REDBIRDS OPEN WNIT PLAY WITH CENTRAL MICHIGAN THURSDAY

Illinois State is back in the WNIT for the fifth time in six years, looking to make another deep postseason run. The Redbirds open play the same way they started their 2011 run, by hosting Central Michigan at 7:05 p.m., Thursday night.

Illinois State is making its fourth-straight appearance in the WNIT, advancing to the semifinals in each of the last three seasons. ISU is 11-3 in its last three WNIT appearances, including a 9-2 record at Redbird Arena.

Illinois State leads the all-time series with Central Michigan, 7-1. ISU and CMU faced off last season in the opening round of the WNIT, when the Redbirds won, 72-59, in Normal, Ill.

The winner of Thursday's game will play the winner of the Villanova and American game.

ILLINOIS STATE-CENTRAL MICHIGAN SERIES

Illinois State leads the all-time series with Central Michigan, 7-1. ISU won the first six meetings, with four in the 1970's and a home-and-home series in 1994-95. Central Michigan's only win came on Nov. 25, 2001, in Redbird Arena, 72-62. ISU and CMU faced off last season in the opening round of the WNIT, when the Redbirds won, 72-59, in Normal, Ill. Illinois State has a 3-1 advantage over Central Michigan in games played in Normal, Ill.

ISU IN THE POSTSEASON WNIT

Illinois State is making its 11th appearance in the Postseason WNIT (1980, 1982, 1984, 1988, 1990, 1996, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012) and has a 18-16 all-time record in the tournament. The Redbirds' 2012 WNIT at-large bid marks the fifth appearance for ISU in postseason play in the last six seasons. In the last four WNIT appearances, the Redbirds have a record of 12-4 during that span. ISU is 10-2 all-time in WNIT games in Redbird Arena.

SIX-PEAT

Illinois State's berth in the 2012 Postseason WNIT puts the Redbirds in the postseason for the sixth-consecutive season. ISU made WNIT trips in five of the last six years and appeared in the NCAA Tournament in 2008. ISU's six-year postseason run is tied for the longest in school history, matching the six-straight trips done from 1980-85.

REDBIRDS UPSET IN MVC TOURNAMENT QUARTERFINALS

For the fifth time in the last six years, Illinois State was upset in the State Farm MVC Tournament as a top-two seed, failing to reach the championship game. The second-seeded Redbirds were beaten by seventh-seeded Drake in the quarterfinals, 56-54, March 9. Drake shot 52 percent from the field in the game compared to Illinois State's 38 percent. ISU had an eight-point lead with just under 11 minutes to play, but Drake used a 14-4 run to regain the lead, 52-50, with just under two minutes to play. The Redbirds tied the game off of a jumper by **Marley Hall**, but a shot by Kyndal Clark with eight seconds left put Drake up by two, 56-54. Illinois State had one last chance, but a Redbird turnover didn't allow a shot to get off, as ISU fell to Drake, 56-54.

BRINGING HOME THE HARDWARE

The Illinois State women's basketball team finished second in the Missouri Valley Conference, after being selected to finish sixth in the preseason poll. After the Redbirds unexpected performance, the Valley named junior transfer **Jamie Russell** Newcomer of the Year and head coach **Stephanie Glance** Coach of the Year for the 2011-12 season. Glance is the third Redbird coach to earn the prestigious Coach of the Year honor. Glance led ISU to a second-place finish in conference play and led the Redbirds to their sixth-straight season finishing in the top-two of the Valley regular season standings. Under her leadership, the Redbirds have four players who finished the regular season averaging double-digit scoring efforts. Through two seasons at the helm of the Redbirds, Glance has led ISU to a record of 42-22. Russell, who transferred to Illinois State from Wisconsin, is the first Redbird player to earn the Newcomer of the Year honors, as the junior transfer played a crucial role for ISU on both sides of the ball. Russell ranked second on the team with 13.5 points per game. She had 17 double-digit scoring efforts in ISU's last 20 games, including 10-straight double-digit performances, earning All-Valley First Team honors.

REDBIRDS FINISH SECOND IN THE VALLEY

Illinois State finished the regular season in sole possession of second place in the Valley standings. The Redbirds finished in the top-two in the Valley regular season in each of the last six years. ISU earned the No. 2 seed in the State Farm MVC Tournament, marking the fourth time the Redbirds competed as No. 2. In 1997, Illinois State lost a quarterfinal game against Wichita State, 81-53. In 2007, the Redbirds beat Bradley, 75-60, before losing to Creighton in the semifinals, 59-56. During the 2011 tournament, ISU lost to Indiana State, 80-51.

