

## Illinois State Postgame Notes FINAL – #1 North Dakota State 28, Illinois State 10 Nov. 9, 2013 • Fargodome • Fargo, N.D.

## PLAYER NOTES:

- Marshaun Coprich scored his ninth rushing touchdown of the season when he scored from two yards out early in the second quarter. With his ninth rushing touchdown, Coprich is tied with five other players for 13th on the single season rushing touchdown list.
- Cameron Hunt rushed for a season-high 52 yards in the first quarter, including a season-long 33-yard carry that set up the Coprich touchdown. He finished the game with 72 yards on 11 carries.
- Nick Aussieker connected on a 22-yard field goal early in the third quarter. Aussiker is now 8-for-9 on field goal attempts this season.
- Longsnapper Chris Highland recorded his first-career fumble recovery when he came up with a muffed punt in the third quarter to set up the Aussieker field goal.
- David Perkins forced his third fumble of the season in the third quarter. With is three forced fumbles, Perkins leads the Redbirds.
- Teddy Corwin blocked his second kick in two weeks, with a block of a 52-yard field goal attempt in the third quarter.
- Dontae McCoy finished with a career-high 12 tackles, including nine solo stops, and added a tackle-for-loss against the Bison.

## TEAM NOTES:

- With their victory, the Bison improve to 5-2 all-time against the Redbirds and have won three out of four contests inside the Fargodome
- Illinois State is now 0-5 in road contests, but 5-0 in games played at Hancock Stadium.
- Saturday's crowd of 18,076 fans at Fargodome marked the highest attendance the Redbirds have played against in 2013. The previous high was 16,327 fans at Ball State on Aug. 29.
- Despite the loss, the Redbirds can secure it's fifth-consecutive winning season with a win next weekend at Southern Illinois.
