### STORYLINES

- The Redbirds are looking to avoid matching their longest losing streak of the season – three games. ISU has lost its last two games with a 70-66 defeat at Drake and a 75-66 loss on Monday against Missouri State at Redbird Arena.
- Wichita State enters tonight's game trying to snap a road losing streak. The Shockers have lost five straight games away from Charles Koch Arena. WSU opened the season with nine straight wins, but has posted a 3-6 record in its last nine games.
- A victory tonight would give Illinois State head coach Porter Moser the 100<sup>th</sup> victory of his head coaching career.
- ISU is 13-5 against Wichita State all-time at Redbird Arena, but the Shockers have won the last four contests in Normal.
- This is the second of three straight home games for Illinois State. The 'Birds are 6-3 on their home floor this season.
- A Redbird loss would mark the 10th straight defeat at the hands of the Shockers, matching the longest current losing streak against a single team. ISU has also dropped 10 straight to Southern Illinois.

### SERIES HISTORY

- Series Record – Illinois State leads the series 31-25.
- First Meeting – Illinois State defeated Wichita State 41-27 in Normal, Ill., on Dec. 17, 1937.
- Last Meeting – The Shockers handed ISU a 64-57 defeat in Wichita, Kan., on Feb. 25, 2006.
- Current Streak – Wichita State has won the last nine meetings, with ISU's last win coming in January of 2002.

### THE COACHES

- Porter Moser (Creighton '90) is in his seventh season as a college coach and his fourth season at Illinois State. He owns a 99-94 (.513) career mark, including a 45-60 (.429) record with the Redbirds. Prior to guiding ISU, Moser served three seasons at Arkansas-Little Rock. Moser is assisted by Chris Jans, Daniyal Robinson and Brian Barone.
- Mark Turgeon (Kansas '87) is 123-82 (.600) in his seventh year at Wichita State and 148-111 (.571) in his ninth year as a college head coach. Prior to coaching the Shockers, Turgeon coached two seasons at Jacksonville State. He is assisted by Scott Spinelli, Alvin "Pooh" Williamson and Mike Rohn.

- ▶ Wichita State is located in Wichita, Kan., and has an enrollment of 14,076. The Shockers are fellow members of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- ▶ The Shockers return eight lettermen, including four starters, as WSU went 26-9 and 14-4 in the MVC in 2005-06, winning the regular-season championship and making an NCAA Sweet Sixteen Tournament Appearance.

**RED RAVEN REUNION**

It shouldn't happen, but it wouldn't be surprising if Illinois State's Boo Richardson or Anthony Slack inadvertently passed the ball to Wichita State's Ryan Martin, or vice versa. The three were all teammates at Coffeyville Community College during the 2004-05 season and led the Red Ravens to the Region 6 Tournament semifinals.

**WITH AGE COMES EXPERIENCE ...**

Heading into the 2006-07 season, junior center Levi Dyer had amassed 138 total points in his collegiate career. After Dyer's performance on Monday versus Missouri State where the Eaton, Colo., native tallied a career-high 23 points on 8-for-13 shooting, he currently totals 156 points. Averaging a personal-best 8.7 points per game this season, Dyer is on pace to finish the season with 260 points, nearly doubling his career total heading into the season.

**CAUGHT RED-HANDED**

While most people might feel that stealing is wrong, the Illinois State men's basketball team has been effective at it on the court this season. The Redbirds boast an 8.06 steals per game average, which is third-best in the Valley and would put the 2006-07 Redbirds into the record books with the third-best mark in school history. The team is also on pace to finish the season with 242 swipes, which would be the fourth-best in Redbird history.

**FORMERLY POOH'S CORNER**

Wichita State assistant coach Alvin "Poo" Williamson is no stranger to Redbird Arena. Williamson was an assistant under former Illinois State head coach Tom Richardson during the 1999-2000 and 2000-01 seasons. He also played in the arena as a point guard for Tulsa from 1991-95, when the Golden Hurricane was a member of the Missouri Valley Conference.

**BOILING UNDER THE HEAT**

The Redbirds have been doing a good job of applying the pressure to opponents' offensive sets. The 'Birds are currently second in the Valley in turnover margin with a +3.33 rating.

**DYERMAKER**

Since entering the starting lineup seven games ago, junior Levi Dyer has been making the most of his opportunities. During the seven-game span, Dyer has posted double-figure scoring in each outing, including a pair of 20-point games, one of which was a career-best 23-point night against Missouri State. During that time, Dyer averaging a team-best 14.4 points and 6.0 rebounds per game.