FOUR REDBIRDS RECEIVE ALL-VALLEY HONORS

Four Redbirds received All-Valley honors and three of the four players received Valley recognition for the first time in their careers. **Katie Broadway** and **Jamie Russell** were named to the All-Valley First Team. The last time ISU had two players on the first team was during the 2009-10 season. Russell was also selected to the All-Defensive Team. **Candace Sykes** earned accolades when she was named to the All-Valley Honorable Mention Team and **Chloe Nelson** was an All-Valley Honorable Mention selection on the All-Scholar Team. Illinois State has had three players named All-Valley in each of the last four years and has had a player on the Valley All-Defensive and Scholar-Athlete teams in six-consecutive seasons.

REDBIRDS IN THE VALLEY RANKINGS

Illinois State had several players finish the regular season in the top-10 in the Valley rankings. **Candace Sykes** was in the top-10 in six categories. Sykes averaged 7.8 rebounds per game and was in fifth place. She was also third in defensive rebounds (6.6 rpg), seventh in steals (1.8 spg) and eighth in blocks (1.0 bpg). Sykes found success beyond the arc, finishing the season in fourth place in three-point field goal percentage (.400) and 10th in three-pointers made (1.6 pg). **Jamie Russell** was in the top-10 in five categories. Russell was second in assist/turnover ratio (1.4) and steals (2.6 spg). Russell was eighth in scoring with 13.5 points per game and finished sixth in assists (3.4 apg) and free throw percentage (.800). **Katie Broadway** was in the top-10 in three categories on the offensive side of the ball. Broadway was fourth in scoring with 15.9 points per game, second in three-pointers made with 2.7 per game and was eighth in three-point field goal percentage (.377). **Marley Hall** finished the season ranked 10th in field goal percentage, making 48.3 percent of her shots.

LEADING THE RECORD BOOKS

Katie Broadway was 1-of-5 beyond the arc in ISU's victory Saturday (March 3) over Southern Illinois, 72-50. With the three, Broadway has made 78 three-pointers so far this season, which is the most threes made by a Redbird player in a single season. The previous record was held by Jenny Schmidt, who made 77 threes during the 1997-98 season. The senior guard is shooting 37.7 percent beyond the arc through 29 games.

AND THAT MAKES 1,000

Katie Broadway recorded the most memorable game of her Redbird career, as the senior guard set a new career-high with 29 points and became the 27th ISU women's basketball player to score 1,000 points in her career in ISU's win over Missouri Valley Conference rival Creighton (Jan. 22), 79-66. Broadway made a career-high 12 field goals in the win and went 1-of-3 from beyond the arc, putting her in a third-place tie on ISU's career three point field goals list with 183. Broadway scored her 1,000th point at the 9:44 mark of the first half with a jumper. The last time a Redbird scored 1,000 points came last season, when **Shala Jackson** accomplished the feat against Evansville on Feb. 24, 2011.

FIFTH IN THE NATION

Out of 238 ranked teams, the ISU women's basketball team is ranked No. 5 in the nation in three-point field goal percentage through March 11. ISU is ranked fifth with a 37.4 three-point field goal percentage, sinking 191 out of 511 attempts. Richmond is first in the nation with a 39.0 three-point field goal percentage. The Redbirds' accurate shooting from three-point land also leads the Missouri Valley Conference.

FANTASTIC FOUR

In ISU's loss to Drake in the MVC Tournament (March 9), the Redbirds had only four players score in the 56-54 loss. With only four players scoring 56 points, that number averages out to 14 points per player, but only three players scored in the double-digits. It is the first time this season only four Redbirds have scored in a game. Only five players have scored in three games for ISU this season. Illinois State finished 2-1 in those games.

OFFENSIVE ATTACK

The Redbirds continue to have offensive threats from everywhere on the floor, as ISU has had four players recorded double-digit performances in the same game eight times this season. It happened seven times during Missouri Valley Conference play that the Redbirds have had four players score double-digit efforts, with two of those six efforts coming against Northern Iowa. In ISU's overtime loss to Missouri State (Feb. 26), four Redbirds recorded double-digit scoring performances. **Candace Sykes** led all scorers and set a career-high 21 points, while **Jamie Russell** netted 17. **Katie Broadway** added 14 points, while **Marley Hall** had 11 points. Broadway, Hall, Russell and Sykes average double-digit scoring efforts on the season heading into the WNIT. Broadway leads the Redbirds with 16.0 points per game, while Russell scores 13.3 points per game on average. Hall and Sykes averages 11.6 and 11.4 points per game.

