ILLINOIS STATE (16-9) at UW-GREEN BAY (17-7) Saturday, Feb. 19, 2005 - 8 p.m.

UW-Green Bay hosts Illinois State in an ESPN Bracket Buster Saturday game televised nationally on ESPN Full Court. Tip-off is set for 8 p.m. at the Resch Center.



Phoenix Head Coach Tod Kowalczyk- Green Bay-area native Tod Kowalczyk is in his third year at the helm of the Phoenix with a 44-38 career head coaching mark. This year Kowalczyk has guided the Phoenix to a 10-4 mark in league play and a 10-2 record at home. Kowalczyk orchestrated one of the nation's top single-season turnarounds during the 2003-04 campaign in just his second year at UW-Green Bay. The rise of the Phoenix to 17-11 ranked among the top 10 improvements in the NCAA last year.

Scouting the Redbirds - Following three straight home conference losses, the Redbirds are 16-9 overall and tied for fourth in the Missouri Valley Conference at 8-7. Head coach Porter Moser is 26-28 in his second season with the Redbirds. Moser posted three straight 18-win seasons at Arkansas-Little Rock prior to arriving in Normal, III. for an 80-62 overall coaching mark in his fifth season. Illinois State holds a 7-3 lead in the all-time series with Green Bay. The last meeting of the two schools was a 69-68 Phoenix overtime win in Normal, III. to open the 1998-99 season.

TV/Radio - Tonight's game will be televised live nationally on ESPN Full Court. The game will also be broadcast live on on WTAQ AM 1360. John Maino in his 12th season of play-by-play duties. The radio broadcast is available online at www.uwgb.edu/athletics.

SCOUTING THE PHOENIX...

- The 17-7 start for Green Bay is the best tip-off to a Phoenix season since the nationally ranked 1995-96 team posted a 25-4 record. The 7-3 non-conference record for UW-Green Bay is tied for tops among Horizon League schools this season.
- UW-Green Bay features Horizon League Player of the Year candidate, senior point guard Javier Mendiburu. The 6-5 Mendiburu leads the Horizon League and ranks fifth in the country with 7.5 assists per game. He also is the league's top three-point field goal shooter (41.8 percent) and he owns the best assist-to-turnover ratio in the conference (2.34 α /to).
- Junior newcomer Benito Flores is making a significant impact for the Phoenix, scoring in double figures 13 straight games and a team-high 20 times this season.

Flores leads the team and ranks first among newcomers in the Horizon League statistical rankings with 13.2 points per game. He also leads the Phoenix with 6.3 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game. Flores swiped a team-record seven steals in the win over Weber State Dec. 4 and tied his own mark at Cleveland State Feb. 3.

- With its 78-66 win at UIC Feb. 14, UW-Green Bay clinched a bye into the Horizon League tournament semifinals and second place in the league race. The finish is Green Bay's best in nine years, since the nationally-ranked 1995-96 team swept the league title with a 16-0 record.
- Coming off a four-game road stretch, UW-Green Bay plays the next two games at home, closing the regular season on the road at Wright State Sunday, Feb. 27.
- UW-Green Bay is 12-0 in games decided by single digits this season. Each of the five road wins have come by less than 10 points for the Phoenix. Over the past two seasons, UW-Green Bay is 21-4 in single-digit games, including a 3-0 mark in overtime.
- Head coach Tod Kowalczyk orchestrated one of the top 10 turnarounds in the NCAA last season at UW-Green Bay with an eight-game improvement to 17-11. In Horizon League play, the team's seven-win reversal of fortune from 4-12 to 11-5 was the best by any team in over a decade. Kowalczyk was rewarded with a new contract during the offseason that includes a provision for an automatic one-year extension at the end of each season.

Looking Back - A red-hot first half powered UW-Green Bay men's basketball team to a 78-66 win at UIC Feb. 14 in a key Horizon League matchup. With the win, the Phoenix clinched a bye into the semifinal round of the league tournament and second place in the league race. UW-Green Bay also tied its win total from last season with the victory.

The Phoenix poured in a season-high 46 points in the first half en route to a 46-34 lead. Brandon Morris led the way with 17 points in the opening stanza, including 4-4 three-point shooting. As a team, UW-Green Bay was a blistering 8-11 from three-point range in the first half.

UIC was unable to cut the lead to single digits after the break, as the Green Bay lead grew as large as 21,66-45, with 8:57 to play. With the game in hand for the Phoenix, UIC scored the final nine points in the closing minutes.

