, had four assists and two steals. He scored 22 points in the second half alone, with 10 coming in the game's final 42 seconds during a furious rally that nearly saw the Panthers pull out the victory.

The game was tied at 60-all with just over six minutes remaining when Creighton went on a 9-0 run to open a 69-60 edge with 3:04 left. UNI cut the lead to six on several occasions, but was forced to foul as the game drew to a close, and the Bluejays responded by hitting 10 straight free throws at one stretch.

Still, UNI kept answering Creighton's scores, and when Jacobson hit a deep trey with nine seconds left it pulled UNI within 83-79. Creighton's Tyler McKinney then missed both free throws, and Jacobson pulled up in transition and nailed a 25-footer to pull the Panthers within one, 83-82, but less than a second remained in the game. Creighton inbounded the ball to earn the victory.

Creighton jumped out to an early 14-3 lead in the game's opening five minutes, hitting six of its first seven shots from the field. UNI battled back to pull within one, 19-18, on a Pete Schmit (St. Charles, Ill.) three-pointer with 9:29 left. But Creighton answered with a jumper by Nate Funk and a Kellen Miliner three-pointer to extend its lead to 26-18. The Bluejays held a 33-28 lead at halftime.

UNI went on a 12-3 run to open the second half and open its largest lead of the game, 40-36, with 17:07 left. Jacobson and Brooks McKown (Fairbank, Iowa) each had three-pointers during that stretch. The Panthers last held the lead, 58-57, after an Eric Coleman (Maplewood, Minn.) layup with 6:48 left.

The Panthers shot 51.6 percent from the field for the game (32-for-62), including 11-for-21 on threes. UNI hit 60.6 percent of its shots in the second half (20-for-33). Creighton was nearly as accurate, shooting 50.9 percent from the field (27-for-53). UNI won the battle of the boards, 32-29, but Creighton hit 22-of-24 free throws on the night, while UNI hit just 7-of-14.

**CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR**

The Panthers' 83-82 loss to Creighton Feb. 9 was just the latest in a series of close losses this season. Wednesday's result dropped UNI to 0-3 in games decided by three points or less this year, including a pair of one-point losses to the Bluejays (CU won 67-66, Jan. 15 in Cedar Falls). UNI also fell 76-73 at Iowa Dec. 7, and dropped a 76-70 double-overtime decision at Cincinnati Nov. 24.

**BACK ON TRACK**

UNI connected on 11-of-21 three-pointers against Creighton on Wednesday night in Omaha, continuing its recent hot shooting. After going through a recent five-game stretch connecting on just 25.9 percent of its treys (28-for-108), the Panthers have hit on 43.6 percent (34-for-78) of its three-pointers over their past four games. UNI has connected on 10 or more three-pointers in a game four times this season, with a high of 13 against Wagner Dec. 21.

## STOUT BREAKS SCHOOL RECORD FOR BLOCKED SHOTS

Sophomore forward **Grant Stout** has 53 blocked shots this season, which is a new UNI single-season record. Stout set the mark Feb. 5 against Southern Illinois, breaking the record of Scott Stafford (51 blocks in the 1983-84 season). Stout is already third on UNI's career blocked shots list with 70. Next for Stout to pass on the career list is Stafford, who had 85. Sean Hawkins (1995-98) is UNI's career leader with 118.

## JACOBSON TALLIES CAREER HIGH AGAINST BLUEJAYS

Junior guard Ben Jacobson scored a career-high 31 points against Creighton Feb. 9, connecting on 14-of-24 shots from the floor and 3-of-6 on three-pointers. He also was big in the clutch, as he scored 10 of his points in the game's final 45 seconds during a furious UNI rally that saw the Panthers come from 11 down in the game's final minute to lose by just one, 83-82.

## BREAKING OUT

The Panthers shot 51.6 percent from the field against Creighton Wednesday night, marking the 14th time this season UNI has shot better than 50 percent from the field. However, it was just the third time in the team's past eight games that the Panthers have shot better than 40 percent from the field, as the team was going through a team-wide shooting slump. UNI broke out against the Bluejays, connecting on 32-of-62 field goals for the game, including 11-of-21 on three-pointers. UNI was red-hot against CU in the second half, hitting 20-of-33 shots (60.6 percent).

