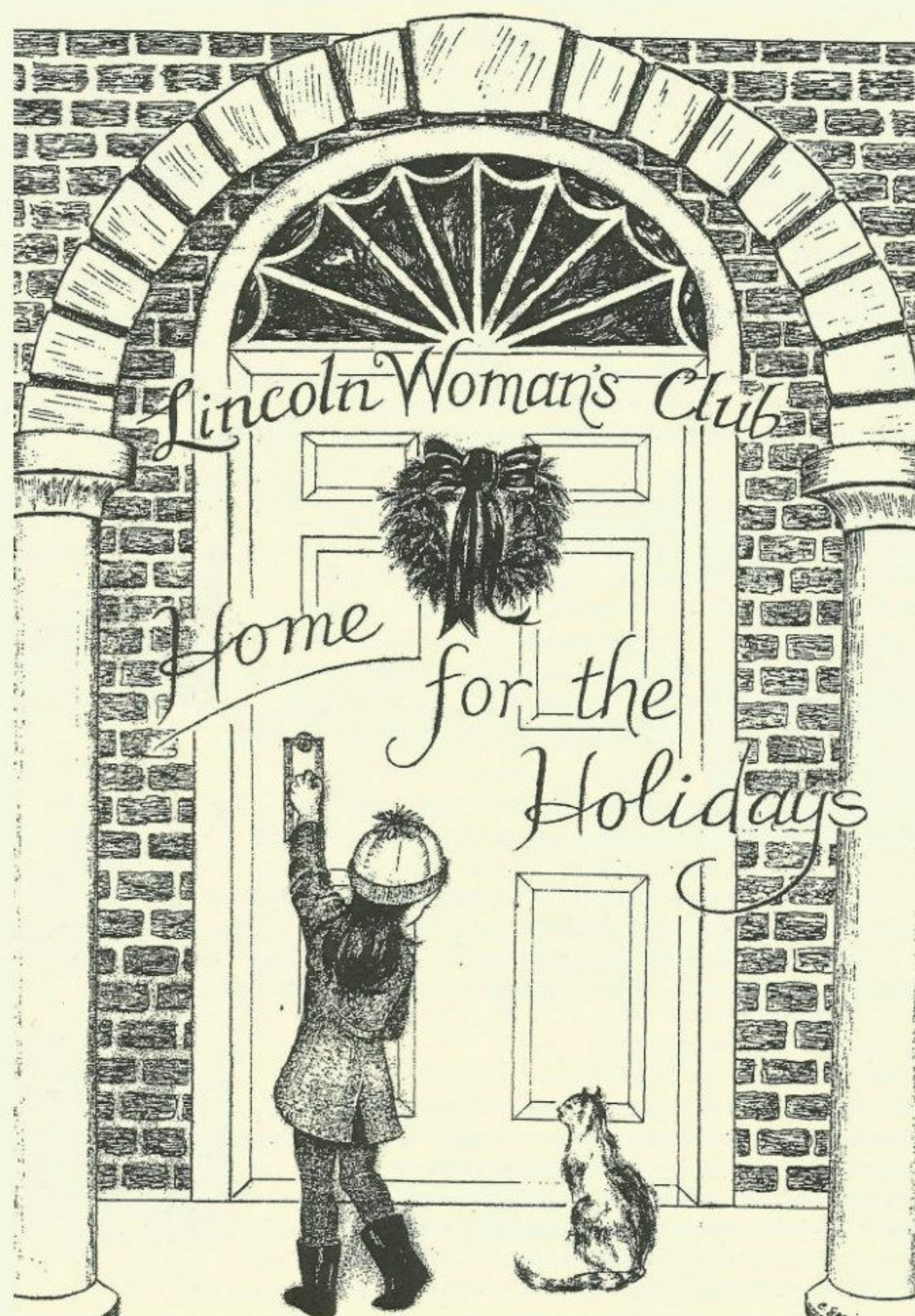