### LETHAL WEAPON 3

After Boo Richardson fired in six three-pointers at Drake, it gave the Redbirds three separate players who have made six or more three-pointers in a single game this season. Osiris Eldridge dumped in eight at Creighton, while Dom Johnson poured in seven against Florida State earlier in the season. In addition, Roberto Fortes did it twice last season with seven treys at Miami (Ohio) and six at Redbird Arena against Drake.

### THE CENTURY CLUB

Head coach Porter Moser enters tonight's contest against Wichita State sitting on 99 career coaching wins. A Redbird victory tonight would give Moser 100 victories in his career against 94 losses. The seventh-year head coach has collected 45 wins at Illinois State and 54 at Arkansas-Little Rock.

### COOLER IN THE VALLEY

Through six conference games, the shooting has definitely been cooler for the Redbirds in league play. After firing field goals through the net at a 45.5 percent clip during the non-conference season, the 'Birds rank ninth during the conference season by shooting 39.6 percent in league games.

### DILLY FOR THE BLOCK

After his two blocked shots against Missouri State, senior Greg Dilligard became Illinois State's career leader in blocked shots. He enters tonight's game with 144 career swats and is only the fifth player in Redbird history to post 100 or more blocked shots in a career. He currently has 20 blocks on the season.

### FRESHMAN PHENOM

Not only did freshman Osiris Eldridge tie the school record at Creighton for made three pointers with eight, but he also poured in a career-high 28 points in the process. His 28 tallies marked the third highest single-game point total by a Redbird freshman in school history. By doing so, he joined a pretty elite group of ISU scorers – Bubbles Hawkins (30 points at Jacksonville, 2-16-73), Roger Powell (30 points vs. Morehead State, 1-8-73), Billy Lewis (28 points at West Virginia, 3-1-75) and Tarise Bryson (28 points vs. Southern Mississippi, 11-28-98 and vs. Wisconsin, 12-5-98).

### CHAIRMAN OF THE OFFENSIVE BOARDS

Offensive rebounds have only been an official stat for a little more than 15 years, but during that time no one at Illinois State has been better at hitting the offensive glass than Greg Dilligard. During his career, Dilligard has registered 225 offensive caroms and is only the fourth player at ISU to collect 200 or more offensive boards. Dilligard is joined by Rico Hill (211), Dan Muller (205) and LeRoy Watkins (205).

### DYER FOR TWO?

Junior center Levi Dyer has been working hard on his post play and it shows. Entering this season, Dyer had made 14 two-point baskets in his Redbird career. Already this season, Dyer has made 35 baskets inside the arc. He has also continued to shoot from three and ranks fourth on the team with 21 made three-pointers.

### THE MINUTEMEN

Both Boo Richardson and Dom Johnson enter tonight's game averaging just over 34 minutes per game and rank second and third, respectively, among the conference leaders in minutes played. Only Indiana State's Gabe Moore has played more minutes per game than this Redbird duo. Richardson has totaled 618 minutes on the year, while Johnson has played 615.

### KEPT OFFLINE

The Redbirds have the fewest free throw attempts in the Valley this season. ISU has only attempted 295 free throws on the year and is averaging 16.4 charity tosses per game.

### 218 GAMES WITH A TREY

ISU enters tonight's game against Wichita State with at least one made three in 218 straight games. The last time ISU didn't sink a trey was an 82-43 loss at Creighton on Dec. 12, 1999.

### DYER JOINS DOUBLE-DOUBLE CLUB

With a career-high 13 rebounds and 14 points at Drake on Saturday, junior Levi Dyer netted his first career double-double. Dyer's performance marked the seventh double-double by the Redbirds this season. Greg Dilligard leads the way with three, Anthony Slack has recorded two and Boo Richardson posted one this season.

**THREE-BALLIN'**

Through 18 games, 41.9 percent of ISU's field goal attempts have come from beyond the 3-point arc. The 'Birds are averaging 23.2 three-point tries per game. Against Texas-Arlington on Dec. 2, the Redbirds set a Redbird Arena record with 14 made treys, which was also the second most in ISU history. The Redbirds are on pace to shoot 719 threes on the season, which would top the school record of 615 set in 1995-96. ISU is also on pace to finish the season with 242 made treys, which would claim the school standard and top the current mark of 220 set during the 1997-98 season.

**DISHING THE ROCK**

Junior point guard Boo Richardson enters tonight's game averaging 5.7 assists per game this season, which is the highest average by a Redbird since Jamar Smiley dropped 6.4 assists per game during the 1997-98 season. Richardson has 102 assists on the season and is on pace to finish the regular season with 177, which would be No. 9 all-time.