Junior forward Benito Flores scored a season-high 22 points on 9-12 shooting to lead the Phoenix. Senior guard Javier Mendiburu was at the top of his game with 12 points, 13 assists and seven rebounds.

Morris ended the game with 19 points and senior guard Matt Rohde chipped in 16 points for a quartet of Phoenix players in double figures.

Flores Heats Up - Junior forward Benito Flores has scored in double figures 13 straight games and a team-high 20 times this season. Flores is on a shooting tear for the Phoenix, with 55-86 shooting in the last nine games for 64.0 percent efficiency, including 10-14 shooting from three-point range for 71.4 percent.

In the latest Horizon League statistical rankings, Flores is eighth overall and first among all newcomers in scoring with 13.2 points per game. He also leads Green Bay and ranks third in the league with 6.3 rebounds per game.

Next Up: Clash with the Titans - UW-Green Bay will host Detroit Wednesday, Feb. 23 at 7:05 p.m. in the final regular season home game for the Phoenix.

Close Counts for the Phoenix - UW-Green Bay is an impressive 12-0 this season in games decided by single-digit scoring margins. Combined with last year's 9-4 mark in games decided by fewer than 10 points, the Phoenix is 21-4 when the going gets tough down the stretch over the last two years under Coach Kowalczyk, Including a 3-0 mark in overtime.

UWM to Host Quarterfinals/Semifinals - With Thursday's win over Butler, UWM clinched the Horizon League regular season title and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming league tournament quarterfinals and semifinals. The games will be played at the U.S. Cellular Arena for the Friday, March 4 and Saturday, March 5. By virtue of their top-two finishes, UWM and UWGB have earned byes into the semifinal round.

Among the National Leaders - Senior guard Javier Mendiburu is fifth in the nation as of the Feb. 15 update in the NCAA statistics rankings with 7.5 assists per game and 164 for the year. Classmate Matt Rohde is 13th in the country in free throw percentage with 88.9 percent efficiency at the charity stripe. Junior Benito Flores ranks 45th in the nation with 55.1 percent shooting on the year.

Mendiburu is chasing Tom Anderson's school record of 193 assists in a single season set in 1976-77. Meanwhile, Rohde is closing in on Terry Schott's 1972-73 mark of 91.7 percent free throw shooting. The school record for field goal percentage in a season is Ron Ripley's 67.8 percent effort in 1977-78.

Classic Title - UW-Green Bay earned its third straight Oneida Bingo & Casino Classic title under head coach Tod Kowalczyk with a 68-60 win over Hartford Dec. 30. Phoenix senior Javier Mendiburu was named the tournament's most valuable player and was joined on the all-tourney team by teammates Morris and Lawrence. Also on the honor squad were NDSU's Adam Dobmeier, Rider's Jerry Johnson and Hartford's Aaron Cook.

Evans Out for the Season - Freshman forward Terry Evans will be sidelined for the rest of the season to rehabilitate a prior knee injury, head coach Tod Kowalczyk announced Dec. 14. UW-Green Bay will apply for a medical hardship and Evans would retain four years of eligibility. He averaged 2.3 points and 3.3 rebounds in 15.5 minutes of play per game over the first six games of this season.

Berlowski Among Four Phoenix Hall of Fame Inductees - Former basketball players Ben Berlowski and Chari Nordgaard Knueppel, former Nordic skier Dan Goltz and former soccer player, coach, and director of sports information and sports marketing Terry Powers are the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay's newest inductees to the Phoenix Hall of Fame.

Race Inducted into Minnesota-Duluth Athletics Hall of Fame - Phoenix assistant coach Dale Race was inducted into the Minnesota-Duluth Athletics Hall of Fame Sept. 28, 2004. Race was 293-120 in 14 years at the Bulldogs helm, where Phoenix head coach Tod Kowalczyk was in Race's first recruiting class.

Beathea, McKenzie Join Staff - Assistant coach Daimon Beathea (Michigan State/1996) and director of basketball operations Pat McKenzie (St. John's, Minn./2004) have joined Tod Kowalczyk's coaching staff for the 2004-05 season.

Fab Five Freshmen Recruits Earn National Recognition

UW-Green Bay head coach Tod Kowalczyk signed four Wisconsin prep stars and a Canadian point guard to National Letters of Intent earlier this fall. The recruiting class ranks No. 25 in the country according to Illinois Prep Bulls-Eye and No. 2 among the nation's mid-major schools according to Clark Francis at Hoop Scoop.