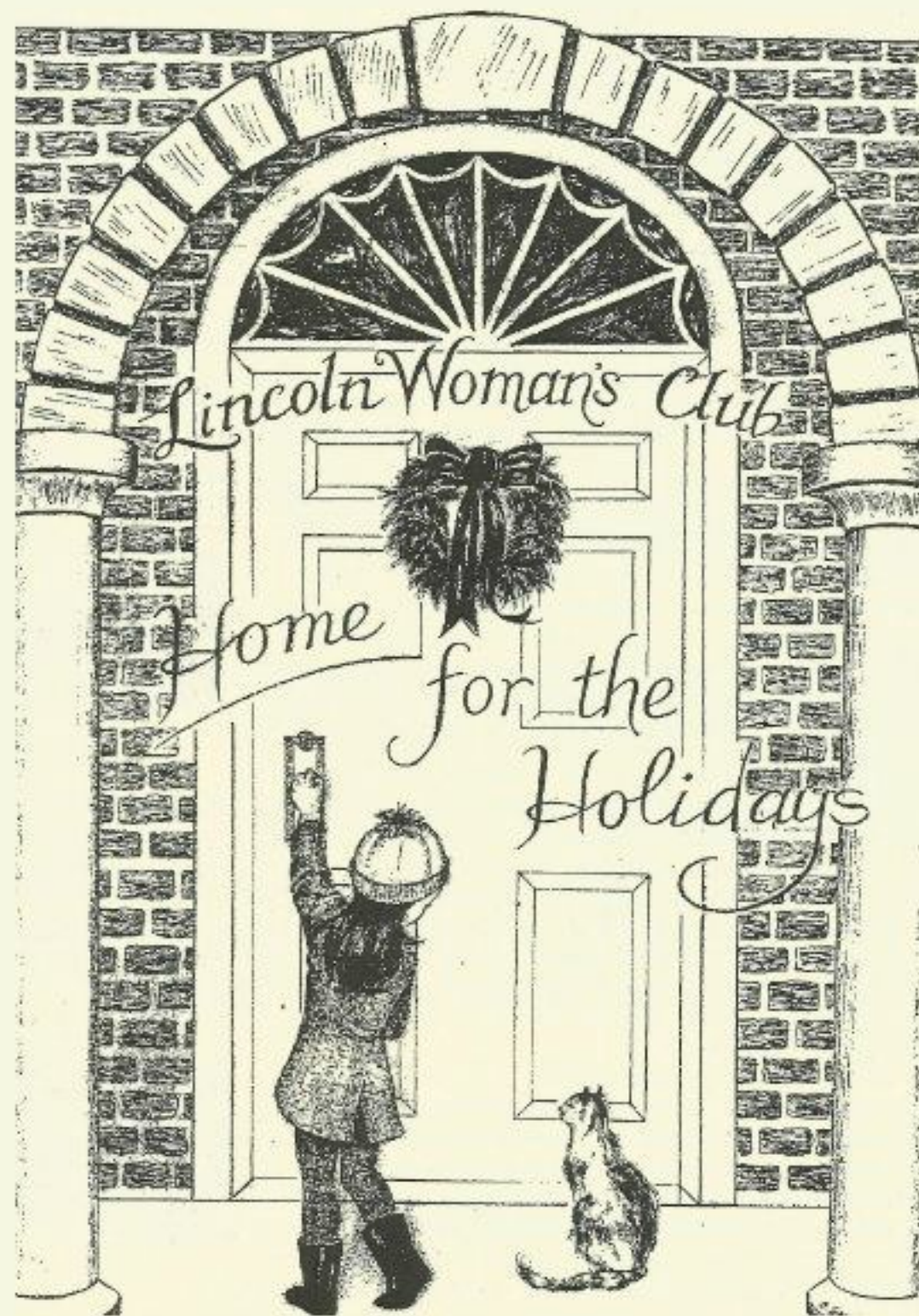