## PANTHER QUICK NOTES

Ben Jacobson averaged 12.5 points and 5.0 assists against Evansville and Southern Illinois last week while battling the flu in both games. He scored a game-high 18 points against Southern Illinois Feb. 5, hitting three-of-four three-pointers. Jacobson received an IV at halftime of the SIU game and scored nine points in the second half ... The Panthers have held three of their last five opponents to under 40 percent shooting for the game. UNI has held its opponent to less than 40 percent shooting nine times this season and is 8-1 in those games. The lone loss was a 76-70 double-overtime loss at Cincinnati, when UNI held the Bearcats to just 28.6 percent shooting.

## SHARP SHOOTER

Panther junior guard **Ben Jacobson** is having a remarkable season for the Panthers. The 6-3, 195-pounder leads the team and now is second in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring at 17.9 points per game. But that just tells part of the story. Jacobson is shooting 50.8 percent from the field for the season (163-321), which is 10th in the conference. He also leads the league in three-point field goal percentage at 49.1 (54-110), and would be among the leaders nationally but he does not qualify as he has not made the NCAA-mandated minimum of 2.5 made per game.

## PANTHERS ENJOYING ONE OF BEST SEASONS IN SCHOOL HISTORY

UNI is 16-8 after 24 games, the school's best record this far into a season since the 1989-90 team was 17-7. That 1989-90 team, under the direction of Eldon Miller, made the school's first-ever appearance in the NCAA I tournament. The best start ever to a Panther season is 19-1 by the 1963-64 team, coached by Norm Stewart, with that squad advancing to the NCAA College Division National Tournament.

## MEET THE NEW CHRIS. SAME AS THE OLD CHRIS.

Senior point guard **Chris Foster** suffered a season-ending knee injury late last season, missing UNI's final regular season game and all four of the Panthers' post-season contests. After surgery and rehab, Foster was back and ready to play for the start of UNI's 2004-05 regular season. Despite being less than one year out from the injury, Foster has continued to provide a much-needed spark off the Panthers' bench and as an occasional starter. He is averaging 5.8 points, 1.6 rebounds and 2.6 assists per game for the season, but is averaging 7.8 points, 2.1 rebounds and 2.6 assists over the past 10 games, with his three starts being during that span.

**JACOBSON TOPS 1,000 CAREER POINTS...**

UNI junior guard **Ben Jacobson** reached 1,000 career points against Indiana State on Jan. 9. The 6-3, 195 pound native of Sioux City, IA, became the 27th player in UNI history to reach that milestone, and just the 15th since the Panthers turned Division I in the 1981-82 season. In addition, Jacobson -- who currently has 1,177 points -- is just the sixth UNI player to reach the century mark in scoring in his junior campaign.

**... AND PASSES HIS COACH AGAINST CREIGHTON**

**Ben Jacobson** now ranks 14th on UNI's career scoring chart with 1,177 points, after his career-best 31-point effort against Creighton on Wednesday. On Jan. 15 against Creighton at the UNI-Dome, he passed his current coach, Greg McDermott, who had 1,033 points from 1985-88. Next for Jacobson to pass on UNI's scoring list is Tony Brus, who had 1,179 points from 1996-99. At his current pace, Jacobson could end this season as high as seventh on UNI's career scoring list.

**PANTHERS RANK 19TH NATIONALLY IN FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE**

UNI is shooting .489 from the field, which leads the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks 19th in the NCAA in the most recent set of national statistics (Feb. 7). The Panthers have shot better than 50 percent from the field as a team in 14 games this season. UNI has posted a better shooting percentage than its opponent a total of 19 times and has a record of 16-3 in those games.

**UNI SNAPS TWO-GAME HOME LOSING STREAK**

The Panthers defeated Indiana State 69-61 on Jan. 26 to end a rare two-game home losing streak. Creighton's buzzer-beating 67-66 win over UNI Jan. 15 snapped an 11-game home winning streak for the Panthers dating back to last year. Wichita State's 65-57 win Jan. 24 at the UNI-Dome gave UNI consecutive home losses for the first time since the 2002-03 season, when SMS and Southern Illinois did the trick.