**THIRTY SOMETHING**

Junior guard Dom Johnson became the first Redbird to score 30 or more points in a game since Trey Guidry tossed in 30 at Creighton on Jan. 22, 2005. Johnson torched Florida State for 32 points on 12-for-23 shooting. It was the most points by a Redbird since Tarise Bryson scored 38 in the 2001 National Invitational Tournament game at Purdue.

**TAKING THE 'NORM' OUT OF NORMAL**

After finishing the 2005-06 season with a 9-19 record, the 'Birds were in the midst of an aberration. The campaign marked only the sixth losing season in ISU's 35 years of being a Division I program.

**GONE IN 60 POINTS**

The 60-point plateau continues to be a viable measuring stick for the Redbirds' success. Under head coach Porter Moser, the Redbirds own a 39-18 (.684) record when they score 60 points or more. When ISU scores less than 60, the Redbirds' record falls to 6-41 (.128).

**MATCHBOX 20**

If the Illinois State box scores from the 2005-06 season were compared to the box scores from this season – one thing in particular jumps out. In 28 games last season, the Redbirds had a 20-point scorer three times. Greg Dilligard did it once and Roberto Fortes reached 20 points twice. This season, the Redbirds have had players score 20 or more points in a game nine times. Boo Richardson has scored 20-plus three times, Anthony Slack and Levi Dyer twice, while Dilligard, Dom Johnson and Osiris Eldridge have all accomplished it once.

**POINT-N-SHOOT**

It's not just the points either; shooting percentage is also a key factor for ISU in terms of wins and losses. When ISU shoots better than its opponent, the 'Birds are 40-12 (.769) over the last four seasons. When the Redbirds shoot worse, ISU is 5-47 (.096).

**JUCO ALL-AMERICA U.**

Dominatrix Johnson and Keith "Boo" Richardson became the second and third junior college all-Americans respectively, to sign with ISU since Porter Moser's arrival. Richardson claimed first-team honors, while Johnson was a third team selection. The duo joins Lorenzo Gordon, who went on to earn Valley Newcomer of the Year honors in 2005.

**SEAD ADDED**

Sead Odzic (SEE-add ODD-zik) transferred to Illinois State from Southern California following the fall semester. Odzic, a 6-foot-3, 192-pound guard, is a native of Skokie, Ill., and played prep basketball at Niles West. He will have to serve a year of residency and will not be eligible to compete in a game for the Redbirds until the completion of the Fall 2007 semester. At USC last season, Odzic averaged 3.2 points and 1.2 rebounds per game. Prior to USC, Ozdic averaged 20 points, five rebounds and four assists during his senior season at Niles West.

**RUBIN SIGNS**

During the early signing period, head coach Porter Moser added his first to the 2007-08 recruiting class. Point guard Alex Rubin from Armstrong High School in Plymouth, Minn., signed his national letter of intent to continue his education and basketball career at ISU. At 6-foot-1, 185-pounds, Rubin led the Falcons to a 19-10 overall record, before falling in the sectional finals. A two-time all-Classic Lake Conference selection, Rubin averaged 14.5 points and 4.8 assists per game as a junior. In 2006, he was named to the all-metro defensive second team and was an honorable mention all-state selection. This season, Rubin is averaging 19.8 points per contest, while Armstrong owns an 9-4 record.

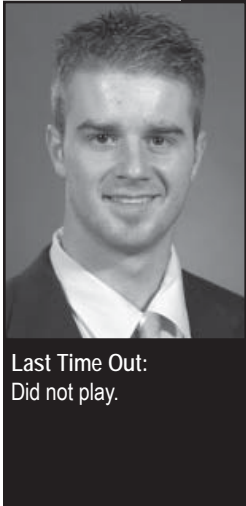

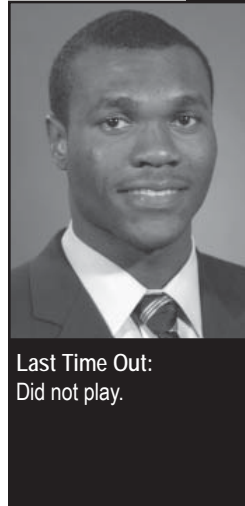

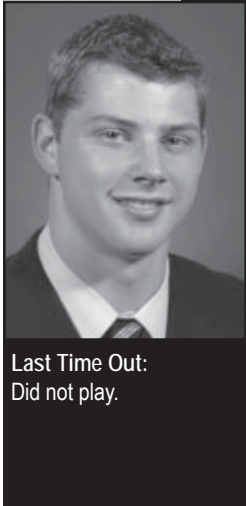

Dilligard, Richardson Lead Birds to Victory

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. - The inside and outside combination of Illinois State's Greg Dilligard and Boo Richardson was too much for McNeese State as the Redbirds notched their first win of the season with a 67-50 win over the Cowboys in the third and final day of the Colonial Classic at the Donald L. Tucker Center.

