COVID-19 Update: January 4, 2021

This is a joint communication from the Logan County Department of Public Health and Abraham Lincoln Memorial Hospital updating you on the status of coronavirus (COVID-19) in Logan County.

The Logan County Department of Public Health has confirmed the following new cases of COVID-19 in Logan County. **Positives are from the last 7 days.**

**** 117 individuals ranging in age from 3 months of age to 86 years of age both symptomatic and asymptomatic.

The total number of confirmed positive cases in Logan County is now 2,686 including 2,445 individuals who have recovered 204 active cases and 37 fatalities.

We are saddened to announce 3 fatalities related to COVID-19:

An individual in their 70s

Two individuals in their 80s

Logan County Data

A continually updated table of Logan County data is maintained by the Logan County Department of Public Health and is available at www.lcdph.org.

NOTE: A recovered individual is someone who has tracked their symptoms twice daily and reported that they have been fever free for 24 hours to the Logan County Department of Public Health. The total number of positives on the Logan County dashboard represents a historical running total of confirmed positive cases. Recovered individuals are never removed from the total number of positives.