**BRINGING THE "O"**

This year's version of the Panthers is tied for the lead in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring, averaging 73.7 points per game. UNI has scored better than 80 points seven times this year, including a high of 99 against Iowa State Dec. 1. The last time a UNI team averaged more than 75 points per game for an entire season was in the 1995-96 campaign, when Eldon Miller's squad averaged 77.2 points per contest.

**A STOUT FORCE INSIDE**

Sophomore forward **Grant Stout** had his best game as a Panther against Illinois State Jan. 3. The 6-8, 220-pound Stout scored 18 points and grabbed a career-best 15 rebounds to lead UNI to a 75-55 win over the Redbirds. Stout hit nine-of-13 shots from the field in the game and also blocked four shots. Stout, who has seven double-doubles on the year, also stepped up on Feb. 2 against Evansville, when he had a career-high 24 points and grabbed nine rebounds against the Purple Aces at the UNI-Dome. For the season, Stout is averaging 11.4 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.3 blocked shots per game, which is among the MVC's top 15 in each statistical category.

**PROTECTING THE BALL**

UNI's five-guard rotation of **Erik Crawford, Ben Jacobson, Chris Foster, John Little** and **Brooks McKown** have 279 assists and just 169 turnovers this season. McKown, Foster, Crawford and Jacobson each rank among the top 15 in the Missouri Valley Conference in assist/turnover ratio.

**STRONG START NOTHING NEW FOR McDERMOTT SQUAD**

This year's squad started the year 10-2, one of the best starts in school history. But under fourth-year head coach Greg McDermott, a strong start to the season is par for the course. In three of McDermott's four years at the Panther helm, the team has gotten out of the gates the right way: UNI was 6-2 in McDermott's inaugural season of 2001-02, and went 7-3 to begin the 2003-04 campaign.

## WHAT, ME WORRY?

One concern for the Panthers entering this season was the youth in the frontcourt, and whether UNI would be able to find capable replacements for the departed **David Gruber** and **Matt Schneiderman**. Those worries have been dispelled, as sophomore **Grant Stout** and freshman **Eric Coleman** have not only stepped in, they have posted very similar numbers as Gruber and Schneiderman did a year ago. Stout and Coleman have combined to average 22.0 points and 14.3 rebounds per game, compared to Gruber and Schneiderman's 23.1 points and 13.3 boards per contest last year. In addition, Stout and Coleman have 10 total double-doubles, after Gruber and Schneiderman combined for six all of last season.

## UNI AMONG NCAA STAT LEADERS

The Panthers are ranked in the top 50 in three categories in the most recent NCAA national statistics, released Feb. 7. The Panthers rank 19th in field goal percentage (48.9), 43rd in three-point field goal percentage (38.4) and 17th in turnovers per game (12.3). Individually, **Grant Stout** is 36th in blocks (2.3).

## BENCH DOES THE JOB AGAINST KANGAROOS

UNI's reserves came through with solid efforts all the way around in the Panthers' 81-58 win at UMKC Dec. 11. UNI got 21 points off the bench, the team's second-highest output of the season from the non-starters. A total of six players scored off the bench for UNI, led by **Chris Foster** with six points and **John Little** with five.

## NEAR MISSES

The Panthers enter this week's games with a 16-8 record, but have had several games go down to the wire that could have upped that mark. UNI's first two losses were a 76-70 double-overtime setback at Cincinnati Nov. 24 and a 76-73 loss at 17th-ranked Iowa Dec. 7. Against the Bearcats, the Panthers held an 18-point lead midway through the second half before UC charged back to get the victory. Against the Hawks, UNI had possession of the ball, trailing 74-73, but had a jumper miss with five seconds left that would have given it the lead. Then, Jan. 15 against Creighton, the Bluejays hit a shot at the buzzer to give CU a 67-66 win over UNI, and then CU escaped in the rematch Feb. 9 in Omaha with an 83-82 victory.