Richardson paced the Redbirds (1-2) with a game-high 23 points, while Dilligard collected 20 points. The victory was the first for ISU away from Redbird Arena in its last 18 tries. The last Redbird victory away from Normal occurred on Feb. 19, 2005, when ISU topped Wisconsin-Green Bay 79-69 in ESPN BracketBusters.

Illinois State took the lead 9-7 at the 15:20 mark on an Anthony Slack lay up and never relinquished the lead. Over the next seven minutes, ISU went on a 14-3 run, which included six points by Dilligard, to give the Birds a 23-10 with 8:30 left in the first half. The Redbirds increased their lead to 16 points and took a 36-20 advantage into the locker room led by Dilligard's 11 first-half points.

In the second half, the Redbirds could never fully put McNeese State (0-3) away, but the Cowboys were unable to get any closer than 10 points. Both times McNeese State closed the gap to 10 points, the Redbirds responded including a 9-0 run in the game's final three minutes.

Redbirds Convincing in Home Opener

NORMAL, Ill. - Illinois State's Dom Johnson led three Redbirds in double figures with 16 points, but it was the ISU defense that got the best of Cal State Northridge in a 66-44 nonconference win at Redbird Arena.

The Matador offense was stifled as the Redbirds held CSUN to a Redbird Arena low 25.9 percent from the field. CSUN also converted 14 field goals, tying the facility low.

The Matadors jumped out to a quick 2-0 lead when Calvin Chitwood threw down a fast-break dunk on the game's opening play. However, the Redbirds quickly answered on a Boo Richardson three-pointer that opened up a 10-0 run to put the Birds up 10-2. Birds Add to Valley's Big Weekend; Win at St. John's

QUEENS, N.Y. - The offensive play of point guard Boo Richardson and the defensive effort of Roberto Fortes paved the way as the Illinois State men's basketball team earned a precious road victory, the Redbirds' first in 16 games, with a 78-65 victory over St. John's at Carnesecca Arena.

The road win was the first by ISU since posting a 79-69 win at Wisconsin-Green Bay as part of BracketBusters Saturday.

St. John's took its only lead of the game at 2-0, but the Redbirds claimed a 9-4 lead after single baskets by four of the five starters. With ISU up 16-13 at the 13:45 mark, the Redbirds went on a 15-3 run, which included a pair of three-pointers by Osiris Eldridge, and took a 31-16 lead with 7:57 on the clock. St. John's responded with a 9-2 spurt and closed the gap to 33-25 with 4:48 left. The two teams traded baskets the rest of the half and the Redbirds took a 41-31 lead into the locker room.

The Redbirds increased their lead to 15 points at 50-35, thanks to a pair of baskets by Richardson. With Illinois State leading 61-49 and 9:42 left in the game, the Red Storm made their final run. St. John's used a 9-1 run over the next three minutes to close the gap to 62-58. But, Dom Johnson hit two of three free throws after being fouled on a 3-point try and Richardson added a basket to put the lead back to 66-58.

After a pair of free throws by Daryll Hill, Fortes sank a big three-pointer and Greg Dilligard added five straight points as the Redbirds regained control with a 74-61 advantage. ISU hit 4-of-8 free throws down the stretch to secure the win.

NORMAL, Ill. – Junior Levi Dyer set a career high with 23 points and senior Greg Dilligard tallied 13 points and became the school's all-time leading shot blocker, but a late Illinois State men's basketball team rally wasn't enough as Missouri State held on to down the Redbirds 75-66, Monday at Redbird Arena.

After trailing throughout the second half, Illinois State cut the lead to 65-63 with 1:41 left in the game after back-to-back baskets by Dilligard, but the Bears answered with a Nathan Bilyeu jumper from the left side and a lay up by Deven Mitchell off a Dom Johnson turnover to build their lead back up 69-64.

Illinois State stayed close all night despite only having two players in double digits, thanks to forcing 17 turnovers that led to 23 points. However, while the 'Birds held the Bears to only 38 shots, MSU took full advantage of those shots nailing 66 percent from the floor, including 8-of-12 from distance.

Missouri State had four players in double figures, led by senior Blake Ahearn with 17 points.
