This is a daily joint communication from the Logan County Department of Public Health and Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital updating you on the status of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Logan County. This communication will come at approximately 6 p.m. each day as necessary.

At the time of this press release, the total number of confirmed cases in Logan County is **1**.

A person under investigation (PUI) is an ALMH inpatient who has been tested and is awaiting the results of their COVID-19 test. ALMH outpatient patients and hospital inpatients who have been discharged or transferred to another healthcare facility are not included in these numbers.

## Logan County Data

Earlier today, April 2, 2020 the Logan County Department of Public Health announced the first confirmed positive COVID-19 case in Logan County, Illinois. The individual was tested on 3/31/2020 at the drive-thru Memorial Physician Services Respiratory Clinic in Springfield, Illinois. At the time of testing, she presented with mild symptoms which have improved. She is currently isolating at home and receiving no treatment. This individual has no known history of travel or contact with a person infected with COVID-19. The Logan County Department of Public Health will continue to monitor the patient's health status and gather details to better understand who the individual has been in contact with and possible exposure.
