


# Rural Health Task Force -Preventive Health-

Goal: To increase preventive healthcare

Objective #1 - Maintain 60% of patients seen on H.O.P.E. at a blood pressure at  $< 140/90^*$ .

\*Approved by the HCNA advisory board for FY2007 60 % of 46-85 year olds have B/P< 140/90 .



- ▼ 75.7% of HOPE patients had B/P reading of < 140/90</li>
- 6.8% of patients in Stage 1 or 2 were identified as non-regular or first time HOPE patients.

\* These statistics are a random sampling of 238 patients seen in March, 2007






# Rural Health Task Force -Primary Health-

- FY07 is averaging 63.6 patients per month seen by the Nurse Practitioner.

- School/athletic physical week is scheduled for July 30 August 3.









♦ 7th Graders' knowledge was increased by 5.77%









- 2. Decrease youth access to ATOD through 100% vendor compliance (Source: Lincoln Police Department)




# Domestic Abuse & Violence (DAV) Task Force

Emergency Orders saw a 9% increase from FY06 to FY07.





2. Establish education programs in order to prevent teen pregnancy, child abuse and neglect.