Etched glass windows in the original double front doors welcome you to this stately Italianate style home, perfectly suited for the brick streets and majestic trees of one of Lincoln's oldest neighborhoods. The inviting foyer includes a unique "coffin niche" located under the winding staircase where family members might be displayed before the funeral, a true illustration of family life (and death) in the 1880's. Distinctive canvas crown molding, high ceilings and tall windows compliment the original hardwood floors & fireplaces in the home's living room as well as the library where the Sagers' interest in Abraham Lincoln and the Civil War is revealed through paintings, busts, and other Lincoln memorabilia. A lofty ceiling and fresh white cabinets welcome you into the airy kitchen where visitors should take special note of the paper ceiling covered with copper paint, as well as the etched glass transom created by Karen.

Built in 1854 by James Gillespie, a local mercantile owner, this classic home can truly be described as a "Painted Lady," the exterior having been decorated in 5 complimentary colors of the Victorian period. And as it is with several houses on the home tour today, this 1854 home is rumored to have been originally owned by an acquaintance of Abraham Lincoln. Who knows? Perhaps you are standing on the same front porch where our 16th president stood 150 years ago!







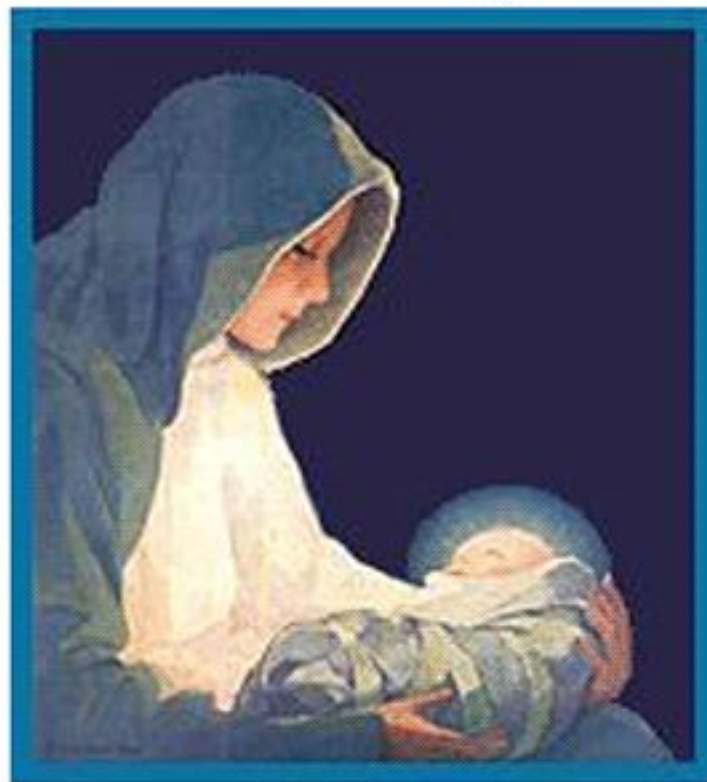

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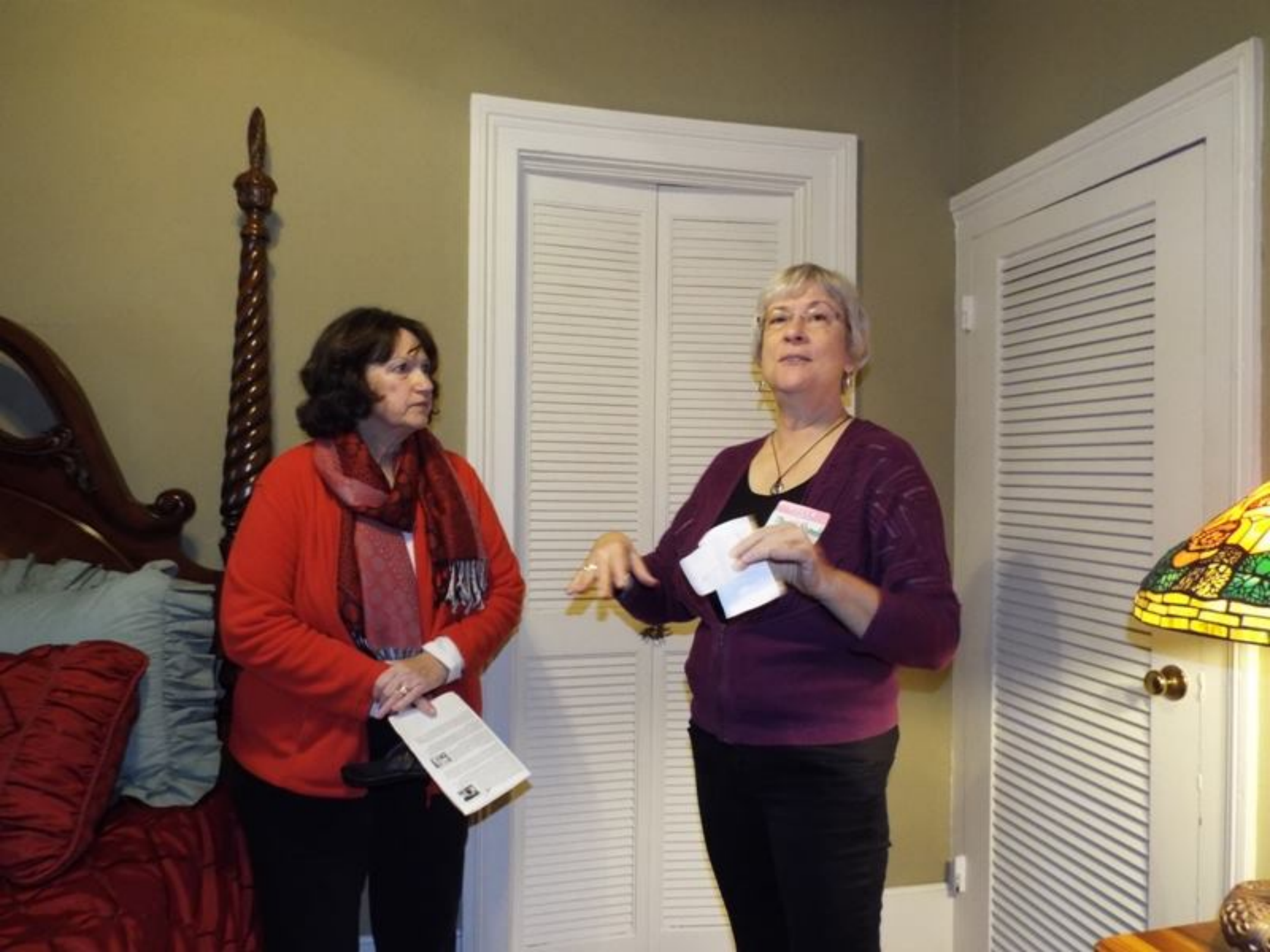
























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