## SUDDEN IMPACT

Freshman **Eric Coleman** certainly has made his presence felt in his young Panther career. The 6-6, 230 pound Coleman is averaging 10.7 points and 6.5 rebounds this season -- including a career-high 24 points and 10 rebounds against Iowa State Dec. 1. He was named Missouri Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week Dec. 6, Dec. 13 and Dec. 27, and MVC Player of the Week Dec. 27.

## OTHER WAYS TO HELP THE TEAM

Sophomore point guard **Brooks McKown** didn't score against Iowa State Dec. 1, missing both of his field goal attempts. But the former Iowa "Mr. Basketball" -- and state's all-time prep scoring leader with 2,831 points -- made his impact felt nonetheless, as he dished out a career-high 11 assists against the Cyclones with just three turnovers. Despite his drop in scoring, averaging just 3.5 points per game on the year, he has 61 assists and just 34 turnovers for the season.

## TRIPLE THREAT

UNI's combination of **Erik Crawford**, **Ben Jacobson** and **Eric Coleman** combined for 79 of the team's 99 points in the 99-82 win over Iowa State on Dec. 1. Each posted a career high in scoring: Crawford with 28, Jacobson with 27 and Coleman with 24, with Coleman also grabbing 10 rebounds for his first double-double. The trio connected on 31-of-46 shots from the field in the game, including 10-of-16 threes.

## UNI SETS DOME RECORD FOR THREES

The Panthers drained **13 three-pointers against Wagner Dec. 21, which set a UNI-Dome record**. The previous mark of 12 had been set several times, most recently Dec. 1 against Iowa State. Freshman guard **Adam Viet** hit the record-setting three-pointer against the Seahawks, as UNI finished 13-for-23 from three-point range on the evening.

**SCORING BALANCE**

All five of UNI's starters reached double figures scoring against Cincinnati Nov. 24. **Erik Crawford** led the way with 16, followed by **Brooks McKown** with 13. **Grant Stout**, **Eric Coleman** and **Ben Jacobson** each had 10 for the Panthers. That marked the first time that all five starters had reached double digits in points since Dec. 30, 2003, when Crawford (11), Jacobson (16), McKown (11), **Matt Schneiderman (14)** and **David Gruber (14)** accomplished the feat in an 82-70 win against Siena. That was the only time last year all five starters reached double digits in scoring. UNI has had at least four players score in double figures eight times this season.

**STARTERS DOING THE JOB**

The Panthers' starting five has certainly delivered this season. Four of the team's five starters are averaging in double figures, led by **Ben Jacobson**, who leads the team and is among the MVC leaders at 17.9 ppg. **Erik Crawford** averages 13.7 points per game, **Grant Stout** averages 11.3 ppg, and **Eric Coleman** averages 10.7 ppg. The duo of **Brooks McKown** and **Chris Foster**, UNI's two primary point guards, have combined for 122 assists and just 65 turnovers this season.

**DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE**

Sophomore **Grant Stout** has posted seven double-doubles this season. Stout recorded 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds against Wayne State Nov. 21, and then had 10 points and 10 boards versus Cincinnati Nov. 24. He then had 10 points and 10 rebounds against Loyola Dec. 4, and also had 12 points, 10 rebounds and six blocked shots against UMKC Dec. 11. Against Illinois State Jan. 3, he had 18 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. He had 12 points and 11 boards against Indiana State Jan. 9, and then 12 points and 11 rebounds in the rematch with the Sycamores Jan. 26. Overall, Stout is averaging 11.3 points and 7.8 rebounds per game.

**PANTHERS NEARLY POST UPSET AT UC**

UNI nearly pulled off one of the biggest wins in the history of the program on Nov. 24 when it travelled to face perennial NCAA powerhouse Cincinnati. The Panthers built a 12-point halftime lead, 36-22, and led by as many as 18 points in the second half before the Bearcats came storming back. UNI fell behind by four in the first extra session, but was able to battle back and force a second OT before eventually falling, 76-70 in 2 OTs. **Erik Crawford** led the way with 16 points, and all five UNI starters reached double-figures in scoring against the Bearcats.