"I'm absolutely delighted to announce the addition of five players that really are the future of our program," said Kowalczyk. "They are strong academically and athletically and they are guys that will represent our program with a great deal of character. We knew going into this year that this recruiting class would determine the future of our program. To have the class ranked among the Top 25 in the nation speaks volumes of my assistant coaches."

Highlighting the incoming class is first team All-State pick Ryan Tillema from three-time Division 4 state champion Randolph. A 6-8 forward noted for his outside shooting, Tillema is the first Phoenix recruit with first team All-State credentials in over a decade, and he aims to become the first player in state history to win four state titles in his prep career. Coached by Bob Haffele at Randolph, Tillema averaged 19.1 points per game as a junior.

The instate recruiting crop includes a pair of Central Wisconsin prep standouts raised on family farms. Randy Berry (6-9, Plover, Wis./Almond-Bancroft) and Mike Schachtner (6-9, Somerset, Wis.) were both high-scoring forwards as preps. Berry averaged an eye-popping 24.5 points and 14.6 rebounds as a junior at Almond-Bancroft where is coached by Curt Lamb.

Schachtner saw his recruiting stock soar after a summer of 2003 stint with the Fox Valley Skillz AAU program. During his junior season at Somerset, he averaged 23.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Schachtner is coached at Somer set by Eric Olson.

Rounding out the Wisconsin contingent is 6-5 guard/forward Cordero Barkley (Racine, Wis./St. Catherine's), noted for his wingspan and athletic ability. Like Schachtner, Barkley was a member of the Fox Valley Skillz AAU squad. He is coached by longtime St. Catherine's mentor Bob Letsch.

Schachtner, Tillema and Barkley were ranked fourth, fifth and six, respectively, among state collegiate prospects by Wisconsin Basketball Yearbook. Berry was tabbed 15th.

With a quartet of Dairy State recruits in the fold, Kowalczyk headed to Canada to complete the group. Toronto's Simon Farine is a 6-3 player considered the top point guard prospect in the country. The MVP of the Nike All Canada Basketball Camp All Star game is prepped at Northern Secondary by his father, Ehoud Farine, and is also coached at the AAU level by Wayne Dawkins of Phase 1.

Kress Gift Moves Events Center Forward - UW-Green Bay Chancellor Bruce Shepard announced Dec. 29 that thanks to a generous gift from the George F. Kress Foundation, the University has reached a major goal in fund raising for the University's sports and events center project. The University will recognize the generosity of the Kress Foundation and family by naming the facility the Kress Events Center. The foundation's gift has enabled UW-Green Bay to attain a goal of raising \$7.5 million in private funds by Dec. 31. The commitment of private funding is needed for the project to also receive \$7.5 million from the state of Wisconsin. UW-Green Bay's overall goal is to raise \$10 million in private funds to support the project. The \$32 million project calls for the renovation and expansion of UW-Green Bay's Phoenix Sports Center, which opened in 1976. The Kress Events Center plan includes a central area with a seating capacity in the range of 3,000 to 4,000 as the home court for the women's basketball and volleyball teams. The center also will include expanded locker room and practice facilities for the men's basketball team as well as new athletics department offices. Ground-breaking will begin in 2005, with the facility planned to open in 2007.

About the Phoenix...

The University of Wisconsin-Green Bay athletic teams gained the distinctive name *PHOENIX* as the result of a campus vote in 1970. Originally, UW-Green Bay's athletic teams were known by the nickname *BAY BADGERS...* a tie-in with the school's parent campus, University of Wisconsin-Madison. However, UW-Green Bay students and administrators pushed for a separate identity and *PHOENIX* outpolled several others in a campus-wide contest.

The Phoenix lore is a composite of Egyptian, Greek and Roman mythologies. The Phoenix is said to be a large and magnificent bird, much like an eagle, with red and gold plumage. According to the myth, only one Phoenix lives at a time in 500 year cycles. When the time of its death approaches, the bird builds a nest of branches and incense. The nest is then ignited by the sun and the flames engulf the bird. Out of the ashes of the old, a young, renewed Phoenix arises.

The Phoenix -- a singular name...

References to the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay mascot or its teams should be singular in printed material. An example of correct usage: "The Phoenix is on a winning streak." During the 1970 campus wide poll which resulted in the selection of "Phoenix" as the University mascot, supporters suggested that the use of a collective singular nickname would emphasize the unity of the teams, University and community.
