PUBLIC NOTICE

The Logan County, IL, Zoning Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 11, 2022, 7:30 PM, Logan County Board Room, 2d Floor, Orr Building, 628½ Broadway Street, Lincoln, IL 62656, for the purpose of considering a petition to amend the Logan County Zoning Ordinance.

Suggested Amendment to the Logan County Zoning Ordinance to add the Conditional Use for the delivery, well installation, deep injection, sequestration and permanent storage of Carbon Dioxide on and beneath land in Logan County that is Zoned Agricultural District.

Proposed changes:

Add a new subsection as follows:

3.41-4 Conditional Uses

- j. Pipeline delivery, well construction, deep injection, geologic sequestration, and monitoring for the commercial, permanent storage of Carbon Dioxide.

This use shall apply to all properties that have Carbon Dioxide injected beneath them, as well as those that have pipelines, injection wells, pumping stations, monitoring wells and other equipment installed, for the purpose of permanent storage of Carbon Dioxide.

All construction, installation and use, maintenance and monitoring of pipelines, injection wells, pumping stations, monitoring wells and other equipment, as well as the permanent storage of Carbon Dioxide, seismic monitoring, post-injection site care and site closure, and financial responsibility provisions, shall comply with the applicable laws, rules and regulations administered by: the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Department of Agriculture, Illinois Pollution Control Board, Illinois Commerce Commission, Logan County Department of Public Health, and any other federal, state or local regulatory agency, as applicable to this use. These rules and regulations shall include those applicable from the Safe Drinking Water Act, the Illinois Underground Injection Control Regulations and the Illinois Carbon Dioxide Transportation and Sequestration Act.