**PANTHERS RANKED 17TH IN MID-MAJOR TOP 25**

In the most recent *CollegeInsider.com* Top 25, UNI is ranked 17th. A total of five Missouri Valley Conference teams are ranked this week. Wichita State (4), Southern Illinois (10), Illinois State (16) and Southwest Missouri State (23) also are in the top 25. Creighton is just outside of the rankings at 26th.

**UNI WINS THIRD STRAIGHT OPENER UNDER McDERMOTT**

The Panthers' 84-66 win over Wayne State on Nov. 21 was the team's third straight season-opening victory under fourth-year head coach Greg McDermott. The Panthers defeated Chicago State last season (83-59) and won at Montana in 2002-03 (77-71) in their opening games of those campaigns. Only in McDermott's first season of 2001-02 did UNI drop its opener, a 71-57 loss on a neutral court to San Diego State. Ironically, that year marked the best five-game start under McDermott, as the team won its next four contests to begin the year 4-1.

**UNI PICKED THIRD IN MVC PRESEASON POLL**

The Panthers were pegged for third place in the 2004-05 Missouri Valley Conference preseason media poll. UNI, which was tied with Creighton for third, received one first place vote and 265 total points. It is the highest the Panthers have been picked in the MVC preseason poll since joining the Valley for the 1991-92 athletic year.

## CRAWFORD NAMED MVC SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE WEEK DEC. 6

Panthers' junior guard **Erik Crawford** was selected the Prairie Farms/Missouri Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Week for the period of Nov. 29 - Dec. 6, Commissioner Doug Elgin announced.

Crawford averaged 23.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists while shooting 62.5 percent (15-for-24) from the floor and 58.3 percent (7-for-12) from three-point range in victories over Iowa State (99-82) on Dec. 1 and at Loyola (80-73) on Dec. 4. Crawford, who has a 3.04 cumulative grade-point average in Leisure Services, scored a career-high 28 points versus Iowa State (including a career-high five three-pointers) and collected 19 points, six boards and six assists at Loyola.

## CRAWFORD NAMED MVC SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE WEEK NOV. 21

Junior guard **Erik Crawford** was selected the Prairie Farms/Missouri Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Week for the period of Nov. 15-21, Commissioner Doug Elgin announced.

Crawford scored 20 points to lead the Panthers to an 84-66 win over Wayne State on Nov. 21. He hit eight-of-12 shots from the field and three-of-four attempts from the free throw stripe while collecting five rebounds, two assists, one blocked shot and a steal.

## COLEMAN NAMED PLAYER, NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK DEC. 27

Freshman center **Eric Coleman** was named the Missouri Valley Conference Player and Newcomer of the Week Dec. 27. This is the first time Coleman earned Player of the Week honors, and third time he has been named Newcomer of the Week.

Coleman continued his impressive rookie campaign as he averaged 18.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in two UNI wins. He tied his career high with 24 points and grabbed eight boards against Longwood Dec. 23. He was a perfect eight-of-eight from the field and was eight-of-11 from the line against the Lancers.

He had a pair of double-doubles as UNI went 1-1. He scored 16 points and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds at #17 Iowa on Dec. 7, hitting eight-of-12 shots from the field. He also had a career-high five assists, one block and two steals versus the Hawkeyes. Against UMKC Dec. 11, he again scored 16 points, grabbing 10 rebounds. ## CRAWFORD, COLEMAN SWEEP MVC WEEKLY HONORS DEC. 6

UNI swept the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference men's basketball awards for the week of Dec. 6, as junior guard **Erik Crawford** was named Player of the Week and freshman center **Eric Coleman** was named Newcomer of the Week Dec. 6.

Crawford led the Panthers to a pair of wins, at home over previously unbeaten Iowa State and at Loyola-Chicago. He scored a career-high 28 points vs. Iowa State, hitting nine-of-13 shots from the field and five-of-seven from three-point range. His five treys also were a career high. Against Loyola, Crawford had 19 points, six assists and six rebounds. For the week, he averaged 23.5 points and 4.5 rebounds, shot .625 from the floor (15-for-24) and .583 from the three-point line (7-for-12), and had nine assists with just one turnover in the two contests.