GET OUT

With time ticking off of the clock in ISU's game against Evansville Thursday (March 1), the Redbirds held a one-point advantage, 60-59, but the Purple Aces had the ball with 30 seconds to go. Meagan Collins was posting up against **Candace Sykes** and a lob pass over Sykes gave Collins a wide open shot, but Sykes used her vertical to get over Collins and recorded her 29th block of the season and save the lead for ISU. On the next possession, Sykes got the ball into **Jamie Russell**, who was quickly fouled by Evansville. Russell hit both of her free throws to secure the Redbird win, 62-59.

TOUGH D

In Illinois State's 70-52 win over Southern Illinois, the Redbirds forced 23 Saluki turnovers and turned the SIU miscues into 23 points. It is the second-most points the Redbirds have scored off of turnovers all season. The highest points off of turnovers came against Indiana State (Feb. 3), when ISU forced 23 turnovers and ISU turned them into 26 points.

IN THE PAINT

Illinois State scored 34 points in the paint compared to Southern Illinois' 12 points in the 72-50 victory (March 3). It was the 15th time this season that ISU has scored 26 points or more points in the paint. When ISU scores 26 or more points in the paint, the Redbirds hold a record of 11-4.

A STREAK IS BROKEN

After defeating Wichita State at home (Feb. 23), the Illinois State women's basketball team held a 24-game Missouri Valley Conference win streak of games played on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena, which was the third best all-time in league history. That streak was snapped in an overtime loss Sunday against Missouri State. The Lady Bears defeated the Redbirds, 80-76. Prior to the loss to MSU, the last time ISU lost to a Valley foe in Redbird Arena was during the 2009-10 season, when Creighton topped the Redbirds, 69-44, on Jan. 2, 2010. It was the second overtime game this season for ISU. The Redbirds defeated Drake (Jan. 20) in Redbird Arena in overtime, 71-67.

SHE CAN DISH IT, SHE CAN TAKE IT

Jamie Russell has both a selfish and a giving personality. She leads the Redbirds in both assists (104) and steals (79) on the season. She is sixth in the conference in assists and is second in steals. She set a career-high in steals at Drake (Feb. 19) with six and tied the mark against Missouri State (Feb. 26).

AT THE HALF

In 26 of Illinois State's 30 games during the 2011-12 season, the way the Redbirds go into the locker room at the half is the way they have ended each game. When leading at the half, ISU is 17-3 on the season, but when trailing on their way into the locker room, the Redbirds are 1-9. The Redbirds led at the half at Missouri State (Jan. 29), but lost the game after an explosive second half offensively by the Lady Bears. Like at MSU, Illinois State was leading at the half, but Creighton (Feb. 17) made 45 points in the second half. The Lady Bears and Bluejays both opened the second half with runs to jump ahead of the Redbirds in their respective games. At Drake (Feb. 19), ISU trailed by five, heading into the locker room, 37-32, but used a 12-0 run to open the second half and maintained the momentum and went on to win, 66-51. It was the first time this season that ISU came back from being down at the half. The Redbirds came back with a 56 field goal percentage in the second half. In the quarterfinal game of the 2012 Valley Tournament, ISU was leading Drake by two, 27-25, but a late run in the second half by the Bulldogs and a layup with less than two seconds on the clock gave DU the win, 56-54.

PLAYING THE FIELD

When examining Illinois State's wins and losses, a lot can be said about how the Redbirds play the field. In the 18 wins, ISU is shooting 44 percent from the field (493-of-1110). In the 12 losses, the field goal percentage drops to 37.9 percent (267-of-706). The Redbirds are also scoring 11 points less in their losses (61.4 ppg) than in their wins (72.4 ppg).

BRINGING IN THE HONORS

Junior transfer **Jamie Russell** was named the Missouri Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week six times this season. Russell also received the honor on Nov. 28, Jan. 2, Jan. 16, Feb. 6, Feb. 13 and Feb. 27. Russell has played a crucial part for the Redbirds on both the offensive and defensive sides of the ball during the 2011-12 season.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

The Redbirds are scoring 68.0 points per game through 30 games and have had a balanced scoring threat during the 2011-12 season. Eight Redbirds have recorded double-digit scoring performances, including **Katie Broadway**, **Marley Hall**, **Alexis Jenkins**, **Chloe Nelson**, **Jamie Russell** and **Candace Sykes**, who have multiple double-digit efforts. Broadway, Hall, Russell and Sykes have each tallied 20-plus point games, and Russell scored 30 points against Eastern Illinois (Nov. 21). In ISU's conference-opening win against Southern Illinois (Dec. 30), 10 Redbirds scored in the win, the most ISU players to score in a game this season.