Coleman had a monster week for the Panthers. He scored a career-high 24 points and grabbed a career-best 10 rebounds against Iowa State on Dec. 1, hitting 11-of-16 shots from the field. He then scored 16 points on eight-of-12 field goal shooting against Loyola, grabbing nine rebounds against the Ramblers. For the week, he averaged 20.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per outing.

## SANTOS MAKES HIS PRESENCE FELT IN UNI DEBUT

Redshirt freshman **Atila Santos** gave the Panthers a lift off the bench against Wayne State in his first regular-season college game. The 6-10, 225-pound native of Salvador, Brazil scored 14 points -- second highest on the team behind Erik Crawford's 20 -- while hitting six-of-eight shots from the field and both of his free throw attempts. He also grabbed two rebounds, had two assists, one blocked shot and one assist in his Panther debut.

## UNI WINS BIG IN EXHIBITIONS

The Panthers posted a pair of dominating performances in their two exhibition games. UNI won by an average of 45 points in the two contests, defeating Dubuque (93-34) and Southwest State (Minnesota) (71-40). UNI shot 50 percent from the field in the two games while holding its opponents to just 27 percent shooting.

## QUICK WORK

Freshman center **Eric Coleman** made the difference Jan. 26 in UNI's 69-61 win over Indiana State. Saddled with foul trouble -- he had picked up two fouls early in each half -- he managed just five minutes played and made minimal impact. But over the final 10 minutes of the game, with UNI clinging to a slim lead as he entered, Coleman scored 10 points and grabbed six boards to help the Panthers to the win. He finished the night with 14 points (7-of-9 shooting), six rebounds and one blocked shot -- in just 11 minutes of action.

## LAND OF 1,000 VICTORIES

UNI's win over UW-Green Bay on Feb. 21, 2004 was the **1,000th win in the 103 year history of Panther men's basketball**. UNI is now 1,019-985 since originating the program in the 1900-01 season. The Panthers have fielded a team every year since then, except during the 1944 and 1945 seasons, when there were no squads due to World War II.

## PANTHERS SIGN THREE EARLY

UNI signed three players to national letters of intent during the early signing period in November, 2004. Inking to play with the Panthers for 2005-06 were guard **Mason Stewart (Aurora, Ill./Waubonsie Valley)**, forward **Jermain Raffington (Bad Krozingen, Germany/Urspring)** and guard **Travis Brown (Richfield, Minn./Richfield)**.

"We are very excited to add Mason, Jermain and Travis to our program," McDermott said. "All three are fundamentally sound from a basketball standpoint, and possess the work ethic and positive attitude that has become the staple of our team. They are also leaders in their respective communities and have a proven record of academic success."

Stewart, a 6-2, 175-pound combo guard, averaged 19.2 points per game as a junior for Waubonsie Valley High School. He reached double-figures in scoring in 28 of 30 games, with a season high of 30, while shooting 44 percent from the field and 40 percent from three-point range. He was a unanimous all-conference selection both his sophomore and junior seasons, and an honorable mention all-area pick as a junior by the *Chicago Sun-Times*.

"Mason brings instant energy to the basketball floor," McDermott said. "His ability to change the game defensively and create opportunities with his quickness on the offensive end of the floor is very impressive."

The 6-8, 220-pound Raffington played at Urspring School in Schelklingen, Germany. In 2002, Raffington was selected as one of the top five players at the Dirk Nowitzki Basketball Academy. He averaged 13 points and nine rebounds per game as a member of the German U20 national team this past summer.

"Jermain's ability to defend on the perimeter, as well as be an effective scorer both on the block and from the three-point line, will be a great addition to our front line," McDermott said.

Brown averaged 17 points, seven rebounds and three assists last season for Richfield High School. The 6-3, 175-pound shooting guard helped lead the Spartans to a 21-5 record and a conference co-championship in 2003-04. Brown was also a member of the Howard Pulley AAU team that produced current Panthers Erik Crawford and Eric Coleman.

"Travis is a very complete basketball player," McDermott said. "We were impressed with his ability to score in a variety of ways. He is a fierce competitor that can impact the game on both ends of the floor."
